Settler violence: At 14:10, a group of Israeli settlers raided the previously abandoned settlement of "Homesh", stoned and threw glass towards Palestinian vehicles and residents driving on the Jenin-Nablus road. Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.

- Since 14 November 2010, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to (ii) Salfit city to civilian buses only. The entrance had been closed for seven years, and at 08:30, Israeli forces closed the entrance and impeded the free flow of traffic.
- **Checkpoints:** The Israeli army increased its restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic.



• Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is partially open for the transportation of food supplies, goods, humanitarian aid cooking gas. In addition to 50 truckloads of livestock feed, 20 imported vehicles, and construction cargo designated to internationally-funded projects. Also, the export of 8 shipments of strawberries was allowed.
