Closure:

- The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints located at (i) the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city.
- The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in (ii) the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

Closure of Main Roads:

- The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the (i) entrance to Jaba' village.
- The Israeli army continues to close the gate along the Wall section separating (ii) the area of Dahiyat Al-Bareed from Al-Ram town.
- The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to (iii) Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Oalandia checkpoint.

Checkpoints:

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city.
- (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.

Detention: At 16:45, Israeli forces detained 3 female residents including a child after storming their home in Jabal Al-Tur neighbourhood in Jerusalem, clashed with several residents as they attempted to detain them including Nabila Al-Su', Tamarlin Al-Su' (15 years old), Tala Al-Su' (16 years old), Mohammad Abu Al-Hawa, and Amer Abu Al-Hawa.

- Home Demolition: At 10:00, Israeli forces served a demolition orders to demolish 4 homes in Silwan neighbourhood owned by Dawood Siyam, Hammoda Siyam, Walid Siyam and Al-Rajabi family.
- **Destruction of Property:** At 10:00, served demolition orders to destroy merchant shops owned by Abu Taya family and livestock sheds owned by Burhan Qawadir during which they fired tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning.
- Home Annexation: On December 10th 2012, an Israeli court ruled in favour the favour of an Israeli settler groups claim to a home owned by Muhammad Shamasna in Al-Sheikh Jarrah neighbourhood and gave him 1 month to leave his property in order to allow Israeli settlers to annex it.
- **Obstruction of Places of Worship:** On the morning of December 10th 2012, Israeli settlers stormed Al-Agsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and proved worshipers.

Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.
- The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate (ii) on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Sleavawahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in the areas north and south of

	Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya
	west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim.
RAMALLAH & AL BIREH	 Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages. Flying Checkpoint: At 19:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Silwad and Ein Yabrud village. Raid: At 08:00, Israeli forces raided Beit Liqya, stormed a home, clashed with its residents, detained a resident, injured Mohammad Assi then withdrew at 11:00. At 14:55 and again at 20:25, Israeli forces raided Silwad, clashed with its residents until 20:25. At 23:10, Israeli forces raided Ramallah, stormed 3 associations: Al-Dameer Association for prisoners affairs, United Women's Association, United networks Association in Ramallah, damaged the entrances and served Ayman Abed to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 04:00.
	 <u>Detention:</u>, Israeli forces detained Arafat Assi in Beit Liqya. <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 10:30, Israeli settlers stormed agricultural land between Um Safa village and Atirat settlement. <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages.
JENIN	 Closure of Main Road: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. Flying Checkpoint: At 07:00 on December 10th 2012, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Faqqu'a and Beit Qad villages until 09:00. At 19:40, Israeli forces set up 2 checkpoints at the entrances of Ti'innik
	 and between Zububa and Rummana villages until 23:00. Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
TUBAS	 <u>Checkpoints:</u> The Israeli army intensified its restrictions on Palestinian access to the Northern Jordan Valley through the Tayasir checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. <u>Raid:</u> At 00:45, Israeli forces raided Tubas, Al-Aqab and Tayasir village, stormed a home, temporarily detained its residents releasing them after interrogating them and taking their phone numbers then withdrew at 02:00.
TULKAREM	 Closure of Main Roads: (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. Checkpoints: The Israeli army intensified its restrictions at Einav checkpoint on the Tulkarem-Nablus main road and impeded the free flow of traffic. Raid: At 16:00 Israeli forces raided Allar and Al-Baqa Al-Sharqiya. Wall Gates: Land leveling for adjustment of the Wall route resumed in the area surrounding Jubara village. According to an Israeli High Court decision,

	the new Wall route is to be constructed west of the village.

	the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to

	• Temporary Detention: At 17:00, Israeli forces temporarily detained Mohammad
	Ishtawi as he was travelling to Azzun and released him at a later time.

	(i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and to
	search civilians, including students, using a metal detector.
QALQILIYA	(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the

	residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at
	the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students
	to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
	Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in Kafr Laqif village north of
	Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel
	settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma 'ale Shomron settlement .

	(i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-
	Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the
	settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the

	village of Osrin.
	(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the

	checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic.

	market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.

	Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall
	construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them
	access to the area.

GAZA STRIP

ALL DISTRICTS	 At 21:00 on November 21st 2012, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. On November 24th 2012, Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark. Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire towards North Gaza and injured a resident.

NORTHERN GAZA	 Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businessmen and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination. Attack: At 12:00 on December 9th 2012, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line opened fire towards several labourers on their way to work in the industrial zone in north Beit Hanun and injured Abdallah Abu Jari.
GAZA	 Closure of Crossing Points: Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
RAFAH	 Closure of Crossing Points: Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. Rafah (Al 'Awdah) Crossing is open for the exit of patients, students, passengers with permits and International aid. Sufa Crossing is closed. Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is. Open for the entry of humanitarian supplies, cooking gas, 5 truckloads of wheat and Livestock feed and construction material for internationally funded projects and exported several tons of Cherry tomatoes.

Detainees Update

• Israeli military court sentenced Salim Al-Ju'ba, a resident of Jerusalem to 4 years in prison and an additional year imprisonment effective immediately.
