WEST BANK

Closure:

- On 28 November 2015, the Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the (i) entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound which forced residents to conduct prayers near checkpoints located outside Al-Agsa mosque compound.
- The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in (ii) the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem according to Military Order 09/02S and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- Israeli forces continue to close the hill between Biddo and Beit Iksa villages (iii) and deny civilian access.

Closure of Main Roads:

- The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the (i) entrance to Jaba' village.
- The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to (ii) Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.
- (iii) On 16 November 2015, Israeli forces closed the southern entrance of Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood leading to Armon Hanatsif settlement with cement blocks.

Checkpoints:

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Oalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. At 22:40, Israeli forces closed Qalandiya checkpoint claiming unidentified persons have opened fire towards Israeli soldiers positioned at the checkpoint.
- (ii) On 19 September 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- (iii) At 00:10, Israeli forces intensified restriction at Jabaa checkpoint on the road connecting Jerusalem, Ramallah and Jericho and denied civilian access.

- (i) At 11:45, Israeli forces arrested 2 civilians from Hizma village after opening fire at and chasing a vehicle between Jabaa and Hizma villages. The civilians are: Mohammad Abboud Abu Khalil and Loaui Hani Sbeih.
- On 13 December 2015, Israeli forces arrested civilian Ismail Jaber Al-Omsi (ii) from Yatta at Jabaa checkpoint.
- At 19:00, Israeli forces arrested civilian Shadi Halaqya on the main road near (iii) Maale Adumim settlement.
- Attacks: At 15:50, Israeli forces near the north entrance of Al-ram town fired tear gas canisters and stun grenades towards civilians for alleged stoning.
- Home Occupation: On 13 December 2015, Israeli forces delivered orders for the eviction of 3 apartments in Batn Al-Hawa in Silwan owned by Youssef Basbous and 8 of his brothers. They were given 20 days for the eviction. Also Israeli forces delivered order for the eviction of a building in Al-Hara Al-Wusta owned by the sons of the deceased Jaber Abdelfattah Al-Rajabi for the benefit of Jewish settlers.
- Attacks on Places of Worship: at 11:00, Jewish settlers backed up by Israeli forces raided the compound of Al-Aqsa Mosque and provoked worshippers.

Wall Gates:

(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu

RAMALLAH & AL BIREH	 Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages On 3 October 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road located near "Bet El" settlement and leading to Al-Jalazoun camp with cement blocks. On 24 November 2015, Israeli forces closed the main entrance gate leading to Sinjil and the east entrance of Mughier with cement blocks. At 18:50 on 4 December 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Abboud town with dirt mounds. Flying Checkpoints: At 08:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Nabi Saleh village, closed metal gate and impeded free flow of traffics and denied civilian access. The gate was reopened at a later time. At 14:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Atara Bridge and searched civilians and vehicles. At 19:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Um Safa village and searched civilians and vehicles. Raids: At 07:35 on 13 December 2015, Israeli forces raided Ramallah city and patrolled it until 05:50. Arrests: At 07:35 on 13 December 2015, Israeli forces arrested civilian Maher Nader Abdel Ghani. Temporary Detention: At 07:40, Israeli forces detained 2 children near Al-Janiye village, physically attacked them and released them at a later time. The children are: Youssef Mohammad Shabayeh, 17, and Yazan Ayman Mazloum, 17. 			
	 Attacks: At 13:40, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Al-Janiye village fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards civilians for alleged stoning, injuring civilian Abdel Majeed Mazloum, 70. Several civilians were suffocated as a result of tear gas inhalation. Settler violence: At 22:00, armed Jewish settlers assembled at the west entrance of Silwad town and opened fire indiscriminately. 			
JENIN	 Closure of Main Road: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. Settler violence: At 22:50, Jewish settlers raided the previously evacuated settlement of Tarsala and withdrew at 02:00 upon the intervention of Israeli forces. Wall Gates: Israeli forces continue to close the wall gate and only allow those holding special permits to enter through it. 			
TULKAREM	 <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified restrictions at "Eniv" checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic. <u>Confiscation of Property:</u> At 02:00 on 13 December 2015, Israel forces confiscated during a raid on Tulkarem (as mentioned in the previous report) surveillance cameras of a car exhibition owned by civilian said Ghazi Said Qatawi, and raided and searched Zeinat gas station. 			
	Closure of Roads: (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town.			
QALQILIYA	(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern			

entrance to Kafr Qaddum village.

