WEST BANK

Closure:

- (i) On December 16th 2015, the Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound which forced residents to conduct prayers near checkpoints located outside Al-Agsa mosque compound.
- The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in (ii) the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a (iii) hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

Closure of Main Roads:

- The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the (i) entrance to Jaba' village.
- The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to (ii) Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.
- On November 16th 2015, Israeli forces closed the south entrance of Jabal Al-(iii) Mukabir neighbourhood in Jerusalem, which leads to "Armon Hantsiv" settlement with cement blocks.

Checkpoints:

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city.
- (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- Flying Checkpoint: At 21:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Bir Nabala then searched residents and vehicles.

- (i) At dawn on December 16th 2015, Israeli forces raided Al-Jadira village and detained two residents after searching their homes.
- (ii) At 23:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Eisawiya village, clashed with several residents and detained a resident.
- (iii) At 01:30, Israeli forces raided Qalandiya camp, clashed with several residents as they stormed several homes, detained a resident then withdrew at 04:30.

Detention:

- (i) On December 16th 2015, Israeli forces detained 2 children: Mohammad Qassim Al-Mabbid (15 years old) and Safeer Khamis Al-Tahan (15 years
- (ii) On the evening of December 16th 2015, Israeli forces detained Mohammad Omar Marad (A resident of Beit Duqu village.
- (iii) At 03:00, Israeli forces detained Abeer Ziyad after storming and searching her home in Al-Thuri village.
- (iv) Israeli forces detained 2 residents: Idris Ra'fat Shuihadeh and Mohammad Maher Shihadeh in Al Jadeirah village.
- (v) Israeli forces detained Sami Abu Al-Louliya (A resident of Kafr Aqab village).

JERUSALEM

- (vi) Israeli forces detained Jallal Nasser in Al-Eisawiya village.
- <u>Attack:</u> At 11:50, Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity of Qalandiya checkpoint fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- Assault on Places of Worship: At 09:00, a group of Israeli settlers under the
 protection of Israeli Military and Police forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque
 compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshipers.
- <u>Settlement Activity:</u> Israeli Authorities approved tenders for the construction of 891 new settlement units in "Gilo" settlement located in south west area of Jerusalem on Palestinian land occupied in 1967.

• Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages
- (ii) . On October 3rd 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road located near "Bet El" settlement and leading to Al-Jalazoun camp with cement blocks.
- (iii) Since November 24th 2015, Israeli forces closed the main entrance of Sinjil and the east entrance of Al-Mughier village with cement blocks.

- (xi) At 13:10 on November 22nd 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Marah Rabah village with dirt mounds.
- (xii) At 18:00 on November 27th 2015, Israeli forces closed the Barbrat junction located in Ras area in Beit Jalah with cement blocks.
- (xiii) At 14:50 on November 28th 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Um Al-Rakaba area located in Al-Khader with cement blocks.

- (i) At 10:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Dar Salah village and at the east entrance of Beit Sahour and temporarily detained Bara Abdallah Hamdan and released him later then withdrew at 16:00.
- (ii) At 11:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Um Salmouna village then searched residents and vehicles.
- (iii) At 19:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the west entrance of Beit Fajjar then searched residents and vehicles until 00:50.
- (iv) At 21:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Al-Faradis village then searched residents and vehicles until 23:30.
- **Raid:** At 22:25, Israeli forces raided Al-Abiyat area located in Bethlehem, clashed with several residents, detained a child then withdrew at 23:30.
- <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Ayman Ameen Hussien Al-Khateeb (17 years old) in Al-Abiyat area located in Bethlehem.
- Attack: At 15:35, Israeli forces positioned near the west entrance of Taqou' fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning during which Israeli forces occupied 2 homes owned by Issa Ibrahim Al-Sha'ir and Ibrahim Hussien Jadallah and converted their rooftops into Military posts.
- Assault on Property: At 12:55, Israeli forces stormed Um Al-Rakaba area in Al-Khader and served a military order to halt construction on 3 homes owned by Ibrahim Musa Salah, Nour Khalil Salah and Alaa Rizq Salah.

