JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On December 20th 2015, the Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshippers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound which forced residents to conduct prayers near checkpoints located outside Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. (iii) On November 16th 2015, Israeli forces closed the south entrance of Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood in Jerusalem, which leads to “Armon Hantsiv” settlement with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and at 21:00 closed the checkpoint after alleged shooting incident towards the checkpoint(as alleged by the Israeli military) then reopened it at 23:15. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At dawn on December 20th 2015 and again at 19:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Eizariya, detained a resident and clashed with several residents. (ii) At dawn on December 20th 2015, Israeli forces raided Abu Dis and summoned Maher Radwan to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning. • <u>Attack:</u> At 09:30, Israeli forces positioned in Silwan neighbourhood in Jerusalem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several labourers as they chased them. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:35, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Za’im checkpoint detained 4 residents: Sharif Khader Sharif, Musa Amjad Al-Titi, Khaled Saleem Rushdi and Haytham Yusef Abu Ghazi {All residents of Al-Arob camp in Hebron}. (ii) At dawn on December 21st 2015, Israeli forces detained 3 residents including 2 children: Ali Khaled Owisat (16 years old), Ahmad Khaled Owisat (16 years old) and Bassam Qanbar in Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood in Jerusalem. (iii) Israeli forces detained Ameen Hussien Rabi’ Far’oun in Al-Eizariya. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 10:00, a group of Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli Military and Police forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshippers. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu

	<p>Dis town.</p> <p>(ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.</p>
RAMALLAH & AL BIREH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and ‘Ein Samiya villages (ii) . On October 3rd 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road located near “Bet El” settlement and leading to Al-Jalazoun camp with cement blocks. (iii) Since November 24th 2015, Israeli forces closed the main entrance of Sinjil and the east entrance of Al-Mughier village with cement blocks. (iv) At 18:50 on December 4th 2015, Israeli forces closed the main entrance of Abboud with cement blocks. (v) On December 15th 2015, Israeli forces closed the West entrance of Al-Labban Al-Gharbi village with cement blocks. (vi) At 21:50 on December 18th 2015, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Silwad with dirt mounds. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Taybeh junction (located along the main road connecting Ramallah and Jericho) then searched residents and vehicles. (ii) At 17:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Turmus’aya then searched residents and vehicles until 18:00. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:50, Israeli forces raided Beituniya, temporarily detained 3 children: Akram Yacoub Abdel-Fattah Abu Daya (14 years old), Ibrahim Mohammad Hamad Sabtiya and Yazan Mahmoud Abu Daya (14 years old) then released him at 21:00. (ii) At 03:45, Israeli forces raided Silwad, stormed and searched the home of Mohammad Abdel-Rahman Ayad {who was killed by Israeli forces} and took measurements of the home in order to prepare it for demolition, detained a resident then withdrew at 06:00. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Ghalib Sami Warda in Silwad. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:20, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Silwad fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 16:20, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Sinjil fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • <u>Raid:</u> At 10:15, Israeli forces raided Ya’bad and clashed with several residents then withdrew at 11:15. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Israeli forces continue too close the wall gate and only allow those holding special permits to enter through it.
TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raid:</u> At 18:25, Israeli forces raided Tamoun and clashed with several residents.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> At 13:50 on December 14th 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Shufa and Izbit Shufa villages located near “Avni Havits”

	<p>settlement with a steel gate and barbed wire fence.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 14:20, Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic until 16:40. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 21:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Bazariya village junction located in east Anabta then searched residents and vehicles. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 19:15, Israeli forces raided Kafr Al-Jamal village until 20:10. (ii) At 02:20, Israeli forces raided Tulkarem, stormed and searched several homes, detained 2 residents including a physician and University student then withdrew at 03:25. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained two residents: Abdel-Raheem Bassam Abu Shanab (a physician) and Hadi Imad Al-Sadr (a University student) in Tulkarem. • <u>Attack:</u> At 11:30, Israeli forces positioned near Ghashouri factories located in west Tulkarem fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 8 residents including 2 children: Fadi Sami Husni Jayous (15 years old), Qays Thaeir Suliman (17 years old), Baker Hassan Odeh Hassan Jama’in, Wadah Hassan Sami Hushiyeh, Ahmad Thafer Mahmoud Darak, Ashraf Kahled Rizq-Allah Khalil, Nour Al-Din Rif’at Khaled Harshat, Mohammad Suhiel Ghannam as well as leaving several others suffocated from tear gas inhalation.

(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) Since 16:55 on December 18th 2014, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far’ata village which is located near “Gillad” settlement with dirt mounds (iv) Since 10:40 on September 1st 2015, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far’ata village which is located near “Gillad” settlement with a steel Gate • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 20:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in the area between Baqat Al-Hattab and Sir Village then searched residents and vehicles until 22:25. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:40, Israeli forces raided Al-Nabi Eliyas village then stormed and searched several merchant shops. (ii) At 01:20, Israeli forces raided Hajja village then summoned Ra’fat Zuheir Ahmad Shan’a to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning. (iii) At 01:30, Israeli forces raided Jit village, stormed and searched two homes, detained a University student and confiscated three computers. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Nu’mān Daraghmeḥ Yameen (A University student) in Jit village. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.

