(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikxa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the gate along the Wall section separating the area of Dahiyat Al-Bareed from Al-Ram town. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikxa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. RAMALLAH & AL BIREH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village as well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages. • Flying Checkpoints: At 10:40, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Rima. • Raids: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 17:00, Israeli forces raided Kharbatha Al Misbah village, closed the village entrance with a flying checkpoint and searched several homes. (ii) At 04:45, Israeli forces raided Ramallah, detained 2 residents and confiscated a cellular phone. • Detention: Israeli forces detained Ra'fat Iftayil and Faek Iftayil during their raid into Ramallah. • Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Road: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. • Flying Checkpoints: At 16:30, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Zabauba village. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces raided Sanur village, opened fire and withdrew at 14:00. (ii) At 14:50, Israeli forces raided Sir village until 17:00. (iii) At 02:30, Israeli forces raided Jenin refugee camp, searched several homes, confiscated a computer, detained 3 residents and summoned Muayad Al-Amar to Israeli intelligence for questioning. • Detention: Israeli forces detained Mahmoud Mathan, Abdel Salam Abu Hijiyeh and Hamza Abu Hijiyeh during their raid into Jenin refugee camp. • Settler violence: At 14:10, a group of Israeli settlers raided the previously abandoned settlement of "Homesh", stoned and threw glass towards Palestinian vehicles and residents driving on the Jenin-Nablus road. • Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to restrict Palestinian access to the Northern Jordan Valley through the Tayasir checkpoint to between the hours of 06:00 and 22:00. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 17:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Aqba village. (ii) At 00:55, Israeli forces raided Al-Faraa refugee camp and detained a resident. • Detention: Israeli forces detained Ashraf Sufatat during their raid into Al-Faraa refugee camp.

TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village and the dirt road between Shufa and Saffarin villages. • Checkpoints: The Israeli army intensified its restrictions on Palestinian access at 'Einav checkpoint on the Tulkarem-Nablus main road and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Raids: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:20, Israeli forces raided Tulkarem and Kafr Al-Labbad village. (ii) At 16:40, Israeli forces raided Beit Lid and stormed a shop. • Wall Gates: Passage through the wall gates was restricted to civilians granted special permits, undercutting access to education and health services for civilians living behind the wall. • Wall Construction: Land levelling for adjustment of the Wall route continued in the area surrounding Jubara village According to an Israeli High Court decision, the new Wall route will be constructed west of the village.
QALQILYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of the town of 'Azzun. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second <i>Intifada</i>, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • Flying checkpoints: At 23:25, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Jit village junction. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:50, Israeli forces raided Hablah, Ras Atiya and Azzun Atma villages . (ii) At 16:20 and again at 20:20, Israeli forces raided Qalqilya, detained 3 residents, including 2 minors, and temporarily detained Musa Sabri. • Detention: Israeli forces detained Abdallah Daoud, (17 years), Omar Baker (17 years) and Yahya Noufal. • Settler violence: At 22:00, a group of Israeli settlers stoned Palestinian vehicles driving on the Qalqilya–Nablus road, damaging vehicles owned by Anwar Kaabi and Odeh Ramadin, residents of Al-Ramadin village, and injuring 3 passengers: Sanaa Rayan and her daughter Israa, residents of Qarwat Bani Hassan in Salfit and Mohammad Khleif, a resident of Al-Nabi Eliyas village in Qalqilya. • Wall Gates: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al-Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras 'Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in Kafr Laqef village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Imanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma'ale Shomron settlement and between Azzun Atma and Oriniet settlement .

On all other days, it is open between 07:00 and 02:00</p> <p>(ii) At 'Awarta commercial checkpoint, civilians are only allowed to cross between 05:00 and 20:00, and between 05:00 and 15:00 on Fridays. SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <p>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland.</p> <p>(ii) Since 14 November 2010, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian buses only. The entrance had been closed for seven years, and at 08:30, Israeli forces closed the entrance and impeded the free flow of traffic.</p> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> The Israeli army increased its restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <p>(i) At 10:05, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the northern entrance of Salfit.</p> <p>(ii) At 13:45, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the western entrance of Kafil Harres.</p> <p>(iii) At 20:30, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Qarwat Bani Hassan village.</p> • <u>Raids:</u> At 16:25, Israeli forces raided Kafil Harres until 16:45.