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) At 05:50 on November 5th 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance leading Farsh Al-Hawa area in Hebron with Cement blocks.
- (vi) At 10:30 on November 8th 2015, Israeli forces closed the junction located near "Hagi" settlement located in south Hebron with cement blocks.
- (vii)At 21:00 on November 11th 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Beit Awwa and Al-Majd village with cement block and dirt mounds.
- (viii) At 15:45 on November 15th 2015, Israeli forces closed Al-Samiya village junction located at the west entrance of Al-Samou' with cement blocks.

(ix) On November 15th 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrances of Khliat Al-Miya and Al Dirat and the two bypass roads leading east Yatta with cement blocks.

- (x) Since 14:10 on November 23rd 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Al-Qom village located in Beit Awwa with cement blocks.
- (xi) At 08:00 on December 1st 2015, Israeli closed a checkpoint located at the entrance of Al-Shuhada road and impeded the free flow of traffic and redirected traffic towards Jabal Al-Rahmeh {for a period of 2 weeks}.
- (xii)At 22:20 on December 9th 2015, Israeli forces closed Jabal Jales area in the old city of Hebron and closed a bypass road in the area.
- (xiii) At 16:00, on December 11th 2015, Israeli forces closed Sa'ir entrance located along highway (60) with earth mounds.

Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) At 08:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Ithna junction then searched residents and vehicles.
- (ii) At 08:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along Zif village junction then searched residents and vehicles.

• Raid:

HEBRON

- (i) At 13:10, Israeli forces raided Hebron and clashed with several residents.
- (ii) At 21:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Thahriya, stormed and searched 3 homes then withdrew at 04:00.
- (iii) At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Beit Awwa then stormed and searched 2 homes
- (iv) At dawn on December 17th 2015, raided Beit Ummar, stormed and searched several homes and detained 3 residents including a child.
- Attack: At 13:50, Israeli forces positioned near Beit Einoun village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

• Detention:

- (i) At 17:20, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Al-Qum village detained Abdel-Nasser Al-Rajoub (A resident of Deir Sammit village).
- (ii) Israeli forces detained 3 residents: Karam Yusef Hasan Khalil (16 years old), Moath Wael Khalil and Rami Khalil Mahmoud Abu Daya in Beit Ummar
- <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 17:20, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate detained Khader Ahmad Salameh Al-Haroub (A resident of Deir Sammit village).
- <u>Home Occupation:</u> At 16:00, Israeli forces stormed Tal'at Abu Hadid area located in the old city of Hebron and occupied a home owned by Jawdat Abu Hadeed and converted its rooftop into military post.
- <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 14:30, Israeli settlers positioned in Al-Ras area located in the old city of Hebron assaulted Mohammad Nathir Al-Ja'bari and as a result, left him hospitalised with contusions.

- At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month.
- Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire from their positions behind the Green Line towards North Gaza, Gaza, Central Gaza and Khan Yunis.
- Israeli Naval vessels broke the cease-fire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of North Gaza and as a result injured four residents.
- Palestinian Gunmen broke the cease-fire agreement by opening fire and detonated a UXO near Israeli forces positioned near the border fence (as alleged by the Israeli Military).

NORTHERN GAZA

• <u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businessmen and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination.

	Attack: (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line opened fire towards agricultural land in east Jabaliya. (ii) At 09:00 and at 10:00 and again at 16:30, Israeli Naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Al-Sudaniya area located in west Beit Lahiya.
GAZA	 Closure of Crossing Points: (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. Attack: At 18:20, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line opened fire towards agricultural land located in east Jaher Al-Dik area located in south east Gaza.
CENTRAL GAZA	 Attack: At 15:30 and again at 18:20, Israeli forces opened fire from their positions behind the Green Line opened fire towards several residents and farmers on agricultural land in east Al-Buriej camp.
KHAN YUNIS	 Attack: At 11:15, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line opened fire towards several residents in Al-Fakhari area and as a result injured a resident. Palestinian Attack: At 16:00, Palestinian gunmen detonated a UXO near the border fence as a Israeli military vehicle was passing near the border fence in east Abbasan Al-Kabira {As alleged by the Israeli Military} during which Israeli forces opened fire and launched 12 Artillery shells towards the area and as a result injured 3 residents.

(ii) Rafah (Al 'Awdah) Crossing is closed (iii) Sufa Crossing is closed (iv) Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing open for the entry of tourist and foreign diplomats and the entry of Humanitarian assistance and construction material funded by UNRWA