(iii) Since 10:40 on 1 September 2015, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far'ata village which is located near "Gillad" settlement with a steel gate.

• Flying Checkpoints:

- (i) At 16:30, Israeli forces set up 3 checkpoints at the east entrance of Qalqilya city, near Azzun town (on Qalqilya-Nablus main road) and near the junction of Jinasaphot village, and searched civilians and vehicles until 22:50.
- (ii) At 18:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Qalqilya city and arrested 1 civilian.
- Raids: At 01:45, Israeli forces raided Jayyous town, stormed 8 civilian homes and summoned civilian Mustafa Hassan Salim to report to the military intelligence, and then withdrew at 04:20.
- Arrests: The civilian arrested east of Qalqilya city is Omar Shaher Al-Siddeh.

• Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access.
- (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
- <u>Closure:</u> Since 17 December 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Oarvut.
- (iii) At 06:30 on 22 November 2015, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Agraba town with Yanun village with dirt mounds.
- (iv) On 29 November 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Bourin, Awarta and Osrin villages and the agricultural road connecting Aqraba and Qabalan with dirt mounds.
- (v) At 13:00 on 1 December 2015, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Tel village with the bypass road alongside Yitzhar settlement and installed a steel gate in the place.
- <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 13:05, Israeli forces intensified restrictions at Beit Fourik checkpoint and impeded free flow of traffic.

• Flying Checkpoints:

- (i) At 09:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Madama village and searched civilians and vehicles.
- (ii) At 19:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near the junction of Lubban al-Gharbi village, arrested 1 civilian, detained 1 civilian called Mohammad Ziyad Talat Daoud from Qalqilya and released him at 22:50.
- Raids: At 24:00, Israeli forces raided Nablus city and Balata refugee camp while escorting Jewish settlers visiting Joseph's tomb, clashed with civilians and injured civilian Issa Nazmi Mahmoud Hashash from balata refugee camp, stormed 2

- (i) At 09:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Deir Salah village on the east entrance of Beit Sahour. The checkpoint was set up again at 11:30 and Israeli forces searched civilians and vehicles until 16:50.
- (ii) At 09:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Um Salmouna village and searched civilians and vehicles.
- (iii) At 20:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Khirbet Al-Deir village and searched civilians and vehicles until 23:35.

• Raids:

- (i) At 01:25, Israeli forces raided Teqoa town, stormed 2 civilian homes and withdrew at 03:00.
- (ii) At 02:05, Israeli forces raided Beit Fajjar town and searched civilians and vehicles until 03:00.
- Attacks: At 19:05, Israeli forces positioned at the west entrance of Husan village fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) On 15 November 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrances of Khilet Al-Mayye and Al-Deirat villages east of Yatta with cement blocks.

HEBRON

- (vi) At 14:10 on 23 November 2015, Israeli forces closed of Al-Kom village north of Beit Awwa with cement blocks.
- (vii)At 08:00 on 01 December 2015, Israeli forces closed the checkpoint at the entrance of Shuhada' Street and denied civilian access and changed direction of traffic.
- (viii) At 22:20 on 9 December 2015, Israeli forces closed road in Jaball Jales area in the old city of Hebron ands well as the Kasarat road leading to the bypass road.
- (ix) At 16:00 on 11 December 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Sair town with dirt mounds.

