#### WEST BANK

#### • Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

#### • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the gate along the Wall section separating the area of Dahiyat Al-Bareed from Al-Ram town.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandia checkpoint.

## • Checkpoints:

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city.
- (ii) On September 19<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- (iii) On December 15<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces increased its restrictions at Ja'aba checkpoint, searched vehicles with bomb sniffing dogs and impeded the free flow of traffic.

#### • Raid:

- (i) At 18:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Isawiya village, clashed with its residents and detained a resident.
- (ii) At 03:30, Israeli forces raided Dahiyat Al-Barid area in Jerusalem and detained 2 residents.
- (iii) At 04:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Ram, stormed a gas station, temporarily detained and interrogated its workers releasing them at a later time.

#### • Detention:

- (i) Israeli forces detained Ameer Al-Wahad in Al-Isawiya village.
- (ii) Israeli forces detained Walid Idreis and Sami Abbasi in Dahiyat Al-Barid area in Jerusalem.
- <u>Settlement Activity:</u> On December 20<sup>th</sup> 2012, Idraeli authorities approved the construction of a road connecting Beit Safafa village with "Gilo" settlement in south Jerusalem.
- **Demonstration:** On December 20<sup>th</sup> 2012, a demonstration took place in front of the head quarters of the International Red Cross in Jerusalem in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons.
