<p style="text-align: center;">JERUSALEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On 28 November 2015, the Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound which forced residents to conduct prayers near checkpoints located outside Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem according to Military Order 09/02S and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. (iii) On 16 November 2015, Israeli forces closed the southern entrance of Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood leading to Armon Hanatsif settlement with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On 19 September 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> At 23:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint under Rafat Bridge and searched civilians and vehicles. • <u>Raids:</u> At 24:00, Israeli forces raided Bir Nibala town and patrolled it until 03:00 • <u>Arrests:</u> At 21:00, Israeli forces arrested at Qalandia checkpoint civilian Hassan Youssef Afaneh from Qalandia refugee camp. • <u>Attacks:</u> At 20:30, Israeli forces in Silwan neighbourhood fired tear gas canisters and stun grenades towards civilians for alleged stoning. • <u>Attacks on Places of Worship:</u> At 10:00, Jewish settlers backed up by Israeli forces raided Al-Aqsa Mosque compound and provoked worshippers. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

	<p>El" settlement and leading to Al-Jalazoun camp with cement blocks.</p> <p>(iii) On 24 November 2015, Israeli forces closed the main entrance gate leading to Sinjil and the east entrance of Mughier with cement blocks.</p> <p>(iv) At 18:50 on 4 December 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Aboud town with dirt mounds.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:05, Israeli forces raided Budrus village and stormed into 1 civilian home. (ii) At 19:10, Israeli forces raided Beitin village (under the pretext molotov cocktail throwing at military jeep) and set up a checkpoint at the entrance of the village. Clashes broke out between civilians and Israeli forces resulting in the injury of civilian Sayel Darweesh Jaraya'a. In addition, Israeli forces caused material damage to home furniture. (iii) At 00:45, Israeli forces raided Birzeit town, clashed with civilians, stormed into 1 civilian home and withdrew at 03:10. (iv) At 02:40, Israeli forces raided Ramallah city, stormed into Al-Wihda Hotel, arrested 1 civilian and confiscated a computer and surveillance cameras, and then withdrew at 07:15. • <u>Arrests:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 03:20 on 7 December 2015, Israeli forces arrested during a raid on Al-Mughier village (as mentioned in the previous report) civilian Basel Abu Alya. (ii) The civilian arrested in Al-Bireh city is Bassem Fares Ibrahim Al-Naasan from Al-Mughier village. • <u>Attacks:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:35, Israeli forces near the entrance of Silwad town fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 14:40, Israeli forces near the entrance of Al-Jalazoun refugee camp fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. Injuring child Ayman Rami Subhi Zeid, 11.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) <u>Raids:</u> At 01:50, Israeli forces raided Jabaa town, clashed with civilians, stormed into several civilian homes, arrested 2 civilians and withdrew at 04:10. • <u>Arrests:</u> The 2 civilians arrested in Jabaa town are: Awad Rashid Abu Oun and Ihab Munir Nasser Fashafashe. • <u>Physical Assault:</u> At 00:30 on 7 December 2015, Israeli forces attacked during raid on Jenin refugee camp (as mentioned in the previous report) 2 civilians (including 1 female civilian): Ghadeer Ahmad Sharqawi and Ahmad Jamal Al-Shalabi. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Israeli forces continue to close the wall gate and only allow those holding special permits to enter through it.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 12:45, Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at "Eniv" checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic until 15:40. • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 17:35, Israeli forces raided Zeita town and patrolled it until 19:45. (ii) At 01:30, Israeli forces raided Ramin village, arrested 1 civilian after storming into his home and withdrew at 04:25. • <u>Arrests:</u> The civilian arrested in Ramin village is Zayed Sami Abdelaziz Salman. Israeli forces arrested at the Separation Wall gate alongside Kaf Jamal village child Abdallah Mahmoud Said Ali, 16 from Kafr Jamal village.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Attacks:</u> At 09:10, Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity of Gishury factories west of Tulkarem city fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents and university students for alleged stoning during protest against Israeli desecration of Al-Aqsa Mosque in Jerusalem. In addition, Israeli forces raided Kadouri University campus, injuring 11 civilians (including 4 children): Amer Mohammad Shaker Kharbasheh, 16, Basel Mohammad Hassan Wahdan, 17, Mohammad majed Jaber Hafaiza, 16, Ahmad Abed Sabri Alawneh, 17, Aref Abdallah Kilani, Mu'tasem Ma'moun Mithwal Shadeed, Abdelfattah Mohammad Abdelfattah Zeidan, Sami Wa'ad Fathallah Al-Hamshari, Ahmad Mohammad Al-Khatib, Ali Samir Khaled Jarrab and Majid Kamal Bakr Khalil.
<p style="text-align: center;">QALQILIYA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) Since 10:40 on 1 September 2015, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far'ata village which is located near "Gillad" settlement with a steel gate. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> At 16:40 and 20:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Qalqilya city and searched civilians and vehicles until 20:50. • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:30, Israeli forces raided Qalqilya city and delivered orders to halt the construction of 12 homes, and razed land under the pretext of their proximity to the Apartheid Wall owned by Yasser Daash, Mohammad Nofal, Kamal Al-Hajj Hassan, Azmi Al-Kharbawi, Mohammad Adel Inaya, Khaldoun Ghassan Mishal, Muemin Abdelkarim Jeidi, Sami Dhiab, Amir Jibara, Mohammad Ibrahim Daoud, Abdelkarim Jeidi and Siham Qatawi. Land threatened to be razed by Israeli forces is owned by Ahmad Rashad Salmi, Tawfiq Jeidi, Abdel Baset Tawfiq Kharzan and Ayman Al-Tirawi. (ii) At 21:20, Israeli Forces raided the city of Qalqelya, stormed a home, and arrested one civilian. • <u>Arrests:</u> The civilian arrested in Qalqilya city is Khalil Abdelrahman Abdel Khafer. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
<p style="text-align: center;">NABLUS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since 17 December 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and

SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) Since 30 July 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Naser and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> At 17:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Deir Ballout and searched civilians and vehicles. • <u>Raids:</u> At 22:00, Israeli forces raided Kafal Haris town and escorted Jewish settlers during visit of holy site and withdrew at 05:00.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> at 13:15, Israeli forces intensified restrictions Al-Hamra checkpoint and impeded free flow of traffic until 13:4. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 10:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the northern entrance of Jericho and searched civilians and vehicles until 11:25. • <u>Arrests:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:00, Israeli forces arrested civilian Khalil Muhannad Biladi from Fara'a refugee camp in Tubas while he was working in Tomer settlement near Fasayel village. (ii) At 15:30, Israeli forces arrested at Al-Karama civilian Murad Mirweh Qubaha from Tura Sharqiyye village in Jenin during his return from Jordan.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunums of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man; a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and

the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement, the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds.

- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks
- (iii) Israeli forces continue to close the road connecting Cremisan area north of Beit Jala and Walaja village with barbed wires and steel gate, and the road connecting Surif town with Jabaa village with cement blocks.
- (iv) Since 10:45 on 8 September 2015, the Israeli army agricultural road in Arab Rashaydeh near Ma'ale Amos settlement with dirt mounds.
- (v) At 15:30 on 20 November 2015, Israeli forces closed eastern entrance of Jinana town with dirt mounds.
- (vi) At 13:10, on 22 November 2015, Israeli force closed the entrance of Marah Rabah town with dirt mounds.
- (vii) At 18:00 on 27 November 2015, Israeli forces closed Barbara junction in Beit Jala with cement blocks.
- (viii) At 14:50 on 28 November 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance to Um Rukba area in Al-Khader with cement blocks.

 - (i) At 14:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Harmala village and searched civilians and vehicles until 15:00.
 - (ii) At 18:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Asakra and Dar Ali villages and searched civilians and vehicles until 18:25.
 - (iii) At 18:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Deir Salah village on the eastern entrance to Beit Sahour and searched civilians and vehicles until 18:30.
- **Raids:**
 - (i) At 01:20, Israeli forces raided Doha town, clashed with civilians during patrol and withdrew at 06:55.
 - (ii) At 00:40, Israeli forces raided Dheisheh refugee camp in Bethlehem, clashed with civilians during home raid, killing 1 civilian and arresting 5 others (including 1 child and a military from NSF), and delivered summons to civilians Odai Fathi Abbad and Bilal Ibrahim Al-Effendi.
- **Killing:** The civilian killed in Dheisheh refugee camp is Malik Akram Mohammad Shahin, 19.
- **Arrests:** The 5 civilians arrested in Dheisheh refugee camp in Bethlehem are: Military Qusai Youssef Abu Laban, Mustafa Jibril Al-Hasanat, Doya' Khalil Al-Jaafari, Ali Mohammad Abu Ajamiyye and Mohammad Elias Ahmad Al-Sarahneh.
- **Attacks:**
 - (i) At 13:15, Israeli forces positioned near Husan village fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning, and detained child Ismail Mohammad Zaoul.
 - (ii) At 15:20, Israeli forces positioned alongside Aida refugee camp north of Bethlehem fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
 - (iii) At 16:10, Israeli forces positioned at the western entrance of Teqoa town fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several

<p>HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) On 15 November 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrances of Khilet Al-Mayye and Al-Deirat villages east of Yatta with cement blocks. (vi) At 14:10 on 23 November 2015, Israeli forces closed of Al-Kom village north of Beit Awwa with cement blocks. (vii) At 08:00 on 01 December 2015, Israeli forces closed the checkpoint at the entrance of Shuhada' Street and denied civilian access and changed direction of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Kozbya village north of Sair town and searched civilians and vehicles. (ii) At 18:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the junction of Sammou' and searched civilians and vehicles. • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 21:35, Israeli forces raided and patrolled Halhul town until 22:35. (ii) At 00:45, Israeli forces raided and patrolled Yatta town until 06:00. • <u>Killings:</u> At 15:45, 2 civilian Ihab Fathi Zakaria Maswadeh, 21, from Hebron city was shot dead by Israeli forces for allegedly attempting to stab an Israeli soldier in the old city of Hebron (according to Israeli claims). • <u>Attacks on Places of Worship:</u> At 17:15, Israeli forces prevented the muezzin of Ibrahim Mosque from calling for afternoon prayer. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 17:00, Jewish settlers opened fire at civilian Kamel Salameh Al-Makhamreh while he was taking care of his cattle east of Yatta. (ii) At 19:50, Jewish settlers stoned civilian homes in Salayme Quarter in the old city of Hebron.
