All Districts	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> On December 10th 2014, Palestinian President Mahmoud Abbas issued a decree for 3 days of National mourning over the killing of Palestinian Authority Minister Ziyad Mohammad Ahmad Abu Ein at the hands of Israeli forces during his participation in a peace full event of planting Olive trees near land under threat of Israeli confiscation in Turmus'aya village in Ramallah and Al-Bireh district.

JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <u>Closure:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 40 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. At 17:00, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Jaba' checkpoint and impeded the free flow of Traffic. <u>Raid:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> At 03:00 on December 11th 2014, Israeli forces raided Biddu and detained a resident. At dawn December 12th 2014, Israeli forces raided Al-Eisawiya, clashed with several residents as they stormed several homes. <u>Detention:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> At 17:45, Israeli forces positioned at Qalandiya checkpoint detained the child: Yathrib Abdel-Rahman (16 years old){ A resident of Beit Duquq} after Israeli forces sprayed pepper spray onto his face which left him suffocated with burnt eyes for allegedly attempting to stab an Israeli soldier. Israeli forces detained Mohammad Azzam in Al-Jadira village. <u>Attack:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> At 11:20, Israeli forces positioned at Qalandiya checkpoint fired, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (ii) At 14:00, Israeli forces positioned at Salah Al-Din road in Jerusalem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iii) At 14:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Anata fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iv) At 16:00, Israeli forces positioned in Beit Hanina fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (v) At 20:15, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Hizma village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:00, Israeli forces detained Nael Jabarin in Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem. (ii) At 14:00, Israeli force detained Mohammad Aliwat in Al-Thuri neighbourhood in Jerusalem. (iii) At 14:00, Israeli forces detained Ahmad Abi Odeh in Wadi Al-Juz neighbourhood in Jerusalem. (iv) At dawn on December 12th 2014, Israeli forces detained Abed Dandis in Ras Al-Amoud neighbourhood. (v) At dawn on December 12th 2014, Israeli forces detained four residents: Ali Awisat, Mohammad Khadr, Sa'ed Abu Jamal and Rif'at Al-Khatib in Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood in Jerusalem. (vi) Israeli forces detained Musa Zahran in Biddu. (vii) Israeli forces detained four residents: Tariq Darwish, Ali Darwish, Yunis Aliyan and Ahmad Mahmoud in Al-Eisawiya. (viii) Israeli forces positioned at Qalandiya checkpoint detained Mohammad Badran and Firas Badran. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> On the morning of December 11th 2014, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshippers. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

(iii) Since 11:30 on October 27th 2014, Israeli forces blocked the main road near Al-Jalazoun camp and Bet El settlement with cement blocks. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Um Safa village. (ii) At 19:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Turmus'aya until 21:00. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:00, Israeli forces raided Turmus'aya. (ii) At 15:45, Israeli forces raided Al-Bireh city until 16:00. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:00, Israeli forces positioned near Atara Bridge in North Bir Zeit fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

	<p>(ii) At 11:20, Israeli forces positioned near “Pesagout” settlement located in east Al-Bireh city, near Abboud junction, near the entrance of Al-Nabi Saleh village and at the entrance of Ofar military base fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 2 residents: Tariq Jabr (A resident of Abboud) and Islam Al-Tamimi (A resident of Al-Nabi Saleh village).</p> <p>(iii) At 17:05, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Turmus’aya fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</p> <p>(iv) At 17:30, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in South Al-Bireh city stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</p>
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 03:00, Israeli forces raided Deir Ghazaleh village. (ii) At 05:15, Israeli forces raided Burqin, detained a resident then withdrew at 05:40. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Wissam Martadi in Burqin.
TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Attouf village until 15:00. (ii) At 20:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Al-Far’a village and detained the Police officer Amin Rabah Bani Oda. • <u>Physical Assault:</u> At 07:50, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Baqi’a area assaulted Mohammad Bani Odeh (A resident of Tamoun) as he was herding his goats.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Raid:</u> At 01:55, Israeli forces raided Tulkarem.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 20:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Izbit Al-Tabib village until 21:45. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 14:20, Israeli forces positioned near agricultural land in the area between Azzun and Kafr Lafiq village temporarily detained two children: Ahmad Salim (13 years old) and Osama Suwadin (13 years old) then released them at 14:50. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. At 14:00, Israeli forces closed the iron gate entrance then reopened it at 14:25 The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access.