(ii) Israeli forces continues to intensify its restrictions at the checkpoint set up on the junction to Al-Ouja village, only allowing access to residents of the Jericho District and others with access permits. • Flying Checkpoints: At 17:05, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the southern entrance of Jericho city. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:45, Israeli forces raided Al Jiftlik village, served military orders for the demolition of 3 homes owned by Ayman Idiyes, Mohammad Abu Haniya and Amer Abu Haniya , (ii) At 22:20 Israeli forces raided Al-Oja village.

(ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 <i>dunums</i> of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road east of Beit Fajjar town; the road connecting Tuqu' town to Khirbet al Baq'a village; and the detour road connecting Wadi Fukin and Al Jab'a villages. • Checkpoint: At 20:15 Israeli army continues to restrict access at the "Container" checkpoint, temporarily detained 20 residents and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Flying Checkpoint: At 17:35, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Al-Nashash junction. • Raids: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:35, Israeli forces raided Al-Jab-a, assaulted and injured 5 school children: Omar Hamdan (17 years), Mohammad Masalma (15 years), Omar Masalma (15 years), Ali Hamdan (15 years) and Mohammad Hamdan (17 years); all sustained moderate injuries. (ii) At 18:50, Israeli forces raided Harmala and fired sound grenades. (iii) At 04:20, Israeli forces raided Beit Fajjar, searched a home and detained a resident . (iv) At 04:25, Israeli forces raided Beit Sahur . • Detentions: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) In addition to what was mentioned in the previous, report at 01:50 on December 12th 2011, Israeli forces detained Mutasib Al-Asa during their raid into Yaabad (ii) Israeli forces detained Yousef Thawabteh during their raid into Beit Fajjar

HEBRON	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Dhahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to the entrance to Al-Simiya village (v) Since 15. 10. 2011, Israeli forces closed two entrances leading to Beit Ummar town. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:10, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Samou village and detained a child. (ii) At 20:15, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint near Abu Hadid area in Hebron's Old City. • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:50, Israeli forces raided Beit Ummar. (ii) At 17:15, Israeli forces raided Hebron city,. • <u>Detention:</u> In Addition to detentions mentioned in the previous report, Israeli forces detained Shams Al-Din Al-Kurki during their raid into Hebron at 24:00 on December 11th 2011. • <u>Settler violence:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:20, a group of Israeli settlers raided land owned by Al Hilies Family in north Yatta. (ii) At 24:00, a group of settlers stoned homes in Al Buwier area located north of Hebron. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahiriya town.

The ceasefire has been further renewed on 30 October 2011 at 22:00. • Israeli forces broke the ceasefire agreement by raiding Central Gaza and North Gaza and opening fire in addition to Israeli naval vessels opening fire towards Palestinian fishermen, injuring 2 fishermen, including a child, off the shores of North Gaza. • Palestinian Gunmen broke the cease fire agreement by launching projectiles towards targets behind the Green Line.
<p style="text-align: center;">NORTHERN GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of patients, journalists, NGO staff, merchants and passengers travelling through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination. • Attack: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:30 on December 11th 2011, Israeli forces from their positions behind the Green Line opened fire towards residents in Beit Hanoun. (ii) At 17:00 on December 11th 2011, Israeli naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishermen off the Shores of Beit Lahia in North Gaza. (iii) At 06:45 on December 12th 2011, Israeli naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishermen off the Shores of Beit Lahia in North Gaza. (iv) On the morning of December 13th 2011, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line opened fire towards Beit Hanoun, injuring a child. • Palestinian Attack: At 23:30, Palestinian gunmen launched projectiles towards targets behind the Green Line.
