JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city for the alleged stabbing of an Israeli settler. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and impeded the free flow of traffic. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 09:00, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Jaba’ village junction. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On December 13th 2014, Israeli forces raided Al-Eisawiya village and detained two residents. (ii) At 01:30, Israeli forces raided Abu Dis until 02:10. (iii) At 03:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Ram and stormed several homes. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On December 13th 2014, Israeli forces detained Waleed Tufaha in the old city of Jerusalem. (ii) At 09:00, Israeli forces detained Billal Ghayth in Silwan neighbourhood. (iii) At 09:00, Israeli forces detained two residents: Ibrahim Abu Sneineh and Obada Najeeb in the old city of Jerusalem. (iv) At 09:00, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Magharabeh gate in the old city of Jerusalem detained Ibrahim Abu Gharbiya. (v) At dawn on December 15th 2014, Israeli forces detained eight residents: Omar Muhesin, Omar Shalabi, Nassar Al-Hadami, Oday Sinokrot, Mohammad Obadah, Ammar Owisat, Sami Id’eis and Nur Khadr in Jerusalem. (vi) Israeli forces detained two residents: Sari Obied and Sa’ed Obied in Al-Eisawiya. • <u>Home Demolition:</u> On December 14th 2014, Israeli forces stormed Silwan

	<p>neighbourhood and served military orders for the demolition of five homes owned by Adnan Ghayth, Mohammad Ghayth, Ahmad Al-Abbassi and 2 of his children.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 09:00, Israeli settlers under the protection of the Israeli Military stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshipers. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

(ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. • <u>Raid:</u> At 17:45, Israeli forces raided Al-Bireh city, clashed with several residents as they stormed several homes then withdrew at 22:00. • <u>Attack:</u> At 10:30, Israeli forces positioned near “Pesagout” settlement located in east Al-Bireh city fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • <u>Raid:</u> At 01:10, Israeli forces raided Jenin, stormed and searched two homes, detained two residents then withdrew at 04:50. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained two residents: Ahmad Al-Darbi and Mohammad Qutban in Jenin.
TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 20:50, Israeli forces raided Al-Far’a camp, stormed and searched seven homes, temporarily detained its residents then released them after recording their Identification card numbers and telephone numbers and withdrew at 03:15. (ii) At 03:15, Israeli forces raided Al-Far’a village until 05:00.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Raid:</u> At 02:35, Israeli forces raided Tulkarem until 04:00. • <u>Detention:</u> On December 24th 2014, Israeli forces detained Asma Bahloul (a resident of Tulkarem) as she was visiting her husband detained in Israeli prison in Al-Naqab.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second

QALQILIYA	<p>Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 18:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Al-Nabi Eliyas village until 19:30. (ii) At 19:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Izbit Al-Tabib village until 20:30. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 20:20, Israeli forces raided Al-Funduq village, clashed with several residents as they stormed Al-Amanah Bakery shop after damaging the main entrance gate and inspected surveillance camera footage then withdrew at 21:00. (ii) At 01:10, Israeli forces raided Azzun and summoned Ali Badran to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 02:05. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 11:30, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Falamiya village temporarily detained two residents: Ayman Abu Haniya and Rami Abu Haniya (Both residents of Azzun) then released them later. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya, the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:30 and again at 14:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Burin village until 15:30. (ii) At 16:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Osarin village. • <u>Raid:</u> At 11:50, Israeli forces raided Burin village until 12:50. • <u>Detention:</u> At 15:00, Israeli forces positioned at Huwara checkpoint detained Mus’ab Basalmeh (A resident of Salfit).
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama’ located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces closed Za’tara checkpoint, impeded the free flow of

(ii) At 11:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the north entrance of Salfit until 12:15. • <u>Raid:</u> At 01:00, Israeli forces raided Bidya, stormed and searched a home then withdrew at 03:30. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 08:00, a group of Israeli settlers positioned near Za'tara checkpoint stoned residents and vehicles passing through the checkpoint.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restriction at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the Dead Sea junction until 08:55. (ii) At 15:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Jericho until 17:00. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Oja village until 09:40. (ii) At 01:10, Israeli forces raided Jericho until 03:10. • <u>Detention:</u> At 19:00, Israeli forces positioned at Allenby Bridge detained Bakir Qasrawi (A resident of Jenin) as he was returning from Jordan.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunums of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.

<p style="text-align: center;">HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 09:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Halhul Bridge until 10:10. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:10, Israeli forces raided Al-Baraka area in Yatta until 13:00. (ii) At 21:00, Israeli forces raided Yatta, summoned 3 residents: Firas Abu Eid, Khaled Hamamdeh and Moath Abu Aram to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning. (iii) At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Hebron until 02:20. • <u>Detention:</u> At 16:15, Israeli forces detained Rami Bahar at the entrance of Beit Ummar.
