<p>JERUSALEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• <u>Closure:</u><ul style="list-style-type: none">(i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city for the alleged stabbing of an Israeli settler.(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.(iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages.• <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u><ul style="list-style-type: none">(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village.(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.• <u>Checkpoints:</u><ul style="list-style-type: none">(i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:20 and impeded the free flow of traffic until 04:05.(ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.• <u>Attacks:</u><ul style="list-style-type: none">(i) At 12:35, Israeli forces positioned at Qalandia checkpoint fired steel bullets and tear gas canisters at civilians.(ii) At 15:00, Israeli forces near Anata fired steel bullets, stun grenades and tear gas canisters at civilians.• <u>House Demolition:</u> At 15:20, Israeli forces on Mount of Olives in Jerusalem handed over a house demolition order to Akram Salah Shurafa under the pretext of unlicensed construction.• <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 08:00, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli Police and Military stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound and provoked worshippers.• <u>Wall Gates:</u><ul style="list-style-type: none">(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.(ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

<p style="text-align: center;">RAMALLAH & AL BIREH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. • <u>Raids:</u> At 23:30, Israeli forces raided Dur Al-Are village, stormed several civilian homes, arrested four civilians and withdrew at 03:20. • <u>Detention:</u> The four civilians detained in Dura village are Mousa Bajes, Qassam Mustafa, Ibrahim Qassem and Mohammad Zbeidi. • <u>Attacks:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:40, Israeli forces near the entrance of Sinjil village fired stun grenades and tear gas canisters at civilians. (ii) At 11:35, Israeli forces near the entrance of Kafr Thulth village fired live bullets, rubber coated bullets, stun grenades and tear gas canisters at civilians injuring Sameh Adli Hammad, 16. (iii) At 11:45, Israeli forces at the western entrance of Silwad fire tear gas canisters and stun grenades at civilians. (iv) At 11:55, Israeli forces near the entrance of Deir Nizam village fired stun grenades and tear gas canisters at civilians for alleged stoning. • <u>Demolition of Property:</u> at 04:00, Israeli forces demolished a blacksmith workshop owned by Asaad Nakhleh near Jalazon refugee camp under the pretext of unlicensed construction.

(ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • <u>Raids:</u> At 10:30, Israeli forces raided Ya’bad, stormed one civilian home, detained Mutaz Hamdan, 14, and released him later and withdrew at 13:00. • <u>Detention:</u> At 14:30, Israeli forces detained at Movo Detan checkpoint on the main road connecting Jenin and Tulkarem a civilian called Abdel Halim Younis and released him at 14:45. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Israeli forces intensified restrictions at wall gates denying access except before civilians with special permits.

<p style="text-align: center;">TULKAREM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Detention:</u> At 03:00 on 22 December 2014, Israeli forces detained Rami Othman after raiding Shweiki suburb in Tulkarem city.
<p style="text-align: center;">QALQILIYA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) At 12:10 on September 2nd 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Qalqiliya and Nablus near Al-Nabi Eliyas village with cement blocks.

(iii) At 20:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Jayyous town and Sir Village until 21:20. • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:20, Israeli forces raided and patrolled Asla village. (ii) At 16:30, Israeli forces raided and patrolled Qalqilya. (iii) At 02:15, Israeli forces raided Far; ata village, stormed a civilian home and arrested one civilian, confiscated a computer and a mobile phone and withdrew at 03:15. • <u>Detention:</u> The civilian detained in Imatin village is Islam Amin Mohammad Tawil. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya, the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 09:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Nablus city and Aseera Shimaliya town, detained Ziyad Huleileh from Jenin, released him later and withdrew at 11:15. • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:0, Israeli forces raided and patrolled Sawiyeh village until 12:45. (ii) At 02:30, Israeli forces raided Kafr Qalil village, stormed 3 civilian homes and summoned Ahed Abu Al-Turab to the military intelligence and withdrew at 03:45. (iii) At 01:30, Israeli forces raided Salem village, stormed three civilian homes, detained one civilian and withdrew at 03:20. • <u>Detention:</u> The civilian detained in Salem village is Ahmad Abdel Fattah Issa. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 14:00, settlers raided agricultural land in Bourin village and Israeli forces fired stun grenades and tear gas canisters at civilians and withdrew at 14:30.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama’ located in western area of Deir Istiya with

(ii) At 09:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the northern entrance of Jericho until 10:25. (iii) At 17:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the southern entrance of Jericho until 18:25. (iv) At 00:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Nabi Mousa junction (main Jericho-Hebron road) until 00:50.

(ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds. (vi) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases. • Flying Checkpoints: At 12:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the northern entrance of Beit Jala until 14:10. • Attacks: At 09:40, Israeli forces positioned near Aida refugee camp fired stun grenades and tear gas canisters at civilians for alleged stoning.

(iii) At 16:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Fawwar junction; detained one civilian called Mohammad Ghatasha and released him at 21:00. (iv) At 21:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Beit Einon junction and detained Mousa Froukh and released him later. • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 22:30, Israeli forces raided Edna and handed two house demolition orders and one order for the demolition of a sheepfold owned by Nayef Tmeizi and Ashaf Al-Batran under the pretext of unlicensed construction. (ii) At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Hebron and detained a university student after storming his home and withdrew at 05:00. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The civilian detained at Fawwar junction in Faraj Mohammad Abdallah Toubasi. (ii) The civilian detained in Hebron is Mahmoud Badr. • <u>Attacks:</u> At 09:30, Israeli forces in Talat Abu Hadid area in the old city of Hebron forces stun grenades and tear gas canisters at civilians. • <u>Levelling of Land:</u> On 22 December 2014, Israeli bulldozers razed land near Arroub refugee camp for setting up fence alongside the camp.

<p style="text-align: center;">ALL DISTRICTS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month.

Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iyah (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.

(ii) Rafah (<i>Al 'Awdah</i>) Crossing is open for the entry and exit of residents, tourists and students entering from the Republic of Egypt. Israeli forces allowed entry of 120 humanitarian aid tons from Algeria into Gaza and 100 tons from UAE. (iii) Sufa Crossing is closed. (iv) Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is open for the entry of tourist and foreign diplomats and the entry of Humanitarian assistance.
