| <p style="text-align: center;">ALL DISTRICTS</p> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Beginning on 05 November 2005, the Israeli army has imposed a complete closure on the West Bank and Gaza Strip districts after a Palestinian individual carried out a suicide attack in the city of Netanya inside the Green Line. The Israeli army has also prevented civilians from entering the city of Jerusalem and workers from crossing the Green Line. |

| <p style="text-align: center;">JERUSALEM</p> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrances to the city of Jerusalem and has set up checkpoints in the old city of Jerusalem and around Al Aqsa Mosque compound. • Checkpoints: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Beginning at 17:30 on 08 December 2005, the Israeli army has continued to close Qalandiya checkpoint and impeded civilian access, after a Palestinian individual stabbed and killed an Israeli soldier at the checkpoint. (ii) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Beit Iksa checkpoint, impeding civilian access. • Wall Gates: The Israeli army continues to close the Wall gate in the town of Abu Dis with cement blocks. • Wall Construction: Wall construction was resumed in Dahiyat al Aqbat, from the village of Hizma to 'Anata, along the Hizma-Jaba' road, the area of Al 'Eizariya to Ash Shayyah, near Al Quds University, in the town of As Sawahira ash Sharqiya, from the village of Beit Surik to Biddu, in the areas of Al Judeira, Bir Nabala, and Beit Hanina, around the settlement of Ma'ale Adumim, and west of the village of Al Jib. • Flying Checkpoint: The Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint near the settlement of Ma'ale Adumim and searched civilians and vehicles. • Arrest: The Israeli army arrested Mustafa Ashraf al Yaseeni in the city of Jerusalem. • Settler Violence/Physical Assault: A group of Israeli settlers severely beat and injured 3 civilians in the city of Jerusalem. |
| <p style="text-align: center;">RAMALLAH & EL BIREH</p> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the eastern entrance to the village of Sinjil with dirt barricades. (ii) At 16:15, the Israeli army closed the gate set up on the junction to the settlement of Halamish and denied civilian access in both directions. • Wall Construction: Wall construction was resumed in the areas of Al Midya to Budrus, Al Midya to Ni'lin, Bil'in to Saffa, in the village of Beit Liqya, in the town of Beituniya, and west of the town of 'Abud. |

| | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 17:10, and again at 02:55, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the Ramallah-Bir Zeit road and searched civilians and vehicles. (ii) At 02:50, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction to the village of Jifna and searched civilians and vehicles. (iii) The Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the overpass to the town of 'Atara and searched civilians and vehicles. • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:20, the Israeli army, including 2 jeeps, raided the city of El Bireh, set up a checkpoint in the neighbourhood of Sateh Marhaba, and searched civilians and vehicles. At 02:10, the Israeli army raided the city again and patrolled the area. (ii) At 23:00, the Israeli army, including 2 jeeps, raided the villages of Qarawat Bani Zeid and Kafr 'Ein and patrolled the area until 01:00. | JENIN | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> At 14:30, the Israeli authorities announced (through the DCO) that the city of Jenin is a closed military zone and that civilian vehicles will be prevented from entering or exiting the city. Only humanitarian cases will be allowed access after prior coordination. • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> At 13:05, the Israeli army closed Al Jalama Street at the northern entrance to the city of Jenin with dirt barricades. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Tayasir checkpoint east of the town of Tubas and to impede civilian access. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> At 12:00, the Israeli army set up 6 flying checkpoints: near As Sa'ada forest on Haifa Street; at the southern entrance to the city of Jenin; in the area of Al Almaniya north of the city of Jenin; at the south-western entrance to the town of Az Zababida; and at the entrances to the town of Tubas and the village of Fahma. The Israeli army searched civilian vehicles and impeded civilian access. • <u>Raids/House Occupation/Detention/Air Patrol:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:05, the Israeli army raided the southern entrance to the city of Jenin, occupied 2 houses, and converted them into military posts after detaining residents. (ii) At 02:30, the Israeli army, including 30 jeeps, raided the city of Jenin whilst an Israeli army helicopter patrolled the skies over the area. The Israeli army searched a number of houses and arrested 5 individuals, including 1 Palestinian National Security officer. At 06:30, the Israeli army withdrew from the area. (iii) The Israeli army raided the town of Kafr Ra'i, set up a checkpoint at its northern entrance, and arrested 1 civilian. |

