JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On December 18th 2015, the Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound which forced residents to conduct prayers near checkpoints located outside Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikka villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikka village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. (iii) On November 16th 2015, Israeli forces closed the south entrance of Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood in Jerusalem, which leads to “Armon Hantsiv” settlement with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Raid:</u> At 19:20, Israeli forces raided Anata, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 21:15. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:00, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Eizariya fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 14:00, Israeli forces positioned in Ras Al-Amoud neighbourhood in the old city of Jerusalem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iii) At 15:50, Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity of Qalandiya checkpoint fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iv) At 16:30, Israeli forces positioned in Ras Kabsa area in Abu Dis fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (v) At 16:30, Israeli forces positioned near Qalandiya checkpoint opened fire towards Jallal Nazhat Shouman (30 years old) {a resident of Khirbeit Abu Falah} and as a result, left him hospitalised with wounds to the leg after he attempted to run over several Israeli soldiers positioned at the checkpoint {A alleged by the Israeli Military}. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Jallal Nazh at Shouman (30 years old) {A resident of Khirbeit Abu Falah}. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on

On October 3rd 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road located near “Bet El” settlement and leading to Al-Jalazoun camp with cement blocks. (iii) Since November 24th 2015, Israeli forces closed the main entrance of Sinjil and the east entrance of Al-Mughier village with cement blocks. (iv) At 18:50 on December 4th 2015, Israeli forces closed the main entrance of Aboud with cement blocks. (v) On December 15th 2015, Israeli forces closed the West entrance of Al-Labban Al-Gharbi village with cement blocks. (vi) At 21:50 on December 18th 2015, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Silwad with dirt mounds. • <u>Raid:</u> At 02:15, Israeli forces raided Al-Bireh city, stormed a home and summoned Salem Shadi Fathi Matariya to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 03:00. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:50, Israeli forces positioned near “Ofar” military base/ Prison fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 14:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Jalazoun camp fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iii) At 14:20, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Silwad fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iv) At 14:20, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Sinjil fired live ammunition; rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result killed a resident and injured Mohammad Ahmad Aloun. (v) At 15:15, Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity of “Pesagout” settlement located in east Al-Bireh city fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and temporarily detained the child Qusay Jafar Fayezez Abed (14 years old) then released him at a later time. (vi) At 15:55, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Beit Liqya fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Killing:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 17:10, Mohammad Abdel-Rahman Ayed (21 years old){A resident of Silwad} was killed after Israeli forces opened fire towards him as he was driving his vehicle for allegedly attempting to run over several Israeli soldiers near the West entrance of of Silwad {As alleged by the Israeli Military. (ii) The resident: Nash’at Jamal Asfour (33 years old) was killed after Israeli forces opened fire towards him during confrontations in Sinjil. • <u>Demonstrations:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:30, a demonstration took place in Bil’in protesting against the construction of the wall during which they clashed with Israeli forces and as a result injured 3 residents and left several residents suffocated from tear gas inhalation (ii) At 12:30, a demonstration took place in Ni’lin protesting against the

	<p>construction of the wall during which they clashed with Israeli forces and as a result left several residents suffocated from tear gas inhalation.</p> <p>(iii) At 12:30, a demonstration took place in Al-Nabi Saleh village protesting against land confiscation for the purpose of settlement construction and expansion during which they clashed with Israeli forces and as a result left several residents suffocated from tear gas inhalation.</p>
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Road: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • Flying Checkpoint: At 18:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Ya’bad then searched residents and vehicles. • Raid: At dawn on December 19th 2015, Israeli forces raided Jenin, clashed with several residents and detained two residents. • Detention: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At dawn on December 19th 2015, Israeli forces detained 2 residents: Samir Mohammad Yassin and Firas Jamil at a checkpoint in Ya’bad. (ii) Israeli forces detained 2 residents: Ra’ouf Al-Zu’bi and Mohammad Nazal in Jenin. • Wall Gates: Israeli forces continue too close the wall gate and only allow those holding special permits to enter through it.

TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Roads: At 13:50 on December 14th 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Shufa and Izbit Shufa villages located near “Avni Havits” settlement with a steel gate and barbed wire fence. • Checkpoint: At 10:30, Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic until 10:50. • Detention: At 02:20 on December 18th 2015, Israeli forces detained Mohammad Jamal Yusef Qaraq’ during their raid into Tulkarem as mentioned in the previous report.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) Since 16:55 on December 18th 2014, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far’ata village which is located near “Gillad” settlement with dirt mounds (iv) Since 10:40 on September 1st 2015, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far’ata village which is located near “Gillad” settlement with a steel Gate • Flying Checkpoint: At 15:30 and again at 23:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Qalqiliya then searched residents and vehicles • Attack: At 16:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Azzun fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades • Demonstration: At 11:55, a demonstration took place in Kafr Qaddum against the closure of the east entrance during which they clashed with Israeli forces tried to disrupt the demonstration by firing live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards demonstrators who attempted to reach they demonstration site and as a result left several others suffocated from tear gas inhalation.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. (iii) At 06:30 on November 22nd 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Aqraba and Yanoun village with dirt mounds. (iv) On November 29th 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Burin, Awarta and Osirin as well as the agricultural bypass road connecting Aqraba and Qabalan village with dirt mounds. (v) At 13:00 on December 1st 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Tel village and the bypass road near “Yitsahar” settlement and installed a steel gate in the area. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 13:20, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Beit Furiq checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 13:40. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 18:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near “Shave Shomron” settlement junction then searched residents and vehicles until 19:45. • <u>Raid:</u> At 18:20, Israeli forces raided Al-Labban Al-Sharqiya village until 19:00. • <u>Attack:</u> At 13:45, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Qaida area located near Beit Furiq fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 8 residents including 2 children: Hussien Nidal Nassasrah (17 years old), Mohammad Ma’moun Hanini (17 years old), Mohammad Marwan Hassan Malitat, Ahmad Abdel-Hafith Nassasrah, Sanad Wael Hanini, Nidal Nassasrah, Ma’moun Ghmalat and Mohammad Hassan Jamal Nassasrah.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama’ located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za’tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 14:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Marda village then searched residents and vehicles.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raid:</u> At 03:25, Israeli forces raided Kafil Harris, stormed a home and detained a resident. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Osama Ziyad Saleh in Kafil Harris. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 14:25, Israeli forces positioned near “Ariel” settlement temporarily detained Yasser Mohammad Adeli (A resident of Osirin village in Nablus) then released him at 16:25.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 00:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near the Dead Sea junction then searched residents and vehicles until 03:50.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near “Ifrat” settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to “Newe Daniyyel” settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds. (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases. (ix) Since 10:45 on September 8th 2015, Israeli forces closed the agricultural road located in Arab Al-Rashaydeh village located near “Malee Amous” settlement with dirt mounds. (x) At 15:30 on November 20th 2015, Israeli forces closed the east entrance of Jinata and the entrance of Marah Rabah village with dirt mounds. (xi) At 13:10 on November 22nd 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Marah Rabah village with dirt mounds. (xii) At 18:00 on November 27th 2015, Israeli forces closed Bararat junction located

in Ras area in Beit Jallah with cement blocks.

- (xiii) At 14:50 on November 28th 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Um Al-Raqaba area located in Al-Khader with cement blocks.

- **Raid:**

- (i) At 12:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Abiyat area located in Bethlehem, set up a checkpoint, temporarily detained Muhanad Abdallah Abu Jurah and released him at a later time then withdrew at 19:30.
- (ii) On the evening of December 18th 2015, Israeli forces raided Nihalin village, clashed with several residents and as a result left an infant suffocated from tear gas inhalation.
- (iii) At 03:05, Israeli forces raided Beit Fajjar and summoned two residents: Mujahid Mohammad Ismail Thawabteh and Assad Abdel-Latif Thawabteh to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 06:20.
- (iv) At dawn on December 19th 2015, Israeli forces raided Al-Waljat village, stormed a home, and summoned Hisham Al-Atrash to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning.

- **Detention:** At 10:10, Israeli forces positioned at “Kafr Itsiyon” settlement junction detained 2 residents: Alaa Ismail Awad Zien and Issa Abu Fanous {Both residents of Yatta}.

- **Attack:**

- (i) At 12:50, Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity of Billal Bin Rabah mosque located in North Bethlehem, in Al-Ayda camp located in North Bethlehem fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 8 residents including 4 children: Oday Riyad Ismail Zawahra (17 years old), Islam Abdel-Salam Yahya Jaber (16 years old), Mahmoud Adel Mahmoud Zaboun (17 years old), Mohammad Nader Shafiq Qulieb (17 years old), Muntaser Bilah Riyad Rashid Abu Sarour, Mu'tasim Marwan Salhab, Yusef Mohammad Ibrahim Jawarish, Bashar Yusef Hussein Al-Shalmouli as well as leaving several others suffocated from tear gas inhalation.
- (ii) At 14:05, Israeli forces positioned near the west entrance of Taqou' fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 2 residents including a child: Musa Mohammad Mahmoud Thawib (17 years old and occupied Bassam Ali Hajjajjha's home and converted its rooftop into a military post.

HEBRON

- **Closure:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
 - (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.
- **Closure of Main Roads:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
 - (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
 - (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
 - (v) At 05:50 on November 5th 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance leading Farsh Al-Hawa area in Hebron with Cement blocks.
 - (vi) At 10:30 on November 8th 2015, Israeli forces closed the junction located near "Hagi" settlement located in south Hebron with cement blocks.
 - (vii) At 21:00 on November 11th 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Beit Awwa and Al-Majd village with cement block and dirt mounds.
 - (viii) At 15:45 on November 15th 2015, Israeli forces closed Al-Samiya village junction located at the west entrance of Al-Samou' with cement blocks.
 - (ix) On November 15th 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrances of Khliat Al-Miya and Al Dirat and the two bypass roads leading east Yatta with cement blocks.
 - (x) On November 23rd 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Al-Qom village located in North Beit Awwa with Cement blocks.
 - (xi) On December 1st 2015, Israeli forces closed a checkpoint located along Al-Shuhada road located in the old city of Hebron and prevented residents from passing through the checkpoint and redirected traffic through a road near the entrance of Jabal Al-Rahma.
