JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On 10 December 2015, the Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound which forced residents to conduct prayers near checkpoints located outside Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem according to Military Order 09/02S and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) Israeli forces continue to close the hill between Biddo and Beit Iksa villages and deny civilian access. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. (iii) On 16 November 2015, Israeli forces closed the southern entrance of Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood leading to Armon Hanatsif settlement with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On 19 September 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:45, Israeli forces set up 2 checkpoints at the entrances of Hizma village and searched civilians and vehicles. (ii) At 14:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Bir Nibala town and searched civilians and vehicles. • <u>Attacks:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:00, Israeli forces positioned in Ras Al-Amud neighbourhood in Jerusalem fired tear gas canisters and stun grenades towards civilians for alleged stoning. (ii) At 17:45, Israeli forces near the north entrance of Al-Ram town fired tear gas canisters and stun grenades towards civilians for alleged stoning. (iii) At 20:20, Israeli forces in Bab Hutta and Lions Gate (one of the gates leading to Al-Aqsa Mosque) in the old city of Jerusalem fired tear gas canisters and stun grenades towards civilians for alleged stoning. • <u>Attacks on Places of Worship:</u> at 09:00, Jewish settlers backed up by Israeli forces raided the compound of Al-Aqsa Mosque and provoked worshippers. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on

<p>RAMALLAH & AL BIREH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and ‘Ein Samiya villages (ii) On 3 October 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road located near “Bet El” settlement and leading to Al-Jalazoun camp with cement blocks. (iii) On 24 November 2015, Israeli forces closed the main entrance gate leading to Sinjil and the east entrance of Mughier with cement blocks. • <u>Flying checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Deir Dibwan town and searched civilians and vehicles. (ii) At 15:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Nabi Saleh village, shut down metal gate of the entrance and impeded traffic but reopened the gate at a later time. Also at 17:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint and detained 2 civilians from Beit Rima: Ali Hussein Shawar Al-Rimawi and Khalil Shawar al-Rimawi and released them at 20:40. (iii) At 17:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near the junction of Oyoun Al-Haramiyye (on Ramallah-Nablus main road) and searched civilians and vehicles. (iv) At 19:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Rantis village and impeded free flow of traffic. (v) At 19:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Ni’lin town and searched civilians and vehicles. (vi) At 20:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in front of Hashimi School east of Al-Bireh city, opened fire towards a civilian vehicle and withdrew at 21:20. (vii) At 00:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near the junction of Al-Jalazoun refugee camp and opened fire indiscriminately. • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:40, Israeli forces raided Al-Bireh city, stormed into and searched 1 civilian home and detained civilian Khaled Anbar and released him at 17:50. (ii) At 15:50, Israeli forces raided and patrolled Shuqba village. (iii) At 18:30, Israeli forces raided Lubban Al-Gharbi village, arrested 1 civilian, stormed into a garage, confiscated 1 civilian vehicle under the pretext of using it to run over 4 Israeli soldiers near ArieH settlement. (iv) At 19:35, Israeli forces raided Rantis village, stormed into a garage owned by civilian Mohammad Abdellatif Khalaf and confiscated surveillance cameras. (v) At 01:20, Israeli forces raided Ramallah city, clashed with civilians, stormed into a bookstore after damaging its door and confiscated surveillance cameras. As a result of the clashes 5 civilians were wounded. Israeli forces also arrested 1 civilian and then withdrew at 04:30. • <u>Arrests:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The civilian arrested at the entrance of Deir Dibwan is Rafiq Sbeih. (ii) The civilian arrested in Lbban Al-Gharbi village is Mohammad Abdel Halim Salem. (iii) The civilian arrested in Ramallah city is Mu’taz Abu Kweik from Qalandia in Jerusalem. (iv) The civilian arrested at the entrance of Al-Jalazoun refugee camp is Mohammad Fathi Huweidi, 15. • <u>Attacks:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:30, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Al-Jalazoun refugee camp fired live ammunition and rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and arrested 1 civilian.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (ii) At 21:425, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Nabi Saleh village opened fire indiscriminately at civilians for alleged throwing of Molotov cocktail and a military watchtower. • Settler Violence: At 15:45, Jewish settlers opened fire at civilian homes in Lubban Al-Gharbi village after an unknown person ran over 4 Israeli soldiers near Arieh settlement.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Road: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. • Raids: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:50, Israeli forces raided Al-Hafira village while escorting a bunch of Jewish settlers visiting an archaeological site, and occupied the rooftop of 1 civilian home owned by Samer Mohammad Mousa and converted it into a military post, and then withdrew at 17:00. (ii) At 02:05, Israeli forces raided Jenin city, clashed with civilians and arrested 4 civilians and then withdrew at 03:50. • Arrests: The 4 civilians arrested in Jenin city are: Abdallah Afif Zakarneh, Jumaa Bassam Jumaa Baajaqi, Silah Abdallah Khlail Zgheibi and Abdel Halim Nayef Khalil Izzedin. • Wall Gates: Israeli forces continue to close the wall gate and only allow those holding special permits to enter through it.
TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Raids: At 22:45, Israeli forces raided and patrolled Al-Fara’a village.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: At 11:15 on 10 December 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Shofa village with cement blocks. • Checkpoints: Israeli forces intensified restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Flying checkpoints: At 12:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near the junction of Al-Jaroushiyye and impeded free flow of traffic. • Raids: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 19:35, Israeli forces raided Tulkarem city and patrolled it until 20:45. (ii) At 03:35, Israeli forces raided Tulkarem city and Tulkarem refugee camp and arrested 7 civilians (including a military officer from NSF). (iii) At 06:00, Israeli forces raided Shofa village and arrested 1 civilian. • Arrests: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 20:20 on 9 December 2015, Israeli forces arrested 6 civilians (including 3 children) during a raid on Tulkarem city and Nour Shams refugee camp (as mentioned in the last report): Ibrahim Adel Ali Amar, 15, Nimer Anwar Ahmad Ibrahim, 17, Mahmoud Akram Issa Farajallah, 16, Ahmad Samir Ahmad Hamed, Ala’ Midhat Khaled and Mohammad Sami Abdelrahim Al-Akhras. (ii) The seven civilians arrested in Tulkarem city and Tulkarem refugee camp are military officer Abdelrahman Burhan Hussein Sarhan, Haitham Ahmad Mohammad Sholi, Rami Adeeb Lutfi Milhem, Mohammad Khalil Al-Shafie, Abdel Nasser Othman Tawir, Sleiman Salim Ilariyye and Fawzi Samir Saed Zbeidi. (iii) The civilian arrested in Shofa village is Badran Saleh Abdallah Saleh. • Attacks: At 12:00, Israeli forces near Kadouri University west of Tulkarem city fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun grenades and tear gas canisters towards civilians and university students for alleged stoning during a demonstration against continuous Israel attacks on Al-Aqsa mosque compound in Jerusalem, injuring 9 civilians (including 3 children): Marwan Abdelkarim Amous, 14, Ahmad Masoud Hassan Ali, 17, Mu’tasem Burham Abu Lifeh, 16, Mu’tasem Majdi Snobar, Rami Ibrahim Mohammad Ghanem, Mu’men Nabhan Jallad, Nihad Saleh Abdel Razik,

