<p style="text-align: center;">JERUSALEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city for the alleged stabbing of an Israeli settler. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and impeded the free flow of traffic. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Raid:</u> On the morning of December 6th 2014, Israeli forces raided Al-Eisawiya and detained a resident. • <u>Attack:</u> On the evening of December 6th 2014, Israeli forces positioned in Ein Al-Lawza and Be’ir Ayoub areas in Silwan neighbourhood fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and detained a resident. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On the morning of December 6th 2014, Israeli forces detained five residents including a child: Ibrahim Abu Al-Hawa (14 years old), Amir Obada, Mohammad Sha’ban, Mohammad Da’as and Shihadeh Odeh in Jerusalem. (ii) Israeli forces detained Bashar Jabarin in Al-Eisawiya village. (iii) Israeli forces detained Mohammad Shuwiyat in Silwan neighbourhood. • <u>Physical Assault:</u> At 12:00, Israeli forces assaulted Nidal Al-Fasfous in Jerusalem. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

(ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. (iii) At 22:30 on November 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Beit

	<p>Illu village with cement blocks.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Yabrud Village Bridge until 15:05. (ii) At 18:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Rantis until 01:00. (iii) At 18:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Abboud. (iv) At 23:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Deir Abu Mash'al village until 01:30. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 20:15, Israeli forces raided Al-Bireh city until 22:15. (ii) At 01:20, Israeli forces raided Abboud, summoned Awar Jabr to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 02:30. (iii) At 02:30, Israeli forces raided Kafr Malik village and summoned Alaa Hamayel to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 03:00. • <u>Attack:</u> At 17:20, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Silwad fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 19:40, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of "Ofra" settlement stoned residents and vehicles passing along the main road leading to the settlement then withdrew at 23:30.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at "Eniv" checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Jayyus and Sir Village until 11:30. (ii) At 16:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun, impeded the free flow of traffic after closing the checkpoint for alleged stoning and temporarily detained Nael Gharabeh (A resident of Kafr Thulth) then released him after opening the checkpoint. (iii) At 20:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Jit village. • <u>Raid:</u> At 23:40, Israeli forces raided Jayyus until 01:00. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> On December 5th 2014, Israeli forces positioned near "Tsuvim" settlement located in North East Qalqiliya, temporarily detained four residents: Ibrahim Hirish, Sameh Hirish, Salah Hirish and Anas Hirish then released them at 11:15 on December 6th 2014. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate

The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access.</p> <p>(ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya, the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.</p>
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • Flying Checkpoint: At 18:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Naqrurah village until 21:00. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:40, Israeli forces raided Beita until 15:55. (ii) At 23:40, Israeli forces raided Orif village until 02:30.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • Checkpoints: At 18:00, Israeli forces closed Za'tara checkpoint, impeded the free flow of traffic until 18:30. • Raid: At 01:45, Israeli forces raided Salfit until 02:10. • Temporary Detention: At 13:30, Israeli forces positioned at Za'tara checkpoint temporarily detained Omar Salah (A resident of Tulkarem) then released him at 16:30.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoints: Israeli forces continue to intensify their restriction at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Flying Checkpoint: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 07:30 on December 6th 2014 and again at 17:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Jericho until 20:15. (ii) At 10:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the Dead Sea junction until 13:30. (iii) At 13:45 and again at 22:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along road (90) near Al-Nu'wmeh village located in North Jericho until 23:05.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area

	<p>in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds. (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in Al-Sadr area located in Beit Jalla until 13:50. (ii) At 12:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the north entrance of Taqou until 14:05. (iii) At 13:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint beneath Al-Khadr Bridge until 15:15. • <u>Raid:</u> At 01:25, Israeli forces raided Taqou' and detained three residents after storming their homes then withdrew at 03:30. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained 3 children: Mohammad Al-Amour (16 years old), Mohammad Abu Mifrih (17 years old) and Ahmad Sabah (17 years old) in Taqou'. • <u>Attack:</u> At 15:20, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ayda camp in Bethlehem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning during which several Israeli forces stormed the camp searched homes then withdrew at 16:40.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the

area.

