| JERUSALEM | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On 28 November 2015, the Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound which forced residents to conduct prayers near checkpoints located outside Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem according to Military Order 09/02S and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. (iii) On 16 November 2015, Israeli forces closed the southern entrance of Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood leading to Armon Hanatsif settlement with cement blocks. (iv) At 15:15 on 29 November 2015, Israeli forces closed a road near Panorama Hotel in Ras Al-Amud neighbourhood in Jerusalem with cement locks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On 19 September 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> At 19:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Qalandia village roundabout and searched civilians and vehicles. • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 03:00 on 6 December 2015, Israeli forces raided Izariyye town and arrested 2 children. (ii) At 16:00, Israeli forces raided Abu Dis town and arrested 4 children. (iii) At dawn on 7 December 2015, Israeli forces raided Beith Hanina, clashed with civilians during search of martyr Omar Yasser Fakhri Iskafi home and arrested his father. (ii) At 15:00, Israeli forces detained 4 children in Wadi Al-Rababa area in Silwan neighbourhood: Amer Waleed Siam, 12, Sultan Shweiki, 12, and Iyad Zaitoun 17, and released them at a later time. • <u>Killings:</u> At 19:45, Israeli forces opened fire and killed civilian Yasser Fakhri Iskafi, 21, from Beit Hanina for allegedly running over 3 settlers in Jerusalem (according to Israeli claims). • <u>Attacks:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 19:30, Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity of Shu'fat checkpoint fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas canisters at civilians for alleged stoning. (ii) At 20:50, Israeli forces at the junction of Al-Jabal in Abu Dis town fired tear gas canisters towards civilians in the Old City of Jerusalem for alleged stoning. • <u>Attacks on Places of Worship:</u> At 09:00, Jewish settlers raided the compound of Al-Aqsa mosque backed up by Israeli forces. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 19:40, a settler opened towards civilians near Ramot settlement north of Jerusalem. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. |

(ii) At 16:30, Israeli forces raided Deri al-Ghuson, clashed with civilians during patrol, injuring civilian Badee’ Rashed Faris Ghanem with tear gas canister in his leg, and withdrew at 18:30. (iii) At 18:30, Israeli forces raided Shweiki suburb in Tulkarem city and patrolled it until 20:40. • <u>Attacks:</u> At 09:40, Israeli forces positioned at Gate 104 near the Separation wall west of Tulkarem city fired stun and tear gas grenades towards Kadouri University students, injuring three civilians: Hassan Talib Ibrahim Al-Tabil, Mustafa Mohammad Mustafa Bani Odeh and Fadi Hussam Adnan Ghanem. • <u>Physical Assault:</u> At 09:00, Israeli forces positioned at Jbara checkpoint physically attacked civilian Rizek Mohammad Bisharat from Tammoun town in Tulkarem and confiscated ILS 2,200 from him. |

(iii) Since 10:40 on 1 September 2015, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far’ata village which is located near “Gillad” settlement with a steel gate. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> At 18:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of qalqilya city and searched civilians and vehicles. • <u>Raids:</u> At 00:45, Israeli forces raided Qalqilya city, arrested 1 civilian and withdrew at 03:55. • <u>Arrests:</u> The civilian arrested in Qalqilya city is Awad Issa Haitham Hassan Elias. • <u>Attacks:</u> At 14:10, Israeli forces guarding the Separation Wall alongside the western side of Qalqilya city fired rubber coated steel bullets, tear gas canisters and stun grenades at civilians for alleged stoning. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. |
