### **WEST BANK**

## The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints set up **ALL** on the main roads connecting the West Bank districts, thereby isolating the **DISTRICTS** northern districts from the southern districts as well as the Jericho district and the Jordan Valley from the remainder of the West Bank. Closure: At 11:00, the Israeli army closed the city of Jerusalem completely for a number of hours. The Israeli army intensified its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrances to the city of Jerusalem. The Israeli army also continued to close the entrances to al-Aqsa Mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and impede civilian access to the mosque. Additionally, the Israeli army combed the area alongside the apartheid Wall as a result of heated alarms of a suicide attack in the city. **Closure of Main Roads:** The Israeli army continues to close the entrance opposite the junction to (a) Dahiyat al-Bareed in the city of Jerusalem with a barbed wire gate and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army continues to close the road connecting Dahiyat al-(b) Bareed to the town of al-Ram in order to complete Wall construction in the area. (c) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt barricades the entrance to the village of Jaba', which connects the village to the cities of Jerusalem, Ramallah, and Jericho. **JERUSALEM** Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to consider Qalandya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and has designated a special crossing for holders of Jerusalem IDs and those possessing permits to access the city of Jerusalem. **Wall Gates:** (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Wall gate in the town of Abu Dis with cement blocks. The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall (ii) gate on al-Shayyah road in the area between the villages of al-Sawahira al-Sharqiya and al-Sawahira al-Gharbiya, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. Wall Construction: Wall construction was resumed in Dahiyat al-Bareed, Dahiyat al-Aqbat, from the village of Hizma to 'Anata, along the Hizma-Jaba' road, the area of al-'Eizariya to al-Shayyah, from the village of Beit Surik to Biddu, in the areas of al-Judeira, Bir Nabala, and Beit Hanina, west of the village of al-Jib, and in the vicinity of the village of Qatanna. RAMALLAH **Closure of Main Roads:** (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the eastern

	(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the settler

- bypass road connecting the village of Deir al-Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh as well as the southern entrance to the village of Qaryut.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close the entrance to the village of al-Lubban al-Sharqiya with dirt barricades and cement blocks.
- <u>Checkpoints</u>: The Israeli army continues to regulate times for crossing checkpoints set up around the city of Nablus:
- (i) At Tur neighborhood checkpoint (set up on Jerzim Mount) is closed on Fridays and Saturdays as well as during Jewish holidays. On all other days, it is open for civilian residents of the neighborhood only.
- (ii) Beit Furik checkpoint is open to civilian residents of the town of Beit Furik and the nearby village of Beit Dajan.
- (iii) Beginning on 23 November 2006, the Israeli army continues to close the checkpoint set up in the area between the city of Nablus and the town of 'Asira al-Shamaliya and to prevent civilians from crossing, only allowing access to humanitarian cases.
- **Flying Checkpoints**: At 10:00, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint at the junction of Yitzhar settlement and impeded traffic.
- <u>Raids</u>: At 01:30, the Israeli army raided the city of Nablus and the refugee camps of Balata, Askar and Ein al-Ma'. In addition, the Israeli army searched a number of houses and arrested 25 civilians including a PLC member and a lecturer at al-Najah University as well as 2 municipal council members.

SALFIT	<ul> <li>Closure of Main Roads: <ol> <li>The Israeli army continues to close the main north-western entrance to the city of Salfit with dirt barricades since the beginning of the current <i>Intifada</i> (Uprising).</li> <li>The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the western entrance to the village of Marda and, with cement blocks, the western entrance to the town of Kafr al-Dik.</li> <li>At 21:50, the Israeli army closed the road connecting the town of Kafl Hares and the village of Hares with dirt barricades.</li> <li>Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Deir Ballut and Za'tarah checkpoints and to deny civilian access.</li> <li>Flying Checkpoints: The Israeli army set6 up a checkpoint on the road connecting the town of Kafl Hares and the village of Hares.</li> <li>Detentions: At 15:00, the Israeli army stationed at Za'tarah checkpoint detained military officer Ahmad Saqer Salim and released him at a later time after the intervention of the military liaison.</li> <li>Wall Construction: Wall construction was resumed in the area northwest of the city of Salfit, and in the village of Marda and the town of Kafr Hares north of the settlement of Ari'el.</li> </ol> </li> </ul>
JERICHO	<ul> <li>Closure: The Israeli army continues to close Road # 90 between the city of Jericho and the village of al-'Auja with cement blocks and to prevent farmers not holding Jericho Governorate IDs from reaching their land, forcing them to apply for access permits. The Israeli army also continues to deny access to the city to holders of Israeli IDs.</li> <li>Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions and impede civilian access at al-Hamra checkpoint set up along al-Badhan road connecting the districts of Jericho and Nablus as well as on the checkpoint set up on the junction to the village of al-'Auja along al-Mu'arrajat road connecting the districts of Jericho and Ramallah.</li> <li>Detentions: On December 14, the Israeli army arrested at al-Karameh (Allenby) Crossing civilian Nidal Youssef Saleh Abu Yaacoub on his way to Jordan.</li> </ul>
BETHLEHEM	<ul> <li>Closure: <ul> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads to the village of An Nu'man, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village.</li> <li>(ii) Since September 15, 2007, the Israeli army has been preventing civilian access, according to military order 07.02.S, to the 22-dunum land that has been confiscated in accordance with confiscation order number 07.31.T. The 22-dunum area has been set to construct a passage in the area of Mazmouriyyeh that is located in the cities of Beit Sahour and Bethlehem.</li> <li>Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close all roads to</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

