<p style="text-align: center;">JERUSALEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city for the alleged stabbing of an Israeli settler. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikse villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikse village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and impeded the free flow of traffic. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Attack:</u> On the evening of December 13th 2014, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Tur neighbourhood fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and detained two residents. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 23:00, Israeli forces positioned at a checkpoint detained two residents: Mohammad Adwan (A resident of Qalandiya camp) after allegedly finding an M-16 assault rifle in his vehicle. (ii) At dawn on December 14th 2014, Israeli forces positioned in Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood detained two residents: Ramzi Odwan and Alaa Awisat. (iii) Israeli forces detained two residents: Fadi Al-Sayad and Omran Rabay’a in Al-Tur neighbourhood. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
<p style="text-align: center;">RAMALLAH & AL BIREH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and ‘Ein Samiya villages. (ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of

	<p>Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 19:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Deir Abu Mash'al village. (ii) At 19:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Deir Nathim village. • <u>Attack:</u> At 12:20, Israeli forces positioned near Ofar Military base/ Prison fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 2 residents: Hassan Al-Rifati and Mohammad Khalil and also detained a University student. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Leenah Khattab at the entrance of Ofar Military Base/ Prison. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 16:25, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of "Bet El" settlement stoned residents and vehicles passing along the main road leading to Al-Jalazoun camp.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad.
TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 14:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Tamoun and Khirbeit Attouf village. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> On December 11th 2014, Israeli settlers positioned near "Migola" settlement and under the protection of Israeli forces levelled, a plot of land near the settlement after the Israeli military prevented its Palestinian owners from entering their farm land by declaring it a closed Military zone.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at "Eniv" checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Raid:</u> At 18:15, Israeli forces raided Zietta until 19:30.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 11:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya, the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area.

<p style="text-align: center;">NABLUS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 12:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Burin village junction, temporarily detained 2 residents including a child: Ameer Qatani (16 years old) and Ahmad Hindi for allegedly finding a steel object in their possession then released them at 15:00 • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 16:15, Israeli forces raided Tel village, stormed and searched a home. (ii) At 01:20, Israeli forces raided Assirah Al-Shimaliya and summoned Amjad Sawalmah to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 02:50. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 09:50, Israeli settlers stormed agricultural land in Yanoun village, attempted to chase away several Sheppard’s in the area during which they withdrew under the protection of Israeli forces at 11:15.
<p style="text-align: center;">SALFIT</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama’ located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces closed Za’tara checkpoint, impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:30, a group of Israeli settlers positioned near Za’tara checkpoint stoned residents and vehicles passing through the checkpoint. (ii) At 23:20, a group of Israeli settlers positioned along the main road between Za’tara checkpoint and Jama’in stoned residents and vehicles and as a result damaged the windshield of a vehicle owned by Muhanad Assad (A resident of Jama’in in Nablus).
<p style="text-align: center;">JERICHO</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restriction at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 07:20, on December 13th 2014, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the Dead Sea junction until 07:50. (ii) At 21:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the North entrance of Jericho.
<p style="text-align: center;">BETHLEHEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu’mān village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds. (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 20:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Taqou until 22:50. (ii) At 23:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in Ush Al-Ghurab area located in east Beit Sahur until 00:15. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 19:40, Israeli forces raided Al-Abiyat area in Bethlehem, set up a checkpoint, fired stun grenades towards several residents and withdrew at 20:25. (ii) At 02:05, Israeli forces raided Al-Duhisheh and Al-Ayda camps in Bethlehem, clashed with several residents as they stormed homes, detained a resident in Al-Duheshieh camp and summoned Amaar Abu Aker to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning. (iii) At 02:50, Israeli forces raided Beit Fajjar and summoned Zeyad Taqatqa to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Oday Hamash Al-Duheshieh camp. • <u>Demonstration:</u> At 10:50, a demonstration took place near Al-Nafaq checkpoint in North –West Beit Jallah protesting the murder of Palestinian Minister Ziyad Mohammad Ahmad Abu Ein, head of the PLO's Commission Against the Separation Wall and Settlements who was killed by Israeli forces (as he was participating in an Olive tree planting event in east Turmus'aya) during which Israeli forces prevented resident from reaching the checkpoint and assaulted them as well as injuring Yusef Abu Mariya who was beat unconscious by Israeli forces.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to

closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.

- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.
 - **Closure of Main Roads:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
 - (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
 - (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
 - (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
 - (vi) On September 4th 2014, Israeli forces closed a road in Eiw Al-Bas and Al-Bayda and Al-Ras area in Ithna located near the wall gate.
 - (vii) At 13:40 on September 16th 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Al-Ibrahim mosque in the old city of Hebron.
 - **Flying Checkpoint:** At 18:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Fuwar camp.
 - **Raid:**
 - (i) At 02:00 on December 13th 2014, Israeli forces raided Beit Ummar and summoned three residents: Yusef Sabarnah, Wahid Abu Mariya and Shadi Bahar to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning.
 - (ii) At 01:10, Israeli forces raided Zif village.
 - (iii) At 01:45, Israeli forces raided Hebron.
 - (iv) At 02:05, Israeli forces raided Nuba and stormed several homes.
 - (v) At 02:20, Israeli forces raided Dura, clashed with several residents as they stormed several homes and detained two residents.
 - **Detention:** Israeli forces detained two residents: Hammad Al-Zir and Ayman Al-Darabi' in Dura.
 - **Settler Violence:** At 19:30, a group of Israeli settlers positioned along road (60) located near Kiryat Arraba' settlement in the old city of Hebron stoned residents and vehicles then withdrew at 21:40.

<p style="text-align: center;">ALL DISTRICTS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month. • Israeli forces broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire towards North Gaza. • Israeli Naval vessels broke the cease-fire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of North Gaza.
<p style="text-align: center;">NORTHERN GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is closed. • Attack: On the evening of December 13th 2014, Israeli Naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Beit Lahiya. • Injury: On the afternoon of December 12th 2014, Israeli forces opened fire from their position behind the Green Line towards agricultural land in east Jabaliya and injured four residents: Khaled NimNim, Shadi Al-Madhoun, Ahmad Abu Ghouri and Ahmad Abarayri as mentioned in the previous report.
<p style="text-align: center;">GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Points: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iyah (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
<p style="text-align: center;">RAFAH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Points : <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. (ii) Rafah (<i>Al 'Awdah</i>) Crossing is closed. (iii) Sufa Crossing is closed. (iv) Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is closed.
