#### **WEST BANK**

#### • Closure:

- (i) Israeli army continues to intensify their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

#### • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.

### • Checkpoints:

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city.
- (ii) Since September 19<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- **Flying Checkpoint:** At 12:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Biddu and detained a woman.

#### Detention:

- (i) At 11:00, Israeli forces detained 2 residents: Mohammad Asili and Shadi Abu Farha in the old city of Jerusalem.
- (ii) At 12:30, Israeli forces detained 2 residents: Mohammad Safadi and Mohammad Akka in Beit Hanina.
- Obstruction of Places of Worship: At 05:00 on December 9<sup>th</sup> 2013, Israeli authorities installed 3 cameras on top of a building located across the north entrance of the Dome of the Rock Mosque and the area of Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and obstructed the freedom of worship.
- <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 21:00, an Israeli settler assaulted and stabbed Mohammad Ewies, a resident of Silwan neighbourhood in Jerusalem and as a result left him

- (vii) Since October 18<sup>th</sup> 2013 at 14:00, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.
- (viii) Since November 10<sup>th</sup> 2013 at 14:40, Israeli forces closed the bypass road leading to Khirbeit Al-Dier village with concrete blocks

#### • Raid:

- (i) At dawn on December 10<sup>th</sup> 2013, Israeli forces raided Harmala and detained a resident.
- (ii) At 23:20, Israeli forces raided Beit Jalla and Al-Ayda camp in Bethlehem, stormed and searched several homes, detained 6 residents, summoned 2 residents: Ahmad Odeh and Saed Abu Akr to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning and handed out flyers warning residents from stoning Israeli vehicles passing through the area.

#### • Detention:

- (i) Israeli forces detained Mohammad Al-Zir in Bethlehem.
- (ii) Israeli forces detained 6 residents: Hamdi Ayed, Mohammad Jadour, Jawad Mohammad, Khadr Abu Khdeir, Khalil Abu Akr and Mustafa Abu Akr in Al-Ayda camp in Bethlehem.
- <u>Settlement Activity:</u> On December 9<sup>th</sup> 2013, Israeli forces levelled plots of land on Al-Walaja village for the purpose of connecting road 60 to Deir Carmisan located in north Beit Jalla and as a result uprooted 40 Olive trees.

#### • Wall Construction:

- (i) Wall construction has continued in North West of Beit Jala town.
- (ii)On May 1<sup>st</sup> 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village.
- (iii) On July 21<sup>st</sup> 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.

#### • Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

#### Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour

#### **HEBRON**

- roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- (vi) Since December 27<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village which connects Yatta and Al-Samou' village with cement blocks.
- (vii) Since 09:45 on September 23<sup>rd</sup> 2013, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to "Haji" settlement and impeded the free flow of traffic



- (ii) At 12:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Awwa.
- (iii)At 16:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint of Al-Fah's area located in south Hebron.
- (iv)At 19:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Majd village and detained 2 residents.

#### • Raid:

- (i) At dawn on December 10<sup>th</sup> 2013, Israeli forces raided Beit Ummar and detained 2 residents.
- (ii) At 10:40, Israeli forces raided Ithna, stormed and searched a merchant shop.
- (iii) At 10:40, Israeli forces raided Hebron and installed a checkpoint.
- (iv)At 23:00, Israeli forces raided Bani Na'im, stormed 2 homes and summoned Mohammad Barakat to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning them withdrew at 05:30.
- (v) At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Dura, detained a resident and summoned Lu'ay Shadid to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 05:30