• Flying Checkpoints:

- (i) At 07:40 on 13 December 2015, Israeli forces set up 2 checkpoints in Hawawreh area (north entrance of Halhul) and at the north entrance of Hebron city and searched civilians and vehicles
- (ii) At 20:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in Al-Fahs area south of Hebron city, opened fire indiscriminately and fired illumination flares, shut down the entrance and reopened it at a later time.

• Raids:

- (i) At dawn on 13 December 2015, Israeli forces raided Dura town and arrested 1 civilian.
- (ii) At 00:55, Israeli forces raided Hebron city, arrested 1 civilians 9incouding 1 woman) and withdrew at 04:00.
- (iii) At 01:00, Israeli forces raided Beit Awwa town, stormed 2 civilian homes, arrested 2 civilians and withdrew at 03:50.
- (iv) At 01:35, Israeli forces raided Yatta town stormed several civilian homes, arrested 1 civilian and withdrew at 03:50.
- (v) At 02:20, Israeli forces raided Al-Arroub refugee camp, stormed into civilian homes, arrested 3 civilians (including 1 child and NSF military office) and then withdrew at 603:50.
- <u>Attacks:</u> At 14:30, Israeli forces positioned east of the city Hebron shot and injured the child Lama Hafez El Bakri 16 years old for allegedly stabbing an Israeli soldier (As presented by Israeli Forces).

• Arrests:

- (i) At 11:20, Israeli forces arrested 2 civilians near Al-Ibrahimi Mosque in the old city of Hebron: Wael Abu Rmeileh and Basil Amro.
- (ii) The civilian arrested in Dura town is Abdel Rahman Mohammad Ismail Abu Arqoub.
- (iii) The 2 civilians arrested in Hebron city are: female civilian Haifa Makroum Abu Sbeih and Haitham Issam Mohammad Al-Jubeh.
- (iv) The 2 civilians arrested in Beit Awwa town are: Bari' Ismail Abdel Qader Shalash, 17.
- (v) The civilian arrested in Yatta town is Ismail Abdel Nabi Houshiyye.
- (vi) The 3 civilians arrested in Al-Arroub refugee camp are: military officer Imad Zuheir Rajab Abu Wardeh, Haitham Youssef Ghazi, 17, and Saed Ibrahim Nimer al-Badawi.
- (vii) The girl arrested after serious injury near Kiryat Arba settlement in the old city of Hebron is Lama Munther Hafez Al-Bakri, 17.

GAZA STRIP

ALL DISTRICTS

- At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month.
- Israeli forces broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire from their position behind the Green Line towards Gaza and Rafah. In addition, Israeli navy boats opened fire at fishing boats off Northern and Central Gaza shores. Also Israeli

	 warplanes fired 2 missiles in 2 raids at Northern Gaza and Gaza resulting in the injury of 1 civilian. Palestinian militants broke ceasefire by firing an unidentified projectile towards the Green Line.
NORTHERN GAZA	 Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is closed Attacks: At 08:00 on 11 December 2015, Israeli navy vessels opened fire towards fishing boats off Soudaniyye shore west of Beit Lahia. Air Attacks: At 07:45, Israeli warplanes fired a missile at a location of Palestinian militants in Soudaniyye area west of Beit Lahia. Palestinian Attacks: At 20:10, Palestinian militants fired an unidentified projectile towards the Green Line (according to Israeli claims).
GAZA	 Closure of Crossing Points: (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. Attacks: At 16:00, Israeli forces opened fire from their position behind the Green Line towards agricultural land east of Johr Al-Dik southeast Gaza city. Air strikes: At 00:40, Israeli warplanes fired a missile at a location for Palestinian militants south Gaza city.
RAFAH	 Closure of Crossing Points: Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. Rafah (Al 'Awdah) Crossing is closed. Sufa Crossing is closed Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is partially open for the entry of food, goods, fuel and construction material for internationally funded projects. Attacks: At 15:45, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line opened fire towards farmers in the vicinity of Karm Abu Salem crossing – Kerem Shalom east of Rafah city resulting in the injury of 1 civilian.