<p style="text-align: center;">NABLUS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. (iii) At 06:30 on November 22nd 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Aqraba and Yanoun village with dirt mounds. (iv) On November 29th 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Burin, Awarta and Osirin as well as the agricultural bypass road connecting Aqraba and Qabalan village with dirt mounds. (v) At 13:00 on December 1st 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Tel village and the bypass road near “Yitsahar” settlement and installed a steel gate in the area. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:20 and again at 21:00, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Huwara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 21:20. (ii) At 18:30, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Beit Furiq checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 21:40. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in the area between Al-Bithan and Al-Far’a village then searched residents and vehicles. (ii) At 21:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near “Shave Shomron” settlement junction then searched residents and vehicles until 22:55. • <u>Attack:</u> At 14:20, Israeli forces positioned in Jabal Al-Aqda area located in south east Beit Furiq fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

(ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama’ located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za’tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 20:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Kafil Harris then searched residents and vehicles.

(ii) At 19:00, Israeli forces positioned at Allenby Bridge temporarily detained Imad Rashid Sab’ Qablawi (A National Security Force Officer) as he was

<p>BETHLEHEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds. (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases. (ix) Since 10:45 on September 8th 2015, Israeli forces closed the agricultural road located in Arab Al-Rashaydeh village located near "Malee Amous" settlement with dirt mounds. (x) At 15:30 on November 20th 2015, Israeli forces closed the east entrance of Jinata and the entrance of Marah Rabah village with dirt mounds. (xi) At 13:10 on November 22nd 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Marah Rabah village with dirt mounds. (xii) At 18:00 on November 27th 2015, Israeli forces closed Bararat junction located in Ras area in Beit Jallah with cement blocks. (xiii) At 14:50 on November 28th 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Um Al-Raqaba area located in Al-Khader with cement blocks. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the west entrance of Beit Fajjar then searched residents and vehicles. (ii) At 10:25, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Khader fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
<p>HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Queisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) At 05:50 on November 5th 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance leading Farsh Al-Hawa area in Hebron with Cement blocks. (vi) At 10:30 on November 8th 2015, Israeli forces closed the junction located near "Hagi" settlement located in south Hebron with cement blocks. (vii) At 21:00 on November 11th 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Beit Awwa and Al-Majd village with cement block and dirt mounds. (viii) At 15:45 on November 15th 2015, Israeli forces closed Al-Samiya village junction located at the west entrance of Al-Samou' with cement blocks. (ix) On November 15th 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrances of Khliat Al-Miya and Al Dirat and the two bypass roads leading east Yatta with cement blocks. (x) On November 23rd 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Al-Qom village located in North Beit Awwa with Cement blocks. (xi) On December 1st 2015, Israeli forces closed a checkpoint located along Al-Shuhada road located in the old city of Hebron and prevented residents from passing through

the checkpoint and redirected traffic through a road near the entrance of Jabal Al-Rahma .

(xii) On December 9th 2015, Israeli forces closed a road near Jabal Jallis area located in the old city of Hebron and closed the bypass road.

(xiii) On December 11th 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Sa'ir located near road (60) with dirt mounds.

- **Flying Checkpoint:** At 20:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Fahs area located in south Hebron city and then surveyed the area after an alleged shooting incident towards Israeli forces at the checkpoint (As alleged by Israeli forces).

- **Raid:**

- (i) At 11:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Mushafir area located in south east Yatta then stormed and searched a local secondary school as well as several other homes.

- (ii) At 00:50, Israeli force raided Hebron city until 02:30.

- (iii) At 02:20, Israeli forces raided Beit Awwa and detained 3 residents including 2 children after storming and searching their homes then withdrew at 05:40.

- (iv) At 02:20, Israeli forces raided Halhoul and detained 3 residents including a child then withdrew at 05:40.

- **Attack:**

- (i) At 11:10, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Fuwar camp junction fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

- (ii) At 13:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Shhuhada road located in the old city of Hebron opened fire towards Abla Ahmad Mohammad Al-Adm (46 years old) for allegedly attempting to stab a Israeli soldier {as alleged by the Israeli Military} and as a result left her critically injured and then detained her during which Israeli forces clashed with several residents and as a result injured 4 residents including 2 children: Foad Osama Mohammad Ahmad (6 years old) {critically injured with facial injuries}, Abdel-Kareem Awad Abdel-Kareem Masaq (13 years old), Nabeela Omar Haaroub and Eyad Ahmad Sa'ed Mubarak {critical head injury}.

- (iii) At 20:50, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Aroub camp fired live ammunition and rubber coated steel bullets towards several residents for alleged stoning.

- **Detention:**

- (i) At 23:00 on December 19th 2015, Israeli forces detained Maher Al-Qawasmi during their raid into Hebron as mentioned in the previous report.

- (ii) Israeli forces detained three resident: Karam Taha Musa Masalmeh (17 years old), Akram Rasmi Al-Masalmeh (17 years old) and Saed Ibrahim Zamar'a in Bet Awwa.

- (iii) Israeli forces detained three residents: Baha Issa Abdel-Haleem Zamar'a (17 years old), Abdel-Haleem Issa Zamar'a and Samer Jamal Mohammad Zamar'a in Halhoul.

- (iv) Israeli forces detained Ahmad Mohammad Al-Adam (46 years old) {a resident of Beit Ulla} near the entrance of Al-Shhuhada road located in the old city of Hebron.

- **Settler Violence:** At 20:30, Israeli settlers stormed Al-Salaymeh neighbourhood in the old city of Hebron.
