JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli army continues to intensify their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) Since September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. (iii) At 10:00, Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Jaba’ checkpoint located along the road connecting Jerusalem, Ramallah and Jericho and impeded the free flow of traffic as they searched vehicles using Police dogs. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 18:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Hizma village. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 17:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Ram, stormed and searched a home. (ii) At 20:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Isawiya village, clashed with several residents as they stormed 2 homes and temporarily detained a child: Mohamad Jarah (11 years old) then released him at a later time. • <u>Detention:</u> At 16:30, Israeli forces detained 2 children: Sayel Al-Atrash (15 years old) and Ayman Al-Atrash (14 years old). • <u>Obstruction of Places of Worship:</u> On the morning of December 9th 2013, Israeli settler under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshipers.

(ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim.

(ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 09:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Abboud. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 20:20, Israeli forces raided Beitin village, clashed with residents as they stormed several homes and merchant shops. (ii) At 20:20, Israeli forces raided Kafr Malik village, clashed with several residents as they stormed a home and summoned Oday Al-Sha'er to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:20, Israeli forces raided Al-Zabada, stormed several merchant shops, temporarily detained several residents then released them after questioning and detained 2 residents then withdrew at 17:20. (ii) At 15:20, Israeli forces raided Al-Arqa. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained 2 residents: Anwar Kamil and Wael Halhul in Al-Zabada . • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.

(ii) At 14:00, Israeli forces positioned near Makhoul village in the North Jordan valley temporarily detained 5 residents: Motaz Basharat, Arif Abu Ziet, Mohammad Basharat, Yusef Asmar and Ashraf Asmar then released them at a later time.

TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 16:45 and 07:10, Israeli forces continues to intensify their restrictions at “Eniv: checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 18:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Lid. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:40, Israeli forces raided Zeita until 14:00. (ii) At 21:25, Israeli forces raided Tulkarem. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.

(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) Israeli forces closed the entrance of Izbit Al-Tabib with several Cement blocks. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Jit village junction. (ii) At 19:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 01:00 on December 9th 2013, Israeli forces raided Hajja village and detained a resident. (ii) At 00:35, Israeli forces raided Qalqiliya, opened fire as they stormed 2 homes then withdrew at 04:40. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Lo’ay Basalat in Hajja village • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 18:50, Israeli settlers stoned residents and vehicles travelling along the main road near Jit village junction and as a result damaged a vehicle owned by Nasser Zayen a resident of Nablus. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction was continued in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma ’ale Shomron settlement.

(iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za'tara Al-checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Qarwat Bani Hassan until 17:30. (ii) At 16:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Oja village. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:20, Israeli forces raided Al-Zibidat village until 10:00. (ii) At 18:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Oja village and detained a resident.

(ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Since October 18th 2013 at 14:00, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds. (viii) Since November 10th 2013 at 14:40, Israeli forces closed the bypass road leading to Khirbeit Al-Dier village with concrete blocks • <u>Raid:</u> At 06:40, Israeli forces raided Al-Duhisheh camp in Bethlehem, clashed with several residents as they stormed several homes and detained 5 residents. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained 5 residents: Karam Abd Rabbo, Tamer Sha'abiyat, Murad Zaghari, and Ashraf Zaghari a Hussien Zaghari in Al-Duhisheh camp in Bethlehem. • <u>Injury:</u> On the morning of December 10th 2013, 2 residents: Imad Shakarna Ali Shakarna were injured after being ran over by an Israeli military jeep near Nihalin village and as a result left them hospitalised with contusions. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> On the morning of December 10th 2013, an Israeli settler vehicle ran over 2 children: Hanin Al-Araj (17 years old) and Hanan Al-Araj (17 years old) along the main road near Beit Jalla and as result left them hospitalised with contusions. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Wall construction has continued in North West of Beit Jala town. (ii) On May 1st 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village. (iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.

HEBRON

- **Closure:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
 - (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. .
- **Closure of Main Roads:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
 - (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
 - (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
 - (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
 - (vi) Since December 27th 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village which connects Yatta and Al-Samou' village with cement blocks.
 - (vii) Since 09:45 on September 23rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to "Haji" settlement and impeded the free flow of traffic
- **Flying checkpoint:** At 09:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Ithna junction.
- **Raid:**
 - (i) At dawn on December 9th 2013, Israeli forces raided Hebron, stormed a home and detained a resident.
 - (ii) At 21:15, Israeli forces raided Bani Na'im.
 - (iii) At 01:45, Israeli forces raided Dura, clashed with several residents as they stormed several homes , detained 2 residents then withdrew at 04:55
 - (iv) At 03:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Karmil village located in south Yatta and detained 2 residents.
 - (v) At 04:00, Israeli forces raided Sa'ir and detained a resident.
- **Detention:**
 - (i) At 09:15, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ramadin village detained 3 residents: Mohammad Al-Ka'imi, Mohammad Al-Hourob and Ibrahim Al-Horoub.
 - (ii) Israeli forces detained Tariq Tawil in Hebron.
 - (iii) Israeli forces detained 2 residents: Mohammad Amro and Rami Abu Zanid in Dura.
 - (iv) Israeli forces detained 2 residents: Hani Makhamra and Zied Makhamra in Al-Karmil village.
 - (v) Israeli forces detained Maher Jarradat in Sa'ir.
- **Wall Construction:** Wall construction continued in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahiriya town.
