## JERUSALEM

- **Closure:**
  - (i) On 28 November 2015, the Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound which forced residents to conduct prayers near checkpoints located outside Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
  - (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem according to Military Order 09/02S and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- **Closure of Main Roads:**
  - (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village.
  - (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.
  - (iii) On 16 November 2015, Israeli forces closed the southern entrance of Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood leading to Armon Hanatsif settlement with cement blocks.
  - (iv) At 15:15 on 29 November 2015, Israeli forces closed a road near Panorama Hotel in Ras Al-Amud neighbourhood in Jerusalem with cement blocks.
- **Checkpoints:**
  - (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city.
  - (ii) On 19 September 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.  
**Flying Checkpoints:** At 18:00, Israeli Forces set up two flying checkpoint at the main entrances to Hizma, preventing people’s entry except for civilians of Hizma.
- **Raids:** On the evening of 5 December 2015, Israeli forces raided Abu Dis town, clashed with civilians during raid on martyr Mazen Arabiyye’s home, detained family members and conducted field investigation.
- **Arrests:** At 19:15, Israeli forces arrested in Sur Bahir village civilian Jihad Atoun.
- **Attacks:**
  - (i) At 11:00, Israeli forces in Ras Al-Amud neighbourhood fired tear gas canisters and stun grenades towards civilians for alleged stoning.
  - (ii) At 16:50, Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity of Qalandia checkpoint fired tear gas canisters and stun grenades towards civilians for alleged stoning.
- **House Demolition:**
  - (i) On 4 December 2015, Israeli forces served 5 orders for the demolition of 5 residential building in the areas of Ein Al-Lozeh, Al-Bustan and Beer Ayyoub in Silwan neighbourhood in Jerusalem.
  - (ii) On 5 December 2015, Israeli forces served 7 orders to demolish residential and commercial stores (2 homes under construction) owned by civilians Youssef Jaafar and Hani Al-Abbasi at Ein Al-Lozeh and Al-Jiser in Silwan neighbourhood in Jerusalem, as well as the demolition of 5 commercial stores (warehouse and restaurant) and a butchery and vegetable store owned by civilian Youssef Jaafar and his brothers.
- **Wall Gates:**
  - (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu

	<p>Dis town.</p> <p>(ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.</p>
