JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city for the alleged stabbing of an Israeli settler. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and impeded the free flow of traffic. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 17:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Khan Al-Ahmar area located along the main road connecting Jerusalem and Jericho until 17:55 • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:30, Israeli forces raided Biddu village and clashed with several residents. (ii) At 04:40, Israeli forces raided Qalandiya camp, clashed with several residents as they stormed several homes and as a result killed a resident and detained another then withdrew at 05:25 • <u>Killing:</u> Israeli forces killed Mohammad Abdallah Odwan (20 years old) {As a result of a gunshot wound to the head}. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On December 15th 2014, Israeli forces detained five residents including a child and a woman: Zakariya Al-Bakri, Dalia Ali, Ahmad Alqam, Mahmoud Al-Jindi and Tawfiq Abu Snieneh in Jerusalem. (ii) At 19:30, Israeli forces positioned near Ras Al-Amoud neighbourhood detained Ma’en Aweid. (iii) Israeli forces detained Mijahid Awad-Allah in Qalandiya camp. • <u>Home Demolition:</u> On December 15th 2014, Israeli forces stormed Al-Thuri neighbourhood in Jerusalem and served demolition orders for the home of Mu; taz Hijazi (Who was killed by Israeli forces last month) for allegedly being built without a licence. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 08:30, Israeli settlers under the protection of

(ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

(ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:00 and again at 17:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Yabrud Village Bridge, temporarily seized a National Security vehicle then allowed it to pass through at 17:50. (ii) At 16:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Atarah Bridge in North Bir Zeit, detained a resident after searching his vehicle as he was accompanied by his wife then released him after inspecting his Identification card and withdrew at 00:20. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At dawn on December 15th 2014, Israeli forces raided Deir Ammar and detained a resident. (ii) At 14:30, Israeli forces raided Turmus’aya and Sinjil, stormed a home and an Internet Café then withdrew at 14:50. (iii) At 20:15, Israeli forces raided Rantis village, set up a checkpoint at its entrance then withdrew at 22:10. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces positioned at Atarah Bridge detained Mohammad Shawahnah (A resident of Qalqiliya). (ii) Israeli forces detained Mahmoud Musa in Deir Ammar village. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:25 and again at 13:10 and at 16:25, Israeli forces positioned near “Pesagout” settlement located in east Al-Bireh city fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 13:00, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Ofar Military base fired live ammunition; rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades for alleged stoning.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 12:20, Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 14:00. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 02:35, Israeli forces raided Tulkarem and its camps, detained a resident and assaulted Salah Nafeyeh (14 years old) leaving him hospitalised with contusions. (ii) At 22:30, Israeli forces raided Zieta, stormed a coffee shop, stormed and searched several homes, summoned 2 residents: Yusef Al-Baladi and Ibrahim Al-Zibadi to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 03:25. (iii) At 00:30, Israeli forces raided Baqa Al-Sharqiya, stormed a home then withdrew at 01:20. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Mustafa Nafeyeh in Tulkarem camp.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Izbit Al-Tabib village, closed the main entrance then reopened it later and temporarily detained two residents Abdallah Abu Rahmeh and Munir Amayreh and released them at 13:20. (ii) At 20:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Izbit Al-Tabib village until 21:00. (iii) At 20:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Qalqiliya until 20:40. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 02:00 on December 15th 2014, Israeli forces raided Habalah village and summoned Zahrat Kharoub to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning. (ii) At 17:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Nabi Eliyas, stormed a merchant shop and inspected surveillance camera footage. • <u>Detention:</u> At 03:00 on December 15th 2014, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Azzun Atma village detained three residents: Nabil Amer, Nihad Amr and Ismail Amr (All residents of Beit Amin village). • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 17:00, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Jayyus temporarily detained Mo’ayad Issa (A resident of Jayous) accompanied with three labourers then released them at 20:50. • <u>Land Levelling:</u> At 13:40, Israeli forces stormed Azzun and levelled a plot of land owned by Ibrahim Hawari, Ismail Radwan, Mohammad Radwan, Mohammad Sarour Radwan, Jihad Radwan, Huwari Ahmad Huwari and Jamal Huwari located near “Malee Shamron” settlement • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya, the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.

(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 08:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Sarah village junction until 09:20. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:15, Israeli forces raided Subustiya village as they escorted a group of Israeli settlers then withdrew at 12:50. (ii) At 00:40, Israeli forces raided Askar camp in Nablus, detained a resident then withdrew at 03:20. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Iz-AIDin Al-Sarifi in Askar camp. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 20:30, Israeli forces positioned at Huwara checkpoint detained Majdi Ali (A resident of Jama’in) then released him after being summoned to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Burin village fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 16:35, Israeli forces positioned near Jabal Al-Saba’ area located in east Burin village fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

(ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama’ located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 11:45, Israeli forces closed Za’tara checkpoint, impeded the free flow of traffic 15:20. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 10:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint beneath Iskaka Village Bridge until 11:20. • <u>Detention:</u> At 01:00 on December 15th 2014, Israeli forces detained Mohammad Al-Aqra’ during their raid into Bidya as mentioned in the previous report.
<p style="text-align: center;">JERICHO</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restriction at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along road (90) near Al-New’meh village located at the north entrance of Jericho until 09:45. (ii) At 09:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along road (90) in Al-Oja village until 11:30. (iii) At 10:15 and again at 16:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Jericho until 17:55.

BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunums of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Tabaqa. (ii) At 10:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Halhul bridge. (iii) At 11:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Zif village junction. (iv) At 14:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint with the presence of Police dogs at the entrance of Al-Urub camp, inspected resident's Identification cards and searched their belongings. (ii) At 10:45, Israeli forces raided Hebron, stormed and searched several homes and fired stun grenades towards Omar Abdel-Latifs home after Israeli forces assaulted him, detained two residents then withdrew at 02:45. (iii) At 11:00, Israeli forces raided Surif village and clashed with its residents. (iv) At 11:35, Israeli forces raided Kuwaziba village located north of Sair. (v) At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Tabaqa village, stormed a home and detained two residents including a child. (ii) At 20:30, Israeli forces stormed Al-Kum village located in West Dura, served halt to construction orders for six homes owned by Ismail Al-Rojub, Mohammad Al-Rujob, Arafat Al-Rujob, Nael Al-Rojub, Hussein Al-Rojub and Muhib Al-Rojob for allegedly being built without proper licencing because of its location in area C that is under Israeli Military and administrative control.
