	<ul> <li>(i) On 02.12.2011, the Israeli army increased its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city entrance and the entrance to the Old City.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local</li> </ul>
	residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.  (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

#### **GAZA STRIP**

#### At 02:00 on 18 January 2009, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. The ceasefire has been further renewed on 30 October ALL 2011 at 22:00. DISTRICTS Israeli broke the ceasefire by firing a mortar from its positions in the green line towards people north of Gaza. Palestinian gunmen broke the ceasefire agreement by launching 20 projectiles towards the Green Line. Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for humanitarian assistance, journalists and international access. Attacks: On 09.12.2011 evening, Israeli forces fired towards homes in AlAttatara, west of Beit Lahia, destroying them.-**NORTHERN** Palestinian attacks: **GAZA** (i) At 17:00, one projectile was launched towards the Green Line. At 22:00, one projectile was launched towards the Green Line. (ii) At 22:40, one projectile was launched towards the Green Line. (iii) At 23:40, one projectile was launched towards the Green Line. (iv) At 01:50, one projectile was launched towards the Green Line. (v) **Closure of Crossing Points:** Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the (i) Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010. (ii) **GAZA** the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. Attacks: On 10.12.2011, an Israeli warplane fired missiles towards a training ground for an armed group west of Rafah city. **RAFAH** Palestinian attacks: (i) At 16:45, 3 projectiles were launched towards the Green Line.
