<p style="text-align: center;">JERUSALEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ On December 17th 2015, the Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound, which forced residents to conduct prayers near checkpoints located outside Al-Aqsa mosque compound. ○ The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. ○ The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. • The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • On November 16th 2015, Israeli forces closed the south entrance of Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood in Jerusalem, which leads to “Armon Hantsiv” settlement with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. • On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Detention:</u> At 15:30, Israeli forces detained three residents: Mohammad Amin Al-Khatib, Ashraf Mohammad Kan’an and Mohammad Al-Dibwani (All residents of Hizma village). • <u>Expulsion:</u> On December 17th 2015, Israeli Authorities served a Military order to Khadija Kahyous (A resident of Jerusalem) which prevents her from entering the old city of Jerusalem and travelling abroad for a period of 6 months from December 16th 2015 until June 15th 2016. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> At 11:00, Israeli forces fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents in the village of Kufer Aqabfor alleged Stoning. • <u>Seizure of Home:</u> On December 17th 2015, Israeli Authorities served court orders to 4 families: Castro, Hashmiyah, Al- Saydawi and Masawdah in order to seize their homes located in Aqbat Al-Khaldiya area in the old city of Jerusalem stating that the home is owned by a group of Israeli settlers before 1948 after the court ruled in favor of the Israeli settlers. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 09:00, a group of Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli Military and Police forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshipers. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis

	<p>town.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

On October 3rd 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road located near “Bet El” settlement and leading to Al-Jalazoun camp with cement blocks. Since November 24th 2015, Israeli forces closed the main entrance of Sinjil and the east entrance of Al-Mughier village with cement blocks. At 18:50 on December 4th 2015, Israeli forces closed the main entrance of Abboud with cement blocks. At 16:40 on December 15th 2015, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Al-Labban Al-Gharbiya. <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> At 08:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in the area between Deir Ammar and Beit Illo then searched residents and vehicles until 13:45. At 13:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Turmus’aya then searched residents and vehicles until 13:50. At 15:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Ein Sinya village roundabout then searched residents and vehicles. At 18:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Ein Ayoub area junction located near Dier Ammar village then searched residents and vehicles until 21:00. <u>Raid:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> At 10:05, Israeli forces raided Beituniya, clashed with several residents, detained 4 residents including 2 children then withdrew at 10:30. At 01:50, Israeli forces raided Al-Bireh city, stormed a home and summoned Faris Matir to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning. At 03:15, Israeli forces raided Kafr Ni’meh village and clashed with several residents. At dawn on December 18th 2015, Israeli forces raided Shuqba village then stormed and searched several homes. <u>Attack:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> At 10:35, Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity of “Pesagout” settlement located in east Al-Bireh city fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. At 10:35, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Silwad fired rubber coated steel bullets; stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning, detained a child and confiscated a vehicle. At 15:20, Israeli forces positioned Deir Jrier village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. At 15:50, Israeli forces positioned near the east entrance of Beit Liqya fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 4 residents including 3 children: Hamadah Ma’rouf Assi (15 years old), Fawaz Akramah Badr (15 years old), Mahmoud Fawaz Assi (15 years old), Abed Salah Badr then detained a child. <u>Detention:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Israeli forces detained 4 residents: Ali Shaladah (17 years old), Qais Afaneh (17 years old), Ahmad Al-Khatib and Omar Mazen Jaradat in Beituniya. Israeli forces detained Haytham Abdel-Hamid Hamad (14 years old) near

JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 20:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Ya'bad then searched residents and vehicles. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Israeli forces continue to close the wall gate and only allow those holding special permits to enter through it.
TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Confiscation of Property:</u> On December 17th 2015, Israeli forces imposed a financial penalty amounting to 3861 NIS on Ahmad Ali Mohammad Bani Odeh in order to release his vehicle, which was confiscated in the North Jordan valley by Israeli forces for over 35 days.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> At 13:50 on December 14th 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Shufa and Izbit Shufa villages located near "Avni Havits" settlement with a steel gate and barbed wire fence. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at "Eniv" checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:40, Israeli forces raided Al-Nazlah Al-Gharbiya village until 10:30. (ii) At 11:10, Israeli forces raided Shwikiya neighbourhood in Tulkarem , detained a resident then withdrew at 12:40. (iii) At 02:20, Israeli forces raided Tulkarem, stormed a home and detained a resident then withdrew at 05:20. (iv) At 04:25, Israeli forces raided Anabta, stormed and searched a home, detained a resident and confiscated a computer and 3 cellular Telephones. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 22:10, Israeli forces detained Ahmad Abdallah Abu Salameh (A resident of Tulkarem camp) as he was reporting to Israeli Intelligence based on a prior summon. (ii) Israeli forces detained Khaled Jamal Abdel-Latif Fuqaha in Shweikiya neighbourhood in Tulkarem. (iii) Israeli forces detained Omar Ibrahim Abu Dajji in Tulkarem. (iv) Israeli forces detained Abdalah Jameel Abdel-Khaliq in Anabta. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 09:30, Israeli forces temporarily detained the child Hussien Ahed Budier (14 years old) {a resident of Far'oun} then released him later. • <u>Attack:</u> At 13:00, Israeli forces positioned near Ghashouri factories located in west Tulkarem fired live ammunition; rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) Since 16:55 on December 18th 2014, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far'ata village which is located near "Gillad" settlement with dirt mounds (iv) Since 10:40 on September 1st 2015, Israeli forces closed an agricultural

The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.

(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. (ii) At 04:30, Israeli forces raided Beit Furiq, stormed and searched 4 homes then withdrew at 05:30. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Ahmad Samir Nayef Shan'iya. • <u>Killing:</u> At 10:45, the child Abdallah Hussien Ahmad Nassasrah (16 years old) {a resident of Beit Furiq} was killed after Israeli forces opened fire towards him near Huwara checkpoint for allegedly attempting to stab an Israeli soldier {as alleged by the Israeli Military}. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 15:00, Israeli forces positioned at Beit Furiq checkpoint temporarily detained 3 residents including a National Security Force Officer: Adnan Najeh Awad, Raed Issam Miflih Hanini and Loai Assad Khattabah. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:20, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Al-Labban Al-Sharqiya fired live ammunition; rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result

(ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 10:45, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 11:50. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Deir Istiya and detained a resident. (ii) At 19:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in the area between Kafil Harris and Deir Istiya then searched residents and vehicles. BETHLEHEM

- **Closure:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village.
 - (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunums of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities.
- **Closure of Main Roads:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks.
 - (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.
 - (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires.
 - (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds.
 - (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.
 - (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.
 - (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.
 - (ix) Since 10:45 on September 8th 2015, Israeli forces closed the agricultural road located in Arab Al-Rashaydeh village located near "Malee Amous" settlement with dirt mounds.
 - (x) At 15:30 on November 20th 2015, Israeli forces closed the east entrance of Jinata and the entrance of Marah Rabah village with dirt mounds.
 - (xi) At 13:10 on November 22nd 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Marah Rabah village with dirt mounds.
 - (xii) At 18:00 on November 27th 2015, Israeli forces closed Bararat junction located in Ras area in Beit Jallah with cement blocks.
 - (xiii) At 14:50 on November 28th 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Um Al-Raqaba area located in Al-Khader with cement blocks.

(iv) At 02:55, Israeli forces raided Al-Assakra village, stormed and searched several homes and detained 2 residents. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained 2 residents: Awwad Mohammad Awwad Assakra and Hamza Ibrahim Hamdan Jabril in Asakra village. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:20, Israeli forces positioned near the North entrance of Taqou' fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 21:25, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Um Salmona village forced stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Land Confiscation:</u> On December 16th 2015, Israeli forces served a military order for the confiscation of a plot of land approximately 101.559 Dunumes/Acres located in the area between Beit Sahour and Beit Jallah for a period of 10 years for alleged military purposes because of its location near the Wall.
