(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the gate along the Wall section separating the area of Dahiyat Al-Bareed from Al-Ram town. The entrance had been closed for seven years, and at 08:30, Israeli forces closed the entrance and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to restrict access at Za'tara checkpoint and impede the free flow of traffic. • Flying Checkpoints: At 19:10, Israeli forces setup a flying checkpoint between Kafil Harres and Harres villages. • Settler Violence: At 02:20, a group of Israeli settlers raided Burqin, set fire to the entrance of a mosque, in an attempt to set it ablaze, and wrote anti-Arab slogans on the mosque walls; settlers also set fire to a bulldozer owned by Nael Sabrah and a vehicle owned by Motasim Samara. • Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement. |

At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. The ceasefire has been further renewed on 30 October 2011 at 22:00. • Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement as Israeli forces opened fire towards North Gaza and Israeli jets launched 2 missiles towards armed Palestinian individuals, killing 1 gunman and injuring 5 others, 2 critically. |
| <p style="text-align: center;">NORTHERN GAZA</p> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critically ill patients, Journalists, NGO staff, merchants and travellers travelling to Al Karama with previous coordination. • Attack: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 22:00 on December 5th 2011 Israeli forces opened fire towards agricultural land in Beit Hanoun. (ii) At 07:30 on December 7th 2011, Israeli forces opened fire towards several workers in Beit Hanoun industrial zone in Beit Hanoun. • Detention: On the morning of December 12th 2011, Israeli force positioned at Erez crossing detained Mahmoud Nassar, a resident of Al-Bureij when he reported to Israeli Intelligence for questioning near the crossing in order to accompany his infant son (18 months) who receives cancer treatment in an Israeli hospital. |

Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. • Raid: At 15:30, Israeli forces escorted several bulldozers along with air cover by helicopters and fighter jets in carrying out an incursion 300 meters into the vicinity of Gaza city's Shajaia neighbourhood, opened fire and fired 3 artillery shells towards residents and several homes while levelling plots of land; meanwhile, Israeli Jets also launched 2 missiles towards armed Palestinian individuals, killing 1 and injuring 5 others, 2 critically; they withdrew at 02:30. |

In addition to 48 truckloads of live stock feed, 3 imported bulldozers and construction cargo designated to Internationally funded projects. |
