JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to increase its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city entrance and the entrance to the Old City. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the gate along the Wall section separating the area of Dahiyat Al-Bareed from Al-Ram town. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • Checkpoints: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On the morning of December 12th 2011, the Israeli military set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Shu’fat refugee camp in Jerusalem replacing the old checkpoint placed at the entrance of the camp after it was closed at 24:00 on December 11th 2011 which will close off and separate Shu’fat Ras Khamis, Ras Shihadeh, Al Salam neighbourhood, Anata and Shu’fat camp from Jerusalem • Detention: The unidentified detainee, mentioned in the previous report is Mohammad Abu Obied , a National Security Officer; he was detained by Israeli forces at 01:30on December 14th 2011. • Physical Assault: At 18:00, Israeli forces positioned near Beit Anan assaulted Dhiyaa Abu Rayah; he was later hospitalised. • Installation of a Military Post: At 16:00, Israeli forces installed a military

	<p>watchtower east of Qalandiya refugee camp.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wall Gates: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Sawahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma'ale Adumim.

(ii) At 16:45, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint between Al Mughayyer and Khirbet Abu Falah villages. (iii) At 17:15, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Liqya. (iv) At 20:20, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Nabi Saleh village. (v) At 22:20, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Um Saffa village. • Raids: At 21:50, Israeli forces raided Arura, Deir Ghassaneh, Bir Zeit and Abu Qash villages. • Detention: On December 13th 2011, Israeli forces positioned at a flying checkpoint near Atara detained Rashid Atiya and Mohammad Abu Adi. • Provocation of Palestinian Forces: At 11:50, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Mahkama checkpoint north of El-Bireh city confiscated a Palestinian police vehicle travelling from Jenin to Ramallah, despite having security coordination; the vehicle was released at later time. • Settler Violence: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 18:25, a group of Israeli settlers stoned Palestinian vehicles, damaging a car owned by Nazal Aqel, a resident of Beitillu. (ii) At 05:00, a group of Israeli settlers raided Burqa, set fire to a mosque and wrote racist graffiti on its walls. • Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages.

TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village and the dirt road between Shufa and Saffarin villages. • Checkpoints: At 19:45 The Israeli army intensified its restrictions on Palestinian access at 'Einav checkpoint on the Tulkarem-Nablus main road and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Raids: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:15, Israeli forces raided Shweikeh neighbourhood in Tulkarem and Hawarish village until 11:45. (ii) At 10:50, Israeli forces raided Tulkarem • Wall Gates: Passage through the wall gates was restricted to civilians granted special permits, undercutting access to education and health services for civilians living behind the wall. • Wall Construction: Land levelling for adjustment of the Wall route continued in the area surrounding Jubara village According to an Israeli High Court decision, the new Wall route will be constructed west of the village.

(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second <i>Intifada</i>, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • Flying checkpoints: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint near Azzun. (ii) At 10:50, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint Jit village junction. (iii) At 14:20, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Kafr Laqif village. (iv) At 16:35, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the northern entrance of Azzun and impeded the free flow of traffic until 18:05. • Raids: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 19:15, Israeli forces raided Al-Nabi Eliyas village. (ii) At 21:30, Israeli forces Arab Al-Ramadin village and temporarily detained Mahmoud Shatarah. (iii) At 23:30, Israeli forces raided Azzun • Detentions: At 20:00, Israeli forces positioned at a checkpoint located north of Qalqilya detained Ali Daoud (17 years), a resident of Salfit, when he was renewing his magnetic card. • Settler Violence: At 13:30, a group of Israeli settlers stoned residents and vehicles in Kafr Laqif. • Wall Gates: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al-Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras 'Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in Kafr Laqef village north of

NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Till-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • Checkpoints: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Tur neighbourhood checkpoint (set up on Jerzim Mount) is closed on Fridays and Saturdays as well as during Jewish holidays. On all other days, it is open between 07:00 and 02:00 (ii) At 'Awarta commercial checkpoint, civilians are only allowed to cross between 05:00 and 20:00, and between 05:00 and 15:00 on Fridays. All vehicles can access the city of Nablus, but only commercial vehicles and ambulances can leave the city through the checkpoint. (iii) At 09:40 and again at 19:40, Israeli forces increased its restrictions at "Huwwara" checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic and at 04:05, Israeli forces closed Huwwara checkpoint. • Flying Checkpoints: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:40 and again 22:00, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Huwara and prevented vehicles from passing through a bypass road leading to Jit village until 13:15. (ii) At 12:05, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Sarra village junction. (iii) At 16:15, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Beita junction. (iv) At 21:30, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Salem village junction. (v) At 22:25, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint between Nablus and Asira Al-Shamaliya • Raids: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:55, Israeli forces raided Nablus. (ii) Since 14 November 2010, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian buses only. The entrance had been closed for seven years, and at 08:30, Israeli forces closed the entrance and impeded the free flow of

(ii) At 20:20, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint between Salfit and Iskaka village. (iii) At 23:10, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint between Salfit and Iskaka village. (iv) At 23:10, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint between Kafil Harres and Harres village • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:30 and again 13:40, Israeli forces raided Yasuf village until 13:55. JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> The Israeli army continues to close Road # 90 between Jericho city and Al-Oja village with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to restrict access through Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus Districts, only allowing access to residents of Jericho District and the Jordan Valley area and at 12:55, Israeli forces closed the checkpoint impeding the free flow of traffic for allegedly conducting a military training exercise in the area and reopened it at 17:00.. (ii) Israeli forces continues to intensify its restrictions at the checkpoint set up on the junction to Al-Ouja village, only allowing access to residents of the Jericho District and others with access permits. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:05, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the southern entrance of Jericho city. (ii) At 22:20, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint near Ein Dweik village
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 <i>dunums</i> of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road east of Beit Fajar town; the road connecting Tuqu' town to Khirbet al Baq'a village; and the detour road connecting Wadi Fukin and Al Jab'a villages.

HEBRON	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Dhahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to the entrance to Al-Simiya village (v) Since 15. 10. 2011, Israeli forces closed two entrances leading to Beit Ummar town. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:00, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Ramadin village. (ii) At 11:00, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Duma village. (iii) At 18:25, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the northern entrance of Hebron city. • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:30, 16:35 and again at 23:15, Israeli forces raided Yatta. (ii) At 10:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Burj village and stormed a home. (iii) At 12:00, Israeli forces raided Hebron. (iv) At 12:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Samou.

<p style="text-align: center;">ALL DISTRICTS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 02:00 on 18 January 2009, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. The ceasefire has been further renewed on 30 October 2011 at 22:00. • Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement as they raided and opened fire towards North Gaza and Gaza and as Israeli naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishermen off the shores of Gaza and Central Gaza.
<p style="text-align: center;">NORTHERN GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critically ill patients, Journalists, NGO staff, merchants and travellers travelling to Al Karama with previous coordination. • Raids: On the morning of December 15th 2011, Israeli forces escorting several bulldozers raided 200 meters into northern Beit Hanoun and opened fire towards agricultural land and homes as they levelled a plot of land. • Attack: At 06:15 on December 14th 2011, Israeli naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishermen off the shores of Sudaniya beach in Beit Lahia.
<p style="text-align: center;">GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Points: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iyah (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. • Attack: On the morning of December 14th 2011, Israeli forces opened fire towards residents in an area near a border fence next to the Karni crossing.
<p style="text-align: center;">Central GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Attack: On the morning of December 15th 2011, Israeli naval forces opened fire towards Palestinian hunting boats across the sea in the area near a Nuserat Camp.
<p style="text-align: center;">RAFAH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Points: • Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. • Rafah (<i>Al 'Awdah</i>) Crossing is open for critically ill patients, students and residents with special permits • Sufa Crossing is closed. • Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is partially open for the transportation of food supplies, goods, humanitarian aid cooking gas. In addition to 44 truckloads of Livestock feed, 20 imported vehicles, and construction cargo designated to internationally-funded projects. 3 shipments of strawberries and 2 shipments of bell peppers were also allowed out of Gaza for export.