	Mahmoud Tayseer Amin Aboudi and Islam Issam Badran.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) Since 10:40 on 1 September 2015, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far'ata village which is located near "Gillad" settlement with a steel gate. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since 17 December 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. (iii) At 06:30 on 22 November 2015, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Aqraba town with Yanun village with dirt mounds. (iv) On 29 November 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Bourin, Awarta and Osrin villages and the agricultural road connecting Aqraba and Qabalan with dirt mounds. (v) At 13:00 on 1 December 2015, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Tel village with the bypass road alongside Yitzhar settlement and installed a steel gate in the place. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> At 12:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Burqa village and searched civilians and vehicles. • <u>Attacks:</u> At 16:45, Israeli forces positioned east of Iraq Bourin village fired rubber coated steel bullets, tear gas canisters and stun grenades towards civilians for alleged stoning. • <u>Confiscation of Property:</u> At 01:50, on 10 December 2015, Israeli forces confiscated a computer and CDs during a raid on Nablus city from a forum (as mentioned in the last report).
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) Since 30 July 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Naser and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 18:00, Israeli forces intensified restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> at 16:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the west

JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 11:35, Israeli forces intensified restrictions Al-Hamra checkpoint and impeded free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> At 07:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Jericho city and searched civilians and vehicles. • <u>Raids:</u> At 22:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Auja village and trolled it until 22:15. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) In the morning of 10 December 2015, Israeli forces detained at Al-Karama Crossing (Allenby) civilian Sultan Abu Al-Einein and prevented him from travelling to Jordan. (ii) At 14:10, Israeli forces detained at Al-Karama Crossing (Allenby) two civilians from Jenin and released them later: Ayman Deeb and Louai Jamil Abu Khamis.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunums of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man; a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (iv) Since 10:45 on 8 September 2015, the Israeli army agricultural road in Arab Rashaydeh near Ma'ale Amos settlement with dirt mounds. (v) At 15:30 on 20 November 2015, Israeli forces closed eastern entrance of Jinana town with dirt mounds. (vi) At 13:10, on 22 November 2015, Israeli force closed the entrance of Marah Rabah town with dirt mounds. (vii) At 18:00 on 27 November 2015, Israeli forces closed Barbara junction in Beit Jala with cement blocks. (viii) At 14:50 on 28 November 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance to Um Rukba area in Al-Khader with cement blocks. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Tamor village and searched civilians and vehicles until 12:30. (ii) At 12:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Dar Salah village on the

(ii) At 04:10, Israeli forces raided and patrolled Bethlehem city. • <u>Arrests:</u> At 02:55 on 10 December 2015, Israeli forces arrested civilian Abed Khader Masalmeh during a raid in the city (as mentioned in the last report). • <u>Attacks:</u> At 13:15, Israeli forces positioned near Aida refugee camp fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
HEBRON	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) On 15 November 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrances of Khilet Al-Mayye and Al-Deirat villages east of Yatta with cement blocks. (vi) At 14:10 on 23 November 2015, Israeli forces closed of Al-Kom village north of Beit Awwa with cement blocks. (vii) At 08:00 on 01 December 2015, Israeli forces closed the checkpoint at the entrance of Shuhada' Street and denied civilian access and changed direction of traffic. (viii) At 22:20 on 9 December 2015, Israeli forces closed road in Jaball Jales area in the old city of Hebron ands well as the Kasarat road leading to the bypass road. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Edna and searched civilians and vehicles. (ii) At 19:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint on the junction of Zif village and searched civilians and vehicles until 20:10. (iii) At 21:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in Al-Jabha area near Surif village. • <u>Raids:</u> At dawn on 10 December 2015, Israeli forces raided Yatta town and
