JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to increase its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city entrance and the entrance to the Old City. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the gate along the Wall section separating the area of Dahiyat Al-Bareed from Al-Ram town. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) Israeli forces continue to close the entrance to Shu’fat refugee camp with cement blocks, which obstructs the free flow of traffic in Ras Khamis, Ras Shihadeh and Salam neighbourhoods in Anata and Shu’fat refugee camp. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Sawahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction was suspended in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za’ayem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma’ale Adumim because of the Sabbath holiday.

<p style="text-align: center;">RAMALLAH & AL BIREH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village as well as the junction to Kafr Malik and ‘Ein Samiya villages. • Flying Checkpoints: At 08:15, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Deir Abu Mashaal. • Raids: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 01:55, Israeli forces raided El-Bireh city and detained a resident. (ii) At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Silwad. • Detention: Israeli forces detained an unidentified resident during its raid into El-Bireh city • Wall Construction: Wall construction was suspended in the area west of ‘Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement ‘Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages because of the Sabbath holiday.
<p style="text-align: center;">JENIN</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Road: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. • Flying Checkpoints: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:45, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Jarba village until 09:30. (ii) At 16:40, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Zabauba village until 18:00. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:45, Israeli forces raided Al-Zababda , Maithaloun, Al-Jedaidiya and Faqoua villages . (ii) At 02:50, Israeli forces raided Ya’bad • Physical Assault: At 14:40, Israeli forces positioned at Bartaa checkpoint assaulted Haitham Kabha, a resident of Bartaa Al-Sharqiya, sending him to hospital. • Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.

<p style="text-align: center;">TULKAREM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village and the dirt road between Shufa and Saffarin villages. • Checkpoints: The Israeli army intensified its restrictions on Palestinian access at ‘Einav checkpoint on the Tulkarem-Nablus main road and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Detentions: On December 9th 2011, Israeli force detained Adham Abu Atwa, a resident of Deir Al Ghusoun. • Wall Gates: Passage through the wall gates was restricted to civilians granted special permits, undercutting access to education and health services for civilians living behind the wall. • Wall Construction: Land levelling for adjustment of the Wall route was suspended in the area surrounding Jubara village According to an Israeli High Court decision, the new Wall route will be constructed west of the village because of the Sabbath holiday.

<p style="text-align: center;">QALQILYA</p>	<p>the town of ‘Azzun.</p> <p>(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second <i>Intifada</i>, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying checkpoints:</u> <p>(i) At 09:30, Israeli forces setup a flying checkpoint between Kafr Qaddoum and Hija villages.</p> <p>(ii) At 20:20, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint beneath the Azzoun bridge.</p> <p>(iii) At 20:40, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Qalqilya.</p> • <u>Raid:</u> <p>(i) At 12:55, Israeli forces raided Kafr Qaddoum village.</p> <p>(ii) At 20:40, Israeli forces raided Al-Nabi Elyas village.</p> <p>(iii) At 03:00, Israeli forces raided Ras Tireh village.</p> • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <p>(i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector.</p> <p>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al-Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras ‘Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.</p> • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction was suspended in Kafr Laqef village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Imanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma’ale Shomron settlement and between Azzun Atma and Oriniet settlement because of the Sabbath holiday.
<p style="text-align: center;">NABLUS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <p>(i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Till-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin.</p> <p>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut.</p> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <p>(i) Al-Tur neighbourhood checkpoint (set up on Jerzim Mount) is closed on Fridays and Saturdays as well as during Jewish holidays. On all other days, it is open between 07:00 and, 02:00</p> <p>(ii) At ‘Awarta commercial checkpoint, civilians are only allowed to cross between 05:00 and 20:00, and between 05:00 and 15:00 on Fridays. All vehicles can access the city of Nablus, but only commercial vehicles and ambulances can leave the city through the checkpoint.</p> • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <p>(i) At 08:50, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Burin village</p> <p>(ii) At 13:15 and again at 20:35 & 00:35, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Deir Sharaf junction, detained and assaulted an unidentified civilian.</p> <p>(iii) At 17:00 and again at 00:10, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint near Beit Furik junction and impeded the free flow of traffic.</p> <p>(iv) At 21:30, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Beita junction.</p>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:10, Israeli forces raided the eastern neighbourhoods of Nablus City. . (ii) At 17:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Bathan village. (iii) At 21:10, Israeli forces raided Awarta, searched a home and detained 2 residents. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained an un identified resident during their raid into Deir Sharaf (ii) Israeli forces detained Muntaser Al-Qadi and his brother Murad during their raid into Awarta village.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) Since 14 November 2010, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian buses only. The entrance had been closed for seven years, and at 08:30, Israeli forces closed the entrance and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> The Israeli army increased its restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:10, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the western entrances of Kafr Al-Dik. (ii) At 21:15, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint between Kafil Harres and Harres villages. • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At dawn on December 10th 2011, Israeli forces raided Rafat village. (ii) At 07:35 on December 10th 2011 and again at 11:50 & 03:00, Israeli forces raided Salfit and with residents. (iii) At 22:15, Israeli forces raided Deir Istiya. (iv) At 03:15, Israeli forces raided Bruqin and summoned Abdel Ilah Samara, a security officer , for interrogation by Israeli intelligence; they withdrew at 03:30. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction was suspended in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement because of Sabbath holiday.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> The Israeli army continues to close Road # 90 between Jericho city and Al-Oja village with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to restrict access through Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus Districts, only allowing access to residents of Jericho District and the Jordan Valley area. (ii) Israeli forces continues to intensify its restrictions at the checkpoint set up on the junction to Al-Ouja village, only allowing access to residents of the Jericho District and others with access permits. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> At 13:05 and again at 17:20, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the southern entrance of Jericho city.

