- (i) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the gate along the Wall section separating the area of Dahiyat Al-Bareed from Al-Ram town.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandia checkpoint.

JERUSALEM

• Checkpoints:

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city.
- (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- (iii) On December 15th 2012, Israeli forces increased its restrictions at Ja'aba checkpoint, searched vehicles with bomb sniffing dogs and impeded the free flow of traffic.

• Raid:

- (i) At dawn on December 18th 2012, Israeli forces raided Qalandiya camp and clashed with its residents.
- (ii) At 10:30 and again at 19:50, Israeli forces raided Al-Isawiya village, closed its entrance with checkpoints, clashed with residents as they stormed a protest tent demonstrating in solidarity with Samer Al-Isawi,

who is on hunger strike protesting his detention, clashed with resident for
a second time as they stormed homes and a soccer field then detained a
resident.

• Attack:

- (i) At 21:0, Israeli forces positioned at a checkpoint at the entrance of Shu'fat camp fired tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning, detained 7 residents and assaulted Hassan Zaki.
- (ii) At 18:45, Israeli forces positioned at Qalandiya checkpoint fired tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning.

• Detention:

- (i) At 21:00, Israeli forces detained Najeh Bakriyat, the head of Al-Aqsa mosque after storming his home.
- (ii) Israeli forces detained Wajdi Mahmoud, Muhanad Mahmoud and Mohammad Darwish in Al-Isawiya village.
- (iii) Israeli forces detained Amir Muhsin (14 years) and Salah Al-Rajabi (15 years) of the 7 detained in Suhfat checkpoint in Jerusalem.
- <u>Temporary Detention:</u> On December 19th 2012, Israeli court sentenced Shireen Al-Isawi to 10 days under house arrest and imposed a fine of 2500 NIS approximately \$650.

• Settlement Activity:

- (i) On December 19th 2012, Israeli authorities approved plans for the construction of 2612 settlement unites in "Jiv'at Hamatus" located in south Jerusalem on land occupied in 1967.
- (ii) On December 19th 2012, the Israeli ministry of public works and housing approved the construction of 1600 settlement unites in "Jif'at Zif" and "Harouhmat" settlements located in north and south Jerusalem on land occupied in 1967.
- Assault on Places of Worship: On December 19th 2012, Israeli Intelligence officers and Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli police stormed Al-Aqsa Mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshipers.

• Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Sleavawahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
- <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction continued in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma'ale Adumim.

• <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages.

- <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 15:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint beneath Yabrud Village Bridge.
- **Raid**: At 04:45, Israeli forces raided Beituniya until 05:20.

• Attack: At 15:40, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Silwad fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

- **<u>Detention</u>**: On December 19th 2012, Israeli forces positioned near "Bet El" settlement Ziyad Mohammad, a resident of Ein Arik for allegedly finding a knife in his possession.
- <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction continued in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala; the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks.
- (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.

• Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) At 10:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Taquo
- (ii) At 21:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the west entrance of Beit Fajjar until 02:30.
- Raid: At 09:50, Israeli forces raided Beit Fajjar and clashed with its residents.
- Settlement Activity: On December 19th 2012, Israeli authorities approved the construction of 523 settlement units in "Jivaot" settlement located between Nilhalin and AL-Jab'at Gharb located in Bethlehem on land occupied in 1967.
- <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 12:15, Israeli settlers stormed AL-Jab'a village, assaulted and injured Haytham Hamdan and Na'im Hamdan.
- <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in North West of Beit Jala town.

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to the entrance to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) On July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat

and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.

• Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) At 15:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Ithna.
- (ii) At 17:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Ramadin village until 18:00.
- (iii)At 18:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Halhul bridge.

• Raid:

- (i) At 00:45, Israeli forces raided Hebron, stormed and searched 2 homes and a money exchange store, detained 2 residents then withdrew 03:45.
- (ii) At 02:55 Israeli forces raided Al-Urub camp, stormed a home, detained a resident then withdrew 04:10.
- (iii) At 03:00, Israeli forces raided Beit Ummar, stormed and searched 2 homes and summoned Adib Oday, Adham Oday and Haytham Oday.
- (iv) At 03:25, Israeli forces raided Ithna and fired stun grenades towards several residents.
- <u>Attack:</u> At 14:20, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Urub camp fired tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning.

• <u>Detention:</u>

- (i) At 03:35 on December 19th 2012, Israeli forces detained Wassim Wahdien during their raid into Beit Ummar.
- (ii) Israeli forces detained an unidentified individual in Ithna.
- (iii) Israeli forces detained Omar Al-Qawasmi and Sajid Al-Qawasmi in Hebron.
- (iv) Israeli forces detained Mahmoud Al-Bis in Al-Urub camp.
- <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahriya town.

GAZA STRIP

ALL DISTRICTS

- At 21:00 on November 21st 2012, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire.
- On November 24th 2012, Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark.
- Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement by raiding North Gaza and levelled agricultural land.

	 Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire from their positions behind the Green line towards North Gaza.
NORTHERN GAZA	 Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businessmen and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination. Raid: At 07:00 on December 19th 2012, Israeli forces escorting several military bulldozers raided 200 meters into the vicinity of Beit Hanun opened fire towards residents near the border fence east of Beit Hanun then withdrew at 13:40. Attack: At 13:50, Israeli forces opened fire and fired tear gas grenades from their positions behind the Green Line towards several residents as they were in their agricultural land near the border fence in Jabaliya.
GAZA	 Closure of Crossing Points: Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
CENTRAL GAZA	 <u>Killing:</u> On December 19th 2012, Salim Bin Sa'id died of injuries sustained from Israeli airstrikes on Deir Al-Balah on November 17th 2012. <u>Detention:</u> At 13:30 on December 17th 2012, Israeli forces detained Yusef Nabhan (17 years old), Firas Washah (17 years old), Sa'eb Farh (17 years old) and A'hed Abu Zied (15 years old).
RAFAH	 Closure of Crossing Points: Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. Rafah (Al 'Awdah) Crossing is open for the exit of patients, students, passengers with permits and International aid. Sufa Crossing is closed. Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is open for the entry of humanitarian supplies, cooking gas, truckloads of wheat and Livestock feed as well as exporting 4 shipments of strawberries and vegetables and construction material for internationally funded projects.
