WEST BANK

Closure:

- (i) On December 21st 2015, the Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound which forced residents to conduct prayers near checkpoints located outside Al-Agsa mosque compound.
- The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in (ii) the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a (iii) hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

Closure of Main Roads:

- The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the (i) entrance to Jaba' village.
- The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to (ii) Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.
- On November 16th 2015, Israeli forces closed the south entrance of Jabal Al-(iii) Mukabir neighbourhood in Jerusalem which leads to "Armon Hantsiv" settlement with cement blocks.

Checkpoints:

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and at 21:00 closed the checkpoint after alleged shooting incident towards the checkpoint(as alleged by the Israeli military) then reopened it at 23:15.
- (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- (iii) At 13:00, Israeli forces closed Jaba' checkpoint located along the road connecting Jerusalem, Ramallah and Jericho and impeded the free flow of traffic until 16:20.
- Raid: At 02:35, Israeli forces raided Abu Dis and Al –Eizariya then detained a resident in Abu Dis.
- Attack: At 20:00, Israeli forces positioned near the North junction of Al-Ram fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning then detained a child.

Detention:

- (i) Israeli forces detained Ahmad Ayad in Abu Dis.
- (ii) Israeli forces detained Ahmad Abu Sbeih (16 years old) near the North junction of Al-Ram.
- Confiscation of Property: On December 22nd 2015, Israeli forces forced the merchant Hussien Al-Qaisi to remove his entire product from inside his shop located in Agbat Al-Khalida area in the old city of Jerusalem, which was then confiscated in order to allow an Israeli settler group the store.
- Assault on Places of Worship: At 08:00, a group of Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli Military and Police forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshipers.

- (iv) At 03:00, Israeli forces raided Bethlehem, detained 3 residents then withdrew at 04:00.
- (v) At dawn on December 23rd 2015, Israeli forces raided Asakra village and detained a resident.

• Attack:

- (i) At 09:10, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ayda camp located in North Bethlehem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (ii) At 09:35, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Khader fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

- (v) At 05:50 on November 5th 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance leading Farsh Al-Hawa area in Hebron with Cement blocks.

- (iv) At 11:50, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Aroub camp fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (v) At 19:00, Israeli forces positioned near Halhoul Bridge fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

• Detention:

- (i) At 09:00, Israeli forces detained Abeer Al-Tamimi {A resident of Hebron} in the old city of Hebron for alleged finding a knife in her possession.
- (ii) At 11:50, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Al-Aroub camp detained Azmi Banat (A journalist) {A resident of Al-Aroub camp}.
- (iii) At 12:000, Israeli forces detained Nathir Kamal Nasar (A resident of Dura).
- (iv) Israeli forces detained 3 residents: Yusef Islafi, Wisam Al-Haymouni and Ala Al-Karaki in Hebron city.
- <u>Settler Violence</u>: At 10:45, A Israeli settler "Anat Cohen" prevented several school children from leaving their school in the old city of Hebron then withdrew at 12:00.

- At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month.
- Israeli forces broke the cease-fire agreement by raiding opening fire towards

	 Central Gaza. Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire from their positions from behind the Green Line towards North Gaza, Central Gaza and Khan Yunis and as a result injured 4 residents. Israeli Naval vessels broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of North Gaza.
