JERUSALEM

- **Closure:**
 - (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city for the alleged stabbing of an Israeli settler.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
 - (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages.
- **Closure of Main Roads:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.
- **Checkpoints:**
 - (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and impeded the free flow of traffic.
 - (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- **Raid:** At 05:00 on December 7th 2014 and again at 12:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Eisawiya village and detained two children.
- **Attack:**
 - (i) At 12:00, Israeli forces positioned in Ras Al-Amoud neighbourhood fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
 - (ii) At 00:30, Israeli forces positioned at Qalandiya checkpoint fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result, set fire to a coffee shop owned by Ayman Al-Hamid after a tear gas grenade canister exploded during which Palestinian Civil defence forces extinguished the flames.
- **Detention:**
 - (i) At dawn on December 7th 2014, Israeli forces detained two children: Ali Awisat (14 years old) and Munthir Awisat (16 years old) in Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood.
 - (ii) Israeli forces detained two children: Hisham Al-Dawik (16 years old) and Mohammad Mustafa (16 years old) in Al-Eisawiya.
- **Assault on Places of Worship:** At 12:00, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces and Israeli Police stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshiper by conducting Talmudic rituals.
- **Settler Violence:** At 23:40, a group of Israeli settlers assaulted Awad Ghaniem (A resident of Beit Jallah) and as a result, left him hospitalised with contusions.
- **Wall Gates:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in

	<p>Abu Dis town.</p> <p>(ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.</p>
RAMALLAH & AL BIREH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and ‘Ein Samiya villages. (ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. (iii) At 22:30 on November 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Beit Illu village with cement blocks. (iv) At 16:50, Israeli forces closed the main entrance gate leading to Deir Nathim village with cement blocks for the alleged stoning of Israeli settler vehicles passing along the road by Palestinian children near the village entrance. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 15:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Mughier village and detained a resident. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 00:10, Israeli forces raided Al-Jalazoun camp, stormed several homes, detained two residents then withdrew at 03:10. (ii) At 00:10, Israeli forces raided Al-Bireh city. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained Ammar Al-Na’san (A resident of Al-Mughier village) in Al-Mughier village. (ii) Israeli forces detained two residents: Ahmad Abu Sbeih and Nidal Al-Rasmi in Al-Jalazoun camp. • <u>Land Confiscation:</u> On December 7th 2014, Israeli forces stormed Beit Sira village and served the local village council a military order for the confiscation of 9.43 dunums of land located west of Beit Sira village.

(ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:45, Israeli forces raided Al-Khabriyat area of Jenin, occupied the home of Majd Al-Tubasi and converted its rooftop into a military post then withdrew at 13:45. (ii) At 02:35, Israeli forces raided Qabatiya, clashed with several residents as they stormed several homes, detained 2 residents then withdrew at 04:30. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Oday Abu Al-Rub and Shadi Zakarna in Qabatiya village.
TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raid:</u> At 04:55, Israeli forces raided Tubas until 05:20. • <u>Detention:</u> At 20:55, Israeli forces detained Saed Sawafta (a resident of Bardala village) as he was reporting to Israeli intelligence for questioning.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 10:40, Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 11:45.

QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Izbit Al-Tabib village until 15:45. (ii) At 16:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Qalqiliya until 17:15. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Ashraf Al-Ra'I at the east entrance of Qalqiliya. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 18:10, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Huwara checkpoint until 21:20. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 11:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Yatma village junction until 13:20. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:25, Israeli forces raided Oriif village, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 14:00. (ii) At 03:20, Israeli forces raided Askar and Balata camp in Nablus, stormed several homes, detained 3 residents then withdrew at 04:05 • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained three residents: Assad Abu Al-Hassan, Yazaan Ishtayeh and Mujahid Khalil in Askar camp in Nablus. • <u>Attack:</u> At 24:00, Israeli forces positioned at a military checkpoint in Tel village opened extensive fire.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from

(ii) At 10:20 and again at 20:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Jericho until 20:55. (iii) At 14:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Oja village junction until 16:40. (iv) At 16:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along road (90) near Al-Nu'wmeh village located in North Jericho until 16:45. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On December 7th 2014, Israeli forces positioned at Allenby Bridge detained Dr. Imad Al-Barghouthi (A University Professor) {a resident of Ramallah} as he was travelling to Jordan. BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunums of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
