JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to increase its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city entrance and the entrance to the Old City. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the gate along the Wall section separating the area of Dahiyat Al-Bareed from Al-Ram town. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) At 14:05, Israeli forces increased its restrictions on Jabaa checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 16:40 (iii) Israeli forces continue to close the entrance to Shu’fat refugee camp with cement blocks, which obstructs the free flow of traffic in Ras Khamis, Ras Shihadeh and Salam neighbourhoods in Anata and Shu’fat refugee camp. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> At 15:00, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint near Jabaa village and prevented residents from entering or leaving the village; they withdrew at a later time.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 05:25, Israeli forces raided Qalandia refugee camp and detained a child. (ii) On the morning of December 12th 2011, Israeli forces raided Beit Hanina and demolished a home belonging to Al-Razem family for allegedly being built without proper licensing. • <u>Attack:</u> On the evening of December 11th 2011, Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity of Shofat refugee camp fired teargas and sound grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Mohammad Muteir (17 years) during their raid into Qalandia refugee camp. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 16:15, Israeli forces positioned at Jabaa checkpoint temporarily detained Manar Al Kurdi, a resident of Bethlehem; they released her at 16:50. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Sawahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma'ale Adumim.
RAMALLAH & AL BIREH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village as well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:30, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint near Atara. (ii) At 13:50, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Turmosayya. (iii) At 15:30, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint near Yabroud. (iv) At 15:55, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Ur Al-Tahta • <u>Raids:</u> At 02:25, Israeli forces raided El Bireh City. • <u>Attack:</u> At 12:40, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Nabi Saleh village, fired teargas grenades towards residents during the funeral of Mustafa Al-Tamimi, assaulted and assaulted several residents and injured several International peace activists. Israeli troops chased and severely beat Ahmad Al Barghouthi leaving him hospitalised with contusions. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Zabuba village. (ii) At 11:55, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Araba . (iii) At 12:00, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint between Qabatia and Masliyh villages.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (iv) At 12:20, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Jabaa junction. • Raid: (i) At 14:35, Israeli forces raided Al-Arqa village, detained, and assaulted Mohammad Waqad (12 years) at a Wall gate near “Shaqid” settlement; they released him at 17:30. (ii) At 16:30, Israeli forces raided Atrah village until 17:30. (iii) At 23:30, Israeli forces raided Yamoun, stormed 2 homes and temporarily detained 3 residents, including a security officer, and released them at a later time. • Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to restrict Palestinian access to the Northern Jordan Valley through the Tayasir checkpoint to between the hours of 06:00 and 22:00.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village and the dirt road between Shufa and Saffarin villages. • Checkpoints: At 12:20 the Israeli army increased restrictions on Palestinian access at ‘Einav checkpoint on the Tulkarem-Nablus main road and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Flying Checkpoints: (i) At 12:00, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Beit Lid junction. (ii) At 12:25, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint along Kafriyat road (connecting Tulkarem and Qalqilya). (iii) At 12:25, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint on Faroun and Kafr Sur village junction. (iv) At 13:30, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Attil. • Raids: At 01:55, Israeli forces raided Tulkarem, searched several homes, confiscated a computer and detained 2 residents. • Detentions: Israeli force detained Kifah Ghannam and Alaa Hamad during their raid into Tulkarem. • Wall Gates: Passage through the wall gates was restricted to civilians granted special permits, undercutting access to education and health services for civilians living behind the wall. • Wall Construction: Land levelling for adjustment of the Wall route continued in the area surrounding Jubara village According to an Israeli High Court decision, the new Wall route will be constructed west of the village.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Roads: (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of the town of ‘Azzun. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second <i>Intifada</i>, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • Flying checkpoints: (i) At 11:05, Israeli forces setup a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Qalqilya. (ii) At 14:00, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Jit village junction. • Raid: (i) At 15:20, Israeli forces raided Azzoun until 17:30 .

QALQILYA	<p>(ii) At 16:10, Israeli forces raided Kafr Thulth.</p> <p>(iii) At 01:25, Israeli forces raided Azzoun.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wall Gates: <p>(i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector.</p> <p>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al-Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras ‘Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.</p> • Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in Kafr Laqef village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Imanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma’ale Shomron settlement and between Azzun Atma and Oriniet settlement .
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <p>(i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Till-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin.</p> <p>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut.</p> • Checkpoints: <p>(i) Al-Tur neighbourhood checkpoint (set up on Jerzim Mount) is closed on Fridays and Saturdays as well as during Jewish holidays. On all other days, it is open between 07:00 and, 02:00</p> <p>(ii) At ‘Awarta commercial checkpoint, civilians are only allowed to cross between 05:00 and 20:00, and between 05:00 and 15:00 on Fridays. All vehicles can access the city of Nablus, but only commercial vehicles and ambulances can leave the city through the checkpoint.</p> <p>(iii) At 12:00, Israeli forces increased its restrictions at “Shave Shomron” checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic</p> • Flying Checkpoints: <p>(i) At 10:05, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Yitsahar settlement junction</p> <p>(ii) At 10:20, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Deir Sharaf junction.</p> <p>(iii) At 10:40, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint near Surra village junction.</p> <p>(iv) At 11:15, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Beit Furik junction.</p> <p>(v) At 12:55, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint along Al-Bathan road.</p> <p>(vi) At 15:00, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Qusin village junction.</p> • Raids: At 14:20, Israeli forces raided the eastern neighbourhoods of Nablus. • Settler Violence: <p>(i) At 04:00, a group of Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli troops stoned several homes, destroying several windows. The damaged homes belong to Khalil Saleh, Bassam Saleh, Abdel Fatah Ahmad, Ibrahim Makhlouf and Abdel Baset Ahmad; a vehicle belonging to Abdel Rahman Ahmad was also damaged by Israeli troops, who fired sound grenades towards residents while escorting the settlers.</p> <p>(ii) At 01:30, a group of Israeli settlers raided the outskirts of Orif village, stormed</p>

