(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. Closure of Main Roads: (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the gate along the Wall section separating the area of Dahiyat Al-Bareed from Al-Ram town. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandia checkpoint. Checkpoints: (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city.

- (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces escorting Israeli Intelligence officers raided Al-Izariya stormed Al-Quds University and searched student Identification cards.
- (ii) At 10:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Jib village, stormed a storage shed owned by Khadr Sbieh, temporarily detained several residents and released them after interrogation then withdrew at 11:00.
- (iii) On December 18th 2012, Israeli forces raided Al-Isawiya village and detained 2 residents including the attorney for Samer Al-Isawi, a Palestinian detainee currently on hunger strike.

Attack:

- (i) At 15:30, Israeli forces positioned near Silwan neighbourhood fired tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning and detained 2 residents.
- (ii) At 22:30, Israeli forces positioned near Ras Al-Amoud neighbourhood in Jerusalem fired rubber coated steel bullets towards residents for alleged stoning and detained 4 residents.

• Detention:

- (i) On December 18th 2012, Israeli forces detained Mahmoud Masous in Bab Hata area in Jerusalem
- (ii) Israeli forces detained Shireen Al-Isawi and Ahmad Muhiesin in Al-Isawiya village
- (iii) Israeli forces detained Mahmoud Taha and Mohammad Taha in Silwan neighbourhood.
- (iv) Israeli forces detained Muhanad Taha, Mahmoud Taha, Mohammad Taha and Tamer Taha in Ras Al-Amoud neighbourhood.
- **Home Demolition:** On December 18th 2012, Israeli forces served demolition orders for 5 apartments owned by Fatma Al-Jafarat and her 4 sons in Silwan neighbourhood in Jerusalem and ordered them to leave their homes by December 20th 2012.

• Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Sleavawahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
- <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction continued in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma'ale Adumim.
- <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages.

- On November 24th 2012, Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark.
- Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire from their positions behind the Green line towards Khan Yunis.
- Israeli Naval vessels broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Rafah.