(vi) The Israeli army arrested 'Ammar Nayef Zakarneh in the town of Kafr Ra'i. |
| TULKAREM | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: At 10:45, the Israeli authorities announced (through the DCO) that the district of Tulkarem is a closed military zone. Civilians from the district of Tulkarem will be prevented from leaving the district and those from other areas will be denied access into it. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the road between the town of Kafr al Labad and the village of Al Hafasa and the entrance to the village of 'Izbat Abu Khamish. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road connecting the towns of Bal'a and Deir al Ghusun with cement blocks. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close the iron gate set up on the Tulkarem-Nablus main road near the junction to the settlement of 'Einav, denying access to civilian vehicles in both directions. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the roads connecting the town of Bal'a to the village of Al 'Attara, the town of 'Illar, and to Dahiyat Iktaba in the city of Tulkarem. • Checkpoint/Provocation of Palestinian Forced/Detention: Beginning at 17:30 on 05 December 2005, the Israeli army has continued to intensify its restrictions at Jubara (Al Kafriyat) checkpoint south of the city of Tulkarem and to prevent civilians, except those holding Tulkarem-issued IDs, from entering the city of Tulkarem. Israeli troops also prevented 1 Administrative Supplies Vehicle belonging to the Palestinian National Security forces from entering the city and detained Maher Ahmed Ghanayem, a Palestinian National Security officer. • Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. • Flying Checkpoints: The Israeli army set up 2 flying checkpoints, one at the entrance to the town of Bal'a and the other on the junction to the village of Al Jarushiya, and searched civilians and vehicles. • Raids: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:10, the Israeli army, including 3 jeeps, raided the town of 'Anabta, raided 1 coffee shop, and forced civilians to remove the stones that young civilians threw at the Israeli army during the confrontations reported yesterday. At 21:35, the Israeli army raided the town again. Confrontations took place between the Israeli army and civilians. (ii) At 19:40, the Israeli army, including 3 jeeps, raided and patrolled Dahiyat Shuweika in the city of Tulkarem. |

| | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Demonstration:</u> At 11:20, a mass demonstration took place in the city Tulkarem in solidarity with political prisoners held in Israeli prisons. Protestors marched towards outside the offices of the International Committee of the Red Cross where they held a sit-in. |
| <p style="text-align: center;">QALQILIYA</p> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. (ii) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, with a metal detector. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Land levelling for Wall construction was resumed in the village of Immatin and east of the towns of Kafr Thulth and ‘Azzun. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 15:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction to the village of Immatin on the Qalqiliya-Nablus main road, searched civilian vehicles, and impeded civilian access. |
| <p style="text-align: center;">NABLUS</p> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the main road leading to the district of Jenin between the junction to the village of Deir Sharaf and the settlement of Shavei Shomron. Instead, the Israeli army has forced civilians to travel along an unpaved 1.5-km-long road, which branches off from the Nablus-Tulkarem road and intersects with the Nablus-Jenin road opposite the village of Sabastiya. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road connecting the city of Nablus and the town of ‘Asira ash Shamaliya. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> The Israeli army continues to regulate times for crossing Huwwara, Beit Iba, At Tur Mountain, and Beit Furik checkpoints around the city of Nablus. The Israeli army closes the checkpoints overnight and reopens them at various morning hours, with the exception of Huwwara checkpoint where civilians between 16 and 30 years of age are allowed only entry into the city around the clock. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:20, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on Al Badhan road east of the city of Nablus, closed the road with dirt barricades, and denied access to civilians and vehicles. At 13:45, the Israeli army reopened the road. (ii) At 21:40, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction to the settlement of Bracha, searched civilian vehicles, and impeded civilian access. • <u>Raids:</u> At 00:45, the Israeli army raided the city of Nablus and Balata refugee camp and arrested 3 civilians, including 1 child. An armed confrontation took place between armed Palestinian individuals and the Israeli army while it was searching a number of houses in Balata refugee camp, during which the Israeli army killed 1 civilian and injured 3 others. |

