## WEST BANK

## JERUSALEM

- **Closure:**

- (i) On 28 November 2015, the Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound which forced residents to conduct prayers near checkpoints located outside Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem according to Military Order 09/02S and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.

- **Closure of Main Roads:**

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.
- (iii) On 16 November 2015, Israeli forces closed the southern entrance of Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood leading to Armon Hanatsif settlement with cement blocks.

- **Checkpoints:**

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city.
- (ii) On 19 September 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- (iii) At 16:05, Israeli forces closed Jabaa checkpoint on the road connecting Jerusalem, Ramallah and Jericho, impeded traffic and reopened it later.
- **Flying Checkpoints:** At 21:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in Ein Al-Lozeh area in Silwan neighbourhood in Jerusalem and searched civilians and vehicles.

- **Raids:**

- (i) At dawn on 8 December 2015, Israeli forces raided Kafr Aqab village, clashed with civilians, stormed into several civilian homes and withdrew at arrested two civilians.
- (ii) At dawn on 8 December 2015, Israeli forces raided Qalandia refugee camp, and stormed into two civilian homes.
- (iii) At 10:00, Israeli forces raided Beit Hanina town and stormed into the home of martyr Omar Iskafi.
- (iv) At 14:00 Israeli forces, raided Al-Ram town clashed with civilians and forced owners of commercial stores near the northern entrance of the town to shut down their stores.
- (v) At 20:20, Israeli forces raided Hizma village and stormed into one civilian home.
- (vi) At 00:30, Israeli forces raided Anata town, stormed into 21 civilian homes, arrested one civilian and detained civilian Mohammad Mousa Saleh Salameh (released later, and withdrew at 04:00.
- (vii) At 04:00, Israeli forces raided and patrolled Abu Dis and Izariyye towns.

In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.</li> <li>(ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta.
