<p style="text-align: center;">JERUSALEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On December 19th 2015, the Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound, which forced residents to conduct prayers near checkpoints located outside Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. (iii) On November 16th 2015, Israeli forces closed the south entrance of Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood in Jerusalem, which leads to “Armon Hantsiv” settlement with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and at 21:00 closed the checkpoint after alleged shooting incident towards the checkpoint(as alleged by the Israeli military) then reopened it at 23:15. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. (iii) At 21:30, Israeli forces closed Jaba’ checkpoint located along the main road connecting Jerusalem, Ramallah and Jericho Districts, impeded the free flow of traffic then reopened it at 23:30. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 20:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Bir Nabala then searched residents and vehicles. (ii) At 22:00, Israeli forces set up two checkpoints at Anata junction and at the entrance of Biddu then searched residents and vehicles. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 21:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Ram until 02:00. (ii) At 21:45, Israeli forces raided Qalandiya camp, clashed with several residents and as a result injured the child Fida Samir Kamil Shukiya (14 years old) then withdrew at 01:55. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 20:00, Israeli forces positioned at Qalandiya camp temporarily detained Sa’ed Al-Jabr (A resident of Qusra village in Nablus District) then released him at 21:30. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.

	<p>(ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.</p>

On October 3rd 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road located near “Bet El” settlement and leading to Al-Jalazoun camp with cement blocks. (iii) Since November 24th 2015, Israeli forces closed the main entrance of Sinjil and the east entrance of Al-Mughier village with cement blocks. (iv) At 18:50 on December 4th 2015, Israeli forces closed the main entrance of Abboud with cement blocks. (v) On December 15th 2015, Israeli forces closed the West entrance of Al-Labban Al-Gharbi village with cement blocks. (vi) At 21:50 on December 18th 2015, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Silwad with dirt mounds. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Ein Sina village roundabout then searched residents and vehicles until 10:45. (ii) At 19:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Nabi Saleh village, impeded the free flow of traffic, detained a resident and opened fire randomly towards the village entrance because of an alleged fire booming incident towards a military watch tower in the area. (iii) At 22:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Surda village, opened fire towards a civilian vehicle for allegedly not stopping at the checkpoint then withdrew at 23:00. • <u>Raid:</u> At 19:25, Israeli forces raided Khirbathat Al-Misbah, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 19:50. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:55, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Silwad fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 15:25, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Al-Mughier village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result set fire to the home of Abdel-Hameed Fathi Abu Aliya during which local residents were able to extinguish the fire. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Ra’fat Salameh (A resident of Jerusalem) near the entrance of Al-Nabi Saleh village.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • <u>Raid:</u> At 18:00, Israeli forces raided Ya’bad and stormed a home. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Israeli forces continue too close the wall gate and only allow those holding special permits to enter through it.
TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raid:</u> At 02:30, Israeli forces raided Tamoun, stormed and searched the home of Mohammad Faysal Basharats (A Palestinian detained by Israeli forces for allegedly stabbing a Israeli settler in Ra’ana city inside Israel) during which Israeli Intelligence officers questioned his family members and served a military order to demolish their home during which they clashed with several residents and as a result injured Mohammad Ali Omar Basharat then withdrew at 03:30.

TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> At 13:50 on December 14th 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Shufa and Izbit Shufa villages located near “Avni Havits” settlement with a steel gate and barbed wire fence. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) Since 16:55 on December 18th 2014, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far’ata village which is located near “Gillad” settlement with dirt mounds (iv) Since 10:40 on September 1st 2015, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far’ata village which is located near “Gillad” settlement with a steel Gate • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in the area between Sir Village and Azzun then searched residents and vehicles. (ii) At 14:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near the entrance of Hajja village then searched residents and vehicles. • <u>Raid:</u> At 00:20, Israeli forces raided Hablat town until 05:30. • <u>Demonstration:</u> At 16:00, a demonstration took place in Kafr Qaddum against the closure of the east entrance during which they clashed with Israeli forces tried to disrupt the demonstration by firing live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards demonstrators who attempted to reach they demonstration site and as a result injured Jamil Hilmi Ishtewi (17 years old). • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya, the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. (iii) At 06:30 on November 22nd 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Aqraba and Yanoun village with dirt mounds.

(iii) At 19:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Deir Sharaf junction (located along the main road connecting Nablus and Tulkarem) and impeded the free flow of traffic until 20:35. (iv) At 20:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Osirin village junction then searched residents and vehicles until 21:00. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At dawn on December 19th 2015, Israeli forces raided Jama’in village then stormed and searched two homes. (ii) At 02:05, Israeli forces raided Duma village as they escorted several Israeli settlers {who were re-enacting the murder of Al-Dawabsheh family} then withdrew at 02:25. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 16:45, Israeli forces positioned near Burin village junction temporarily detained two children: Ameer Imad Assous (14 years old) and Diya Imad Al-Din Amran (15 years old). • <u>Attack:</u> At 13:45, Israeli forces positioned in Jabal Al-Aqdat area located in south east Beit Furiq fired live ammunition, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Imad Daoud Mohammad Daoud (A resident of Ain Beit Al-Ma camp in Nablus). • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 22:25, a Israeli settler positioned near “Shavot Arhil” settlement installed a barbed wire fence around a plot of land (Approximately 7 dunums) owned by Mohammad Abdel-Aziz Musa located in Qaryut village in an attempt to confiscate it.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama’ located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za’tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 17:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the west entrance of Kafr Al-Dik then searched residents and vehicles. (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
