<b>JERUSALEM</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to increase its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city entrance and the entrance to the Old City.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.</li> <li>(iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the gate along the Wall section separating the area of Dahiyat Al-Bareed from Al-Ram town.</li> <li>(iii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoints:</u></b> Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city.</li> <li>• <b><u>Raids:</u></b> At 13:20, Israeli forces raided Bir Nabala until 16:00.</li> <li>• <b><u>Physical Assault:</u></b> At 12:45, Israeli troops positioned at Qalandia checkpoint assaulted Mustafa Marar and Nabil Hajal, sending them to hospital.</li> <li>• <b><u>Demonstrations:</u></b> At 11:00, Palestinian and international peace activists marched in Qalandia town against the construction of the wall; confrontations ensued with Israeli troops, who injured Alaa Mansour, who was hit with a teargas grenade while several protesters suffocated as a result of teargas inhalation.</li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Gates:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

<b>TUBAS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoints:</u></b> The Israeli army continues to restrict Palestinian access to the Northern Jordan Valley through the Tayasir checkpoint to between the hours of 06:00 and 22:00.</li> </ul>
<b>TULKAREM</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village and the dirt road between Shufa and Saffarin villages.</li> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoints:</u></b> The Israeli army continues to increase restrictions on Palestinian access at 'Einav checkpoint on the Tulkarem-Nablus main road and impeded the free flow of traffic.</li> <li>• <b><u>Raids:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 14:45, Israeli forces raided Anabta, temporarily detained several residents and released them after interrogation; residents and Israeli troops also clashed during the raid.</li> <li>(ii) At 23:10, Israeli forces raided Tulkarem, searched several homes and withdrew at 03:10</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Gates:</u></b> Passage through the wall gates was restricted to civilians granted special permits, undercutting access to education and health services for civilians living behind the wall.</li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Construction:</u></b> Land levelling for adjustment of the Wall route resumed in the area surrounding Jubara village According to an Israeli High Court decision, the new Wall route will be constructed west of the village.</li> </ul>
<b>QALQILYA</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Roads:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of the town of Azzoun.</li> <li>(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second <i>Intifada</i>, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Flying checkpoints:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 09:00, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Hablah .</li> <li>(ii) At 14:20, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Azzoun .</li> <li>(iii) At 18:10, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Kafr Laqief.</li> <li>(iv) At 20:00, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Jit village junction.</li> <li>(v) At 21:00, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the northern entrance of Azzoun, closed the area and impeded the free flow of traffic, alleging that settler vehicles driving nearby were stoned; the checkpoint was reopened at 22:00</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Raid:</u></b> At 21:00 Israeli forces raided Azzoun town.</li> </ul>

The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras ‘Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b>Wall Construction:</b> Wall construction was resumed in Kafr Laqef village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Imanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma’ale Shomron settlement and between Azzun Atma and Oriniet settlement</li> </ul>

The entrance had been closed for seven years, and at 08:30, Israeli forces closed the entrance and impeded the free flow of traffic.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b>Checkpoints:</b> The Israeli army continues to increase its restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic.</li> <li>• <b>Flying Checkpoints:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 18:20, Israeli forces setup 3 flying checkpoints between Salfit and Burqin &amp; between Al Faraaa and Khirbet Qais village.</li> <li>(ii) At 21:00, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Qarwat Bani Hassan until 00:30</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b>Raids:</b> At 02:45, Israeli forces raid Kafil Harres, searched several homes, detained 2 residents and summoned Firas Odeh to questioning by Israeli intelligence then withdrew at 03:15.</li> <li>• <b>Detention:</b> Israeli forces detained Jallal Masoud and Moayad AL-Qaq during their raid into Kafil Hares.</li> <li>• <b>Land Levelling:</b> At 13:00, Israeli forces escorting bulldozers raided and levelled land in Kafr Al-Dik for the purpose of settlement expansion and withdrew at 17:00</li> <li>• <b>Wall Construction:</b> Wall construction resumed in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement.</li> </ul>
<b>JERICHO</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Closure of Main Road:</b> The Israeli army continues to close Road # 90 between Jericho city and Al-Oja village with cement blocks.</li> <li>• <b>Checkpoints:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) Israeli forces continue to restrict access through Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus Districts, only allowing access to residents of Jericho District and the Jordan Valley area.</li> <li>(ii) Israeli forces continues to intensify its restrictions at the checkpoint set up on the junction to Al-Ouja village, only allowing access to residents of the Jericho District and others with access permits.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b>Flying Checkpoints:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 11:30 and again at 19:40, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the southern entrance of Jericho.</li> <li>(ii) At 17:10, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Al-Oja village junction.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
<b>BETHLEHEM</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Closure:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village.</li> <li>(ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 <i>dunums</i> of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b>Closure of Main Roads:</b> The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road east of Beit Fajjar town; the road connecting Tuqu' town to Khirbet al Baq'a village; and the detour road connecting Wadi Fukin and Al Jab'a villages.</li> </ul>

In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.</li> <li>(ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta.