Road # 60 leading to the city of Jerusalem, thereby isolating the city of Bethlehem from its towns and villages located west of Road # 60.

• <u>Checkpoints</u>: At 12:00, the Israeli army intensified restrictions at the alcontainer checkpoint and impeded traffic.

#### • Raids:

- (i) At 15:20, the Israeli army raided the village of Dar Salah and set up a checkpoint.
- (ii) At 20:15, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of al-Khader.
- (iii) At 03:45, the Israeli army raided the village of Batir, searched a number of houses, arrested 5 civilians and withdrew at 04:50.

#### • Arrests:

- (i) At 22:30, the Israeli army arrested at the checkpoint that is set up at the junction of Kfar Etzyon settlement military officer Kamal Hamdan from the Palestinian National Security Forces.
- (ii) The 5 civilians arrested in the village of Batir are:
- (a) Moammar Mohammad Moammar;
- (b) Asem Ismail Moammar;
- (c) Saleh Noman Moammar:
- (d) Omar Samir Abu Ni'meh; and
- (e) Nidal Mohammad Abu Ni'meh.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction was resumed in the area northwest of the town of al-Khader; northwest of the city of Beit Jala; in the area of Wadi Rahhal east of the settlement of Ephrata; and in the area surrounding the village of al-Walaja.

## • <u>Closure</u>:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the following locales in the old city of Hebron: al-Shuhada' Street and the area of al-Sahleh with cement blocks and barbed wire; the old gold market with an iron gate; the area of Khuzq al-Far near the settlement of Abraham Avino with a dirt barricade and an iron gate; and the entrance to the area of al-Khan with an electronic gate, isolating the area from al-Laban Market and the area of al-Sahleh. The Israeli army also continues to install an iron gate at the entrance to the area of al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) in the old city of Hebron, thereby controlling civilian access in the area.
- (ii) Although it expired on 07 May 2006, the Israeli army continues to implement a military order stipulating the prohibition of civilian vehicles from traveling along the road connecting the settlement of Kiryat Arba' to the Ibrahimi Mosque in the old city of Hebron unless they possess access permits.

## • Closure of Main Roads:

(i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the following locales: the entrance to the town of al-Samoa'; the area of al-Hawawir leading to the town of Halhoul; the area of al-Fahs south of the city of Hebron; the junction to the area of Farsh al-Hawa leading to Road # 35 northwest of the city of Hebron; the road connecting the town of Surif to the village of al-Jab'a; the entrance to the village of Beit 'Einun; and

- the eastern entrance to the village of Kharsa. The Israeli army also continues to close with cement blocks the entrance to al-Qeisi neighborhood in the old city of Hebron as well as the main entrance to al-'Arroub refugee camp.
- (ii) In accordance with Military Order # 378, the Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from traveling along Shalala Old Street that leads to the old city of Hebron, only allowing Israeli vehicles as well as Israeli army vehicles to travel along this street.
- **Flying Checkpoints**: At 15:50, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint at the junction o the village of Beit Umrah, and searched civilians and vehicles.

#### Raids

- (i) At 14:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the city of Hebron. The raid recurred at 17:00 during which the Israeli set up 2 checkpoints. The raid took place for the third time at 01:00 during which the Israeli army patrolled the city of Hebron until 03:00.
- (ii) At 15:30, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Yatta.
- (iii) At 15:40, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Dura.
- (iv) At 17:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of al-Thahiriyyeh.
- Arrests: At 12:45, the Israeli army arrested civilian Mohammad Mahmoud Odeh, a resident of the town of Dura, while he was working inside the Green Line. Mohammad was charged of stabbing an Israeli for financial reasons.
- <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction was resumed in the section of Tarqumiya checkpoint terminal, the remaining section of the Wall route that separates the settlement of Eshkolot from the village of al-Ramadin, and near the village of Imneizil southeast of the town of Yatta.