	<p>(ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.</p>
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • Closure of Main Roads: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • Flying Checkpoint: At 17:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Osarin village. • Raid: At 01:35, Israeli forces raided Tel village, detained two residents then withdrew at 02:25. • Detention: Israeli forces detained Moath Ishtaya and Majd Ishtaya in Tel village. • Attack: At 14:35, Israeli forces positioned near Jabal Jadou’ and the area located in between Beit Furiq and “Yatamar” settlement fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama’ located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • Checkpoints: Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za’tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: At 12:00 on December 10th 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Fasayil village for alleged Military purposes for a period of 40 days. • Checkpoints: Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • Flying Checkpoint: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:30, again at 17:10 and at 22:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along road (90) near Al-Nuwe’meh village located in North Jericho until 23:30. (ii) At 14:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Jericho until 16:50. • Temporary Detention: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:10, Israeli forces positioned at Allenby Bridge temporarily detained Nathmi Badran (A Presidential Guard) as he was returning from Jordan then released him at 13:25. (ii) At 16:25, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Hambrah checkpoint temporarily detained Waleed Al-Kaliya until 16:45.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu’mān village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the

village.

- (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunums of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities.

• **Closure of Main Roads:**

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks.
- (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.
- (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires.
- (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds.
- (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.
- (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.
- (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.

• **Flying Checkpoint:**

- (i) At 14:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the North entrance of Taqou', temporarily detained Billal Badan nand released him later then withdrew at 14:50.
- (ii) At 18:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Ush Al-Ghurab area in east Beit Sahur until 19:00.
- (iii) At 20:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Husan village until 21:35.
- (iv) At 20:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Beit Ta'mar village until 21:35.

• **Raid:**

- (i) At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Shwarah village and detained a resident.
- (ii) At 02:40, Israeli forces raided Al-Ayda camp in Bethlehem and detained two residents.

• **Detention:**

- (i) Israeli forces detained Adel Salamah in Al-Shuwarah village.
- (ii) Israeli forces detained two residents: Shadi Abu Aker and Ibrahim Sarour in Al-Ayda camp in Bethlehem.

- **Settler Violence:** On December 11th 2014, a group of Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces closed a bypass road in Al-Shafa' area located in south Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.

HEBRON

- **Closure:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
 - (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.
- **Closure of Main Roads:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
 - (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
 - (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
 - (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- **Flying Checkpoint:**
 - (i) At 10:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Halhul Bridge.
 - (ii) At 15:00, Israeli forces set up three checkpoints at the North entrance of Hebron, at the entrance of Beit Awwa and at Beit Einun village junction.
 - (iii) At 17:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Fuwar camp and detained a resident.
- **Attack:**
 - (i) At 08:20, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Shuhada' road in the old city of Hebron fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
 - (ii) At 16:00, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Tabaqa village junction fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
 - (iii) At 20:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Beit Ummar and Al-Urub camp fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- **Detention:**
 - (i) At 03:05 on December 11th 2014, Israeli forces detained 2 residents: Mohammad Musa Mohammad and Ayed Abu Rish during their raid into Dura as mention in the previous report.
 - (ii) Israeli forces positioned near Al-Fuwar Camp detained Musa Tubasi (A resident of Al-Rahaya village).
 - (iii) Israeli forces detained two resident: Jihad Al-Alami and Billal Al-Alami at the entrance of Beit Ummar.
- **Physical Assault:** At 22:15, Israeli forces positioned near Beit Awwa junction assaulted Mohammad Abu Atwan and as a result, left him hospitalised with contusions.
- **Settler Violence:** At 10:30, a group of Israeli settlers positioned near road (600 in North Hebron stoned residents and vehicles.

GAZA STRIP

ALL DISTRICTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month.
NORTHERN GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businesspersons and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination.
GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Closure of Crossing Points: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. Al-Shija'iyah (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
RAFAH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Closure of Crossing Points : <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. Rafah (<i>Al 'Awdah</i>) Crossing is closed. Sufa Crossing is closed. Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is open for the entry of tourist and foreign diplomats and the entry of Humanitarian assistance and construction material funded by UNRWA.
