## • Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city for the alleged stabbing of an Israeli settler.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

## • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Oalandiya checkpoint.

## • Checkpoints:

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:20 and impeded the free flow of traffic until 04:05.
- (ii) On September 19<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.

### • Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) At 16:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in Khan Al-Ahmar junction on the main road between Jerusalem and Jericho, and searched vehicles and civilians.
- (ii) At 20:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Beit Ijza and Beit Daqqo villages and searched vehicles and civilians.

#### Arrests:

- (i) On 16 December 2014, Israeli forces arrested three civilians in Thori neighbourhood in Jerusalem. The civilians are Thaer Riyad Lafi, Mahdi Burgan and Anas Burgan.
- (ii) At 22:00, Israeli forces physically assaulted and arrested a child called Ahmad Rizek from Jabal Al-Mukaber in Jerusalem.
- (iii) On 17 December 2014, Israeli forces arrested seven civilians in Jerusalem: Amjad Tawil, Odai Radaideh, Murad Kastiro, Zakaria Abu Nab, Ibrahim Usama Al-Batta, Fadi Darwish, Rami Darwish.

## Attacks:

- (i) At 10:30, Israeli forces stationed at Qalandia military checkpoint opened live fire and fired rubber coated bullets and tear gas canisters at civilians injuring a child called Mohammad Al-Rajabi, 15.
- (ii) At 19:30, Israeli forces in Ras Al-Amud. Mt. of Olives and the Old City in Jerusalem fired gas canisters at civilians under the pretext of stone throwing.

## • Flying Checkpoints:

- (i) At 08:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrances to Al-Khader and Teqoa towns, and searched vehicles and civilians until 11:00.
- (ii) At 10:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Kfar Etzyon settlement junction and detained a civilian called Dheeb Mohammad Dheeb Shamroukh from Dheisheh camp in Bethlehem and released him at 14:30.
- (iii)At 18:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Al-Khader Town Bridge on the road to Bethlehem villages and arrested a military from the National Security Forces.
- (iv)At 19:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance to Beit Jala town and searched vehicles and civilians until 21:00.
- Raids: At 20:00, Israeli forces raided Teqoa town, set up checkpoint and patrolled the town until 20:20.
- <u>Arrests:</u> The military arrested near Al-Khader Town Bridge (on the road to Bethlehem villages) is called Muath Abed Shaker Hamamreh.

## • Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

## • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> At 20:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Bani Naim town junction and searched vehicles and civilians.
- Raids: At 15:50, Israeli forces raided Surif tow, stormed a civilian home and a garage and arrested one civilian.

## • Arrests:

- (i) At 09:40, Israeli forces arrested in the old city of Hebron a child cold Ahmad Fahmi Mohammadn Ajlouni, 16.
- (ii) At 16:45, Israeli forces arrested two civilians in the old city of Hebron: Usama Samer Abu Sneineh and Maher Abu Sneineh.
- (iii) The civilian arrested in Surif is called Ahmad Youssef Adwan.
- Attacks: At 12:40, Israeli forces near the entrance to Fawwar refugee camp fired stun grenades and tear gas canisters at children under the pretext of stone throwing. The Israeli forces held in custody 2 civilians (incl. a child) called

after the intervention of the Palestinian DCO.
• Settler Violence: At 18:10, a group of settlers assembled near Rihiye village and
physically assaulted a civilian called Ahmad Mohammad Salem Toubasi causing
him injuries. The civilians was taken to hospital for treatment.
