#### **Checkpoints:** (i) Israeli forces continue to restrict access through Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus Districts, only allowing access to residents of Jericho District and the Jordan Valley area. Israeli forces continues to intensify its restrictions at the checkpoint set up on (ii) the junction to Al-Ouja village, only allowing access to residents of the Jericho District and others with access permits. Flying Checkpoints: At 15:55 and again at 00:30, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the southern entrance of Jericho. Raids: (i) At 09:05, Israeli forces raided Jericho in order to provide protection to a group of Israeli settlers as they were visiting a Jewish synagogue and withdrew at At 10:45, Israeli forces raided the area near Ein Dweik village, served (ii) demolition orders to 5 homes owned by Fayez Al-Khalfawy, Taha Shihada, Hatem Al-Jabbar, Fadi Al-Silwadi and Majed Al Awatana, for allegedly being built without proper licensing (the homes in question are in Area C). (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunums of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road east of Beit Fajjar town; the road connecting Tuqu' town to Khirbet al Baq'a village; and the detour road connecting Wadi Fukin and Al Jab'a villages. **Checkpoint:** The Israeli army continues to restrict access at the "Container" checkpoint, impeded the free flow of traffic. (i) At 15:30, Israeli forces raided Batir village, detained a resident and withdrew **BETHLEHEM** At 16:40, Israeli forces raided Beit Jala, searched and stormed a building and (ii) set up a flying checkpoint.. (ii) (iii) Israeli forces detained Ismail Al Zir during their raid into Tagou Wall Construction: Wall construction continued northwest of Beit Jala town. **Closure:** The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq (i) Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the (ii) Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall

construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them
access to the area.

- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to the entrance to Al-Simiya village
- (v) Since 15. 10. 2011, Israeli forces closed two entrances leading to Beit Ummar town.

- (ii) At 08:00, Israeli forces raided Susia village north of Yatta, served demolition notices for 8 residential tents, 3 barracks and 5 water wells owned by Ghassan Shinaran, Mohammad Mudallal, Mohammad Nawajaa, Jibril Nawajaa, Mohammad Al-Hrini, Khalil Musalam, Mohammad Ibrahim Nawajaa and Jihad Malash for allegedly being built without proper licensing (all property in question are in Area C).
- (iii) At 10:30 and again at 14:45 and 01:30, Israeli forces raided Hebron and detained 2 residents.
- (iv) At 11:15 and at 03:00, Israeli forces raided Halhoul and detained 2 residents.
- (v) At 12:30, Israeli forces raided Beit Ummar and detained a child.
- (vi) At 19:20, Israeli forces raided Al-Birkeh area in Yatta and fired teargas and stun grenades at residents.
- (vii) At 19:30, Israeli forces raided Kureiseh.
- (viii) At 02:30, Israeli forces raided Ithna and detained a resident.

- Settler Violence: At 10:30, a group of Israeli settlers occupied, plowed and planted 40 dunums of land owned by Al-Nawajaa and Al-Hadar families north of Yatta.
  - <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction continued in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahiriya town.

#### **GAZA STRIP**
