WEST BANK

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the gate along the Wall section separating the area of Dahiyat Al-Bareed from Al-Ram town.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandia checkpoint.

JERUSALEM

• Checkpoints:

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city.
- (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- (iii) On December 15th 2012, Israeli forces increased its restrictions at Ja'aba checkpoint, searched vehicles with bomb sniffing dogs and impeded the free flow of traffic.
- <u>Temporary Detention:</u> On December 16th 2012, Israeli courts imposed a home detention sentence on Tamer Da'na, a resident of Silwan neighbourhood for a 7 day period until his court hearing and fined him 5000 NIS approximately 1300 USD
- **Home Demolition:** At 10:00, Israeli forces served demolition orders for several homes in Silwan neighbourhood in Jerusalem.

• Settler Violence:

(i) On the afternoon of December 16th 2012, Israeli settlers stoned vehicles near Mikhmas village junction.

	(ii) On the evening of December 16 th 2012, an Israeli settler assaulted Nihad Zaghier and sprayed pepper spray in her face under the protection of Israeli forces leaving her suffocated from tear gas inhalation.

	(i) On December 16 th 2012, a demonstration took place near Al-Isawiya village in the old city of Jerusalem in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons. (ii) On December 16 th 2012, a demonstration took place near Bab Al-Amoud
	gate in the old city of Jerusalem in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons.
	• Wall Gates:
	(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.

TULKAREM	 Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. Checkpoints: The Israeli army intensified its restrictions at Einav checkpoint on the Tulkarem-Nablus main road and impeded the free flow of traffic. Flying Checkpoint: At 08:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Lid. At 08:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Bizzariya village junction located east of Anabta, fired stun grenades then withdrew at 00:20. Raid: At 04:20, Israeli forces raided Tulkarem until 05:50. Wall Gates: Land leveling for adjustment of the Wall route was in the area surrounding Jubara village for Sabbath holiday. According to an Israeli High Court decision, the new Wall route is to be constructed west of the village
	 Closure of Roads: (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. Flying Checkpoint: At 18:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Azzun and Izbat Al-Tabib village. Attack: At 11:40, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate leading to Azzun Atma village opened fire towards several labourers as they attempted to enter Israeli for work.

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala; the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks.
- (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.
- **Flying Checkpoint:** At 18:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Fajjar until 20:00.

Raid:

- (i) At 09:30 and again at 02:00, Israeli forces raided Beit Fajjar, clashed with several school children, stormed an abandoned home, stormed another home and detained a resident.
- (ii) At 10:45, Israeli forces raided Al-Walaja village, fired stun grenades towards several farmers heading towards their agricultural land, forcibly removed them from the land then withdrew at 12:00.
- (iii) At 13:55, Israeli forces raided A'eda camp in Bethlehem, fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning and injured a child and left several other children suffocating from tear gas inhalation.
- (iv) At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Bethlehem until 03:30.
- **Detention:** Israeli forces detained Mohammad Taqatqa in Beit Fajjar.
- <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in North West of Beit Jala town.

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.

HEBRON

- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to the entrance to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) On July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.

• Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) At 08:25 and again at 18:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Halhul bridge.
- (ii) At 18:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Fahs area in south Hebron.

Raid:

- (i) At 18:30, Israeli forces raided Bab Al-Zawiya area in Hebron and stormed several home after detaining its residents.
- (ii) At 22:30, Israeli forces raided Ithna.
- (iii) At 02:15, Israeli forces raided Al-Shuyukh until 04:00.
- (iv) At 02:20, Israeli forces raided Al-Thahriya until 04:00.

• Detention:

- (i) At 14:00, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Sahla area in the old city of Hebron temporarily detained Lu'ay Al-Rajabi (11 years old) and released him at a later time.
- (ii) At 18:25, Israeli forces positioned in Tel Al-Rumayda neighbourhood in the old city of Hebron temporarily detained several residents as they exited a mosque after evening prayers and released them after interrogation
- <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction resumed in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahriya town.

At 21:00 on November 21st 2012, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into

effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. On November 24th 2012, Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's **ALL** seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark. **DISTRICTS** Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire from their positions behind the Green line towards Khan Yunis and injured a resident. Israeli Naval vessels broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of North Gaza. Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businessmen and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination. Attack: (i) At 06:00 on December 15th 2012, Israeli naval vessels opened fire towards **NORTHERN GAZA** Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Beit Lahiya. (ii) At 06:20 on December 16th 2012, Israeli naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Beit Lahiya. (iii) At 06:30 on December 17th 2012, Israeli naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Beit Lahiya. **Closure of Crossing Points:** Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the (i) **GAZA** Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, (ii) the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. **Attack:** On the afternoon of December 16th 2012, Israeli forces opened fire from their positions behind the Green Line towards several farmers in east Qarara village **KHAN YUNIS** and injured a resident. **Closure of Crossing Points:** Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. Rafah (Al 'Awdah) Crossing is open for the exit of patients, students, passengers with permits and International aid. Sufa Crossing is closed. **RAFAH** Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is open for the entry of humanitarian supplies, cooking gas, truckloads of wheat and Livestock feed as well as exporting six shipments of strawberries and vegetables and construction material for internationally funded projects.