<p style="text-align: center;">BETHLEHEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 <i>dunums</i> of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road east of Beit Fajjar town; the road connecting Tuqu' town to Khirbet al Baq'a village; and the detour road connecting Wadi Fukin and Al Jab'a villages. • Checkpoint: At 20:15 Israeli army continues to restrict access at the "Container" checkpoint, temporarily detained 20 residents and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Flying Checkpoint: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:35 and again at 18:25, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Taqou. (ii) At 17:15, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Khader. • Raids: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 18:05, Israeli forces raided Jinata. (ii) At 19:30, Israeli forces raided Zaatara town. (iii) At 03:35, Israeli forces raided Bethlehem and Al-Diheisheh refugee camp, searched several homes and detained 4 residents, including a police officer, and summoned Mohanad Al-Ghaffar to interrogation by Israeli intelligence. • Detentions: Israeli forces detained Mohammad Al-Sajdiyeh, a police officer, as well as Saber Maali, Alaa Muheisen and Basel Al-Aiaseh • Wall Construction: Wall construction was suspended northwest of Beit Jala town because of the Sabbath holiday.
<p style="text-align: center;">Hebron</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Dhahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to the entrance to Al-Simiya village (v) Since 15. 10. 2011, Israeli forces closed two entrances leading to Beit Ummar town. • Flying Checkpoints: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:30, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the northern entrance of Al-Thahriya. (ii) At 09:30, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the northern entrance of

<p style="text-align: center;">ALL DISTRICTS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 02:00 on 18 January 2009, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. The ceasefire has been further renewed on 30 October 2011 at 22:00. • Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement as Israeli forces opened fire towards the Green Line, Israeli naval vessels opening fire towards Palestinian fishermen off the shores of Rafah and Israeli fighter jets fired 3 missiles towards Southern Gaza, injuring a mother and child. • Armed Palestinian groups broke the ceasefire agreement by launching 8 projectiles towards targets behind the Green Line.
<p style="text-align: center;">NORTHERN GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is closed. • Palestinian Attack: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:30, Palestinian gunmen launched a projectile towards the Green Line. (ii) At 14:15, Palestinian gunmen launched a projectile towards the Green Line. (iii) At 22:15, Palestinian gunmen launched a projectile towards the Green Line.
<p style="text-align: center;">GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Points: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iyah (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. • Attack: At dawn on December 11th 2011, Israeli forces fired artillery shells from their position behind the Green Line towards agricultural land in Juhor Al-Dik, southeast of Gaza City. • Aerial Assault: At dawn on December 11th 2011, Israeli fighter jets fired 3 missiles at an abandoned home in Al-Zaitoun neighbourhood southeast of Gaza City, injuring a woman and child and damaging several nearby homes

<p style="text-align: center;">Khan Younis</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Palestinian Attack: At 23:30, Palestinian gunmen launched 1 projectile towards the Green Line.
<p style="text-align: center;">RAFAH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Points: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. • Rafah (<i>Al 'Awdah</i>) Crossing is open for critically ill patients, students and residents with special permits • Sufa Crossing is closed. • Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is closed. • Attack: On the evening of December 11th 2011, Israeli naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishermen off the shores of Rafah.