	<p>the home of Jamal Shihadeh and withdrew under the protection of Israeli troops.</p>
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) Since 14 November 2010, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian buses only. The entrance had been closed for seven years, and at 08:30, Israeli forces closed the entrance and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Checkpoints: The Israeli army increased its restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Flying Checkpoints: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:20, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the western entrances of Deir Istiya. (ii) At 12:15, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Kafil Harres. • Raids: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:40, Israeli forces raided Deir Istiya. (ii) At 12:15, Israeli forces raided Kafil Harres until 12:40. (iii) At 13:00, Israeli forces raided Harres village. (iv) At 20:00, Israeli forces raided Qarwat Bani Hassan and served Yousef Mari, Azam Mari , Nader Mari and Ibrahim Assi notices to halt farming their land at the eastern outskirts of the village • Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Road: The Israeli army continues to close Road # 90 between Jericho city and Al-Oja village with cement blocks. • Checkpoints: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to restrict access through Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus Districts, only allowing access to residents of Jericho District and the Jordan Valley area and at 12:55, Israeli forces closed the checkpoint, impeding the free flow of traffic for allegedly conducting a military training exercise in the area; they reopened it at 17:00. (ii) Israeli forces continue to intensify its restrictions at the checkpoint set up on the junction to Al-Ouja village, only allowing access to residents of the Jericho District and others with access permits. • Flying Checkpoints: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:00 and at 00:25 and again at 07:00, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the southern entrance of Jericho city. (ii) At 10:10, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint along Al-Muarrajat road (connecting Jericho and Ramallah) • Raid: At 22:15, Israeli forces raided Al-Oja village until 23:45.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 <i>dunums</i> of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities.

(ii) At 08:45, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Jinata . (iii) At 09:00, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint near Al-Faradis village. (iv) At 09:15, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint in Osh Al-Ghurab area, east of Beit Sahour. (v) At 14:40, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the western entrance of Taqou. (iv) At 01:50, Israeli forces raided Al-Ubeidiya until 02:40. (v) At 02:40, Israeli forces raided Bethlehem and served Samer Hijazi and Husam Abdallah summons for questioning by Israeli intelligence. • Detentions: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:25, Israeli forces positioned at the "Container" checkpoint detained Anas Abu Daya, a Bethlehem resident, and served his brother Ahmad a summon for questioning by Israeli intelligence (ii) At 15:10, Israeli forces detained Anas Ramadan and Alaa Al-Amouyi when they reported to Israeli intelligence agency • Settlement Activity: On December 11th 2011, the Israeli government approved the construction of 40 illegal housing units for the purpose of expanding "Efrat" settlement on land belonging to Al-Kahder and Al-Dheisheh refugee camp in Bethlehem, • Wall Construction: Wall construction continued northwest of Beit Jala town.

<p style="text-align: center;">Hebron</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Dhahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to the entrance to Al-Simiya village (v) Since 15. 10. 2011, Israeli forces closed two entrances leading to Beit Ummar town. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 16:45, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Awa and detained a minor. (ii) At 21:00, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Burj village. (iii) At 07:50, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the northern entrance of Hebron • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:25, Israeli forces raided Samou. (ii) At 11:20 and again at 24:00, Israeli forces raided Hebron city, stormed a carpenter workshop and several shops, while also setting up a flying checkpoint and served summons to several residents to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning; they also detained a resident. (iii) At 17:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Ramadin village and detained 4 residents. (iv) At 02:30, Israeli forces raided Yatta And Al-Thahiriya. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 06:10, Israeli forces detained Imad Abu Rumeileh, a resident of Hebron, when he reported to Israeli intelligence for questioning. (ii) Israeli forces positioned at a checkpoint near Beit Awa detained Oday Masalma (17 years). (iii) Israeli forces detained Haroun Al-Turki during their raid into Hebron. (iv) Israeli forces detained Bashar Amro, Fadi Al-Sous, Mazen Odeh and Muhib Habash during their raid into Al-Ramadin village. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahiriya town.

<p style="text-align: center;">ALL DISTRICTS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 02:00 on 18 January 2009, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. The ceasefire has been further renewed on 30 October 2011 at 22:00. • Palestinian gunmen broke the cease fire agreement by launching projectiles towards targets behind the Green Line.
<p style="text-align: center;">NORTHERN GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanun (Erez) is closed.
<p style="text-align: center;">GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Points:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. • <u>Aerial Surveillance:</u> At noon on December 11th 2011, Israeli jets flew over northern neighbourhoods of Gaza and broke the sound barrier. • <u>Palestinian Attack:</u> At dawn on December 12th 2011, Palestinian gunmen launched projectiles towards targets behind the Green Line.
<p style="text-align: center;">RAFAH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Points:</u> • <u>Yasser 'Arafat International Airport</u> remains closed. • Rafah (<i>Al 'Awdah</i>) Crossing is open for critically ill patients, students and residents with special permits • Sufa Crossing is closed. • Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is partially open for the transportation of food supplies, goods, humanitarian aid, and cooking gas. In addition, construction material designated to internationally funded projects and 28 truckloads of wheat were allowed to enter while 8 shipments of strawberries were allowed out for export.