| SALFIT | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the main north-western entrance to the city of Salfit with dirt barricades. The road has been closed since the beginning of the current <i>Intifada</i> (Uprising). (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the entrance to the town of Kafr ad Dik with cement blocks. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close the western entrance to the village of Bruqin with dirt barricades. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Deir Ballut checkpoint overnight and open it at various morning hours, impeding civilian access. (ii) At 08:00, the Israeli army intensified its restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint, impeding civilian access until 14:00. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction was resumed near the Green Line in the town of Deir Ballut and the villages of Az Zawiya and Rafat, northwest of the city of Salfit, and in the village of Marda and the town of Kifl Haris north of the settlement of Ari'el. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction to the town of Jamma'in and searched civilians and vehicles until 14:00. (ii) At 10:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction to the town of Deir Istiya and searched civilians and vehicles until 14:00. (iii) The Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the overpass to the town of Az Zawiya and searched civilians and vehicles. • <u>Arrests:</u> At 20:40, Israeli troops positioned at Za'tara checkpoint arrested 3 civilians: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Mu'atasseem Haydar al Kharraz; (ii) Nael Mash'hour Sultan; and (iii) Hussein Yasser Sultan. |
| JERICHO | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Road # 90 between the city of Jericho and the village of Al 'Auja is closed with cement blocks. The Israeli army prevents farmers not holding Jericho ID cards from reaching their land, forcing them to apply for access permits. The Israeli army also sporadically impedes civilian movement into the city of Jericho, except for Jerusalem and Jericho ID holders. |

The Israeli army also set up a checkpoint in front of 1 Palestinian National Security location and prevented workers from accessing their workplaces. The Israeli army remains positioned in the village as of 08:00 this morning. • <u>Destruction of Property:</u> At 14:15, an Israeli army jeep pursued farmers in agricultural areas surrounding the village of Al 'Auja, destroying part of the agricultural crops. |
| BETHLEHEM | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the road to the village of An Nu'man in the north-eastern Bethlehem district, isolating the village. The Israeli army considers the civilians' residence in the village illegal because they hold West Bank identity cards while their village is located within the Israeli-defined municipal boundaries of Jerusalem. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the villages of Husan and Nahhalin with cement blocks. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> The Israeli army continues to close all roads to Road # 60 leading to the city of Jerusalem, thereby isolating the city of Bethlehem from its towns and villages located west of Road # 60. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction was resumed north of 'Ayda refugee camp towards the area north of the city of Beit Jala. • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:30, an Israeli army patrol raided the city of Bethlehem and patrolled the area. |

Civilian vehicles will also be prohibited from travelling along this road unless they possess access permits. Only Israeli settler vehicles will be allowed unrestricted access on the road.</p> <p>(iii) The Israeli army continues to close with a dirt barricade the area of Khuzq al Far near the settlement of Abraham Avino in the old city of Hebron, in addition to the iron gate that has already been set up in the area.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction was resumed west of the town of Surif to Beit Ula, in the town of Idhna, from the village of Deir Samit to the village of Beit 'Awwa, from Beit 'Awwa to the village of Al Burj, and south of the towns of Adh Dhahiriya and As Samoa'. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <p>(i) At 20:10 on 10 December 2005, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to the town of Adh Dhahiriya and searched civilians and vehicles.</p> <p>(ii) At 22:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the road connecting the towns of Dura and Adh Dhahiriya and searched civilians and vehicles.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raids/Provocation of Palestinian Forces:</u> <p>(i) At 12:50, the Israeli army, including 2 jeeps, raided the city of Hebron and set up a checkpoint near Hebron University. | NORTHERN GAZA | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanun (Erez) Crossing is partially open to humanitarian cases and VIPs only. • <u>Attack:</u> At 21:55, the Israeli army fired 3 tank shells from its location inside the Green Line towards the area of Abu Safiya southeast of the town of Beit Hanun. • <u>Death:</u> At 19:00, Khader Rayyan died of injuries sustained during an Israeli army air attack on the town of Jabalya on 08 December 2005, as was reported on 09 December 2005. • <u>Palestinian Attacks:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 19:00, 2 unidentified mortars were fired towards the Green Line. (ii) At 22:20, 5 unidentified mortars were fired towards the Green Line. Consequently, the Israeli army fired 2 tank shells towards Al Qarya al Badawiya north of the town of Beit Lahiya. (iii) At 00:50, 1 unidentified mortar was fired towards the Green Line but exploded on Palestinian territory. |

| RAFAH | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Points:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Yasser Arafat International Airport remains closed. (ii) Rafah Crossing is partially open in both directions from 10:30 to 16:00 to passengers holding Palestinian IDs, humanitarian cases, and Arab and foreign diplomatic missions.