- **Closure of Main Roads:**

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- (vi) On September 4th 2014, Israeli forces closed a road in Eiwn Al-Bas and Al-Bayda and Al-Ras area in Ithna located near the wall gate.
- (vii) At 13:40 on September 16th 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Al-Ibrahim mosque in the old city of Hebron.

- **Flying Checkpoint:**

- (i) At 10:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Surif and Kharas village until 11:30.
- (ii) At 17:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Fah's area located in south Hebron.

- **Raid:**

- (i) At 18:10, Israeli forces raided Hebron, set up a checkpoint , detained 3 residents , stormed and searched 2 homes and detained 2 others (5 total detained) then withdrew at 02:00.
- (ii) At 22:15, Israeli forces raided Al-Urub camp, occupied Muhanad Abu Khirans home and converted its roof top into a military post then withdrew at 22:25.
- (iii) At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Thahriya, stormed a home, detained a resident, assaulted Khaled Al-Batata leaving him hospitalised with contusions then withdrew at 03:30.
- (iv) At dawn on December 7th 2014, Israeli forces raided Al-Fuwar camp and detained a resident.
- (v) At dawn on December 7th 2014, Israeli forces raided Ithyna and detained two residents.

- **Detention:**

- (i) Israeli forces detained five residents: Musa Amro, Hassan Amro, Amjad Amro, Amin Al-Qawasmeh and Mus'ab Al-Zaghir in Hebron.
- (ii) Israeli forces detained Ibrahim Al-Batat in Al-Thahriya.
- (iii) Israeli forces detained Hamam Al-Titi in Al-Fuwar camp.
- (iv) Israeli forces detained 2 residents: Mu'taz Abu Jahishah and Al-Mutawakil Abu Jahishah

- **Attack:** At 08:30, Israeli forces positioned near Tariq Bin Ziyad School in the old city of Hebron fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

- **Assault on Property:** At 11:40, Israeli forces prevented several labourers from entering their farm land in Um Al-Aris area located near " Mitsi Ya'ar" settlement in south Yatta for allegedly being a closed military zone.

<p style="text-align: center;">ALL DISTRICTS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month. • Israeli forces broke the cease-fire agreement by opening fire towards Khan Yunis. • Israeli Naval vessels broke the cease-fire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of North Gaza and detained 12 fishermen.
<p style="text-align: center;">NORTHERN GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is closed. • Attack: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 18:30, Israeli Naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Beit Lahiya and detained 10 fishermen after surrounding their boats and again at 21:00 Israeli Naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats and detained 2 other fishermen (total fishermen detained 12) and confiscated 5 fishing boats. (ii) At 07:30, Israeli Naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Beit Lahiya. • Detention: Israeli forces detained 12 fishermen: Ahmad Zeyed, Mahmoud Zeyed, Safwat Al-Sultan, Saed Zayed, Yasser Muqdam, Adham Muqdam, Baha Al-Din Al-Najjar, Mahmoud Mahfouth, Sufayan Abu Masah, Billal Abu Odeh, Mohammad Abu Ward and Yusef Abu Warda off the shores of Beit Lahiya.

Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iyah (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
<p style="text-align: center;">CENTRAL GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Detention: On the evening of December 6th 2014, Israeli forces detained two unidentified residents in Al-Buriej camp as they were attempting to climb the border fence into Gaza.
<p style="text-align: center;">KHAN YUNIS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Attack: At 08:30, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line opened fire towards agricultural land in east Al-Qarrarah.
<p style="text-align: center;">RAFAH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Points : <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. (ii) Rafah (<i>Al 'Awdah</i>) Crossing is closed. (iii) Sufa Crossing is closed. (iv) Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is closed.
