JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On December 23th 2015, the Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshippers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound which forced residents to conduct prayers near checkpoints located outside Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. (iii) On November 16th 2015, Israeli forces closed the south entrance of Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood in Jerusalem which leads to “Armon Hantsiv” settlement with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and at 21:00 closed the checkpoint after alleged shooting incident towards the checkpoint(as alleged by the Israeli military) then reopened it at 23:15. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 20:00, Israeli forces set up checkpoint at the entrance of Budros searching residents and vehicles. (ii) At 22:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Bir Nabala searching residents and vehicles. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 03:00 on December 23rd 2015, Israeli forces raided Al-Jaderah village and detained four residents. (ii) At 22:05, Israeli forces raided Al-Eisawiya village, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 23:00. (iii) At 02:50, Israeli forces raided Abu Dis and stormed a University Students Dormitory. • <u>Killing:</u> At 13:50, 2 residents : Annan Mohammad Hamad Abu Hasbat (21 years old) and Issa Yassin Assaf (22 years old) were killed after Israeli forces opened fire towards them near Bab Al-Khalil gate area in Jerusalem for allegedly stabbing several Israeli settlers {killing 1 settler}{as alleged by the Israeli Military}. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:45, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Hizma village fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas

	<p>grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 4 children: Mohammad Habass Talib Salah Al-Din (16 years old), Mohammad Hassan Mohammad Al-Khatib (16 years old), Mohammad Sanad Mohammad Sa'id (15 years old) and Salah Mohammad Shalabi Askar (16 years old) and detained 6 residents including 4 children {3 of those children suffered injuries}.</p> <p>(ii) At 20:35, Israeli forces positioned at Qalandiya checkpoint fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At dawn on December 24th 2015, Israeli forces positioned in Ras Al-Amoud neighbourhood detained the child: Ma'rouf Matour (16 years old). (ii) At dawn on December 24th 2015, Israeli forces detained the child Nader Naji Awisat (16 years old) in Jabal Mukabir neighbourhood. (iii) Israeli forces detained four residents: Sanad Ikram Barjis, Mohammad Ashraf Barjis, Ala Shawqi Badis and Moham mad Badis in Al-Judiria village. (iv) Israeli forces detained 6 residents: Salah Mohammad Shalabi Askar (16 years old){injured}, Mohammad Habbas Salah Al-Din (14 years old){Injured}, Mohammad Sanad Harbi Sa'ed (15 years old){Injured}, Mohammad Saber Talib Sa'id (15 years old), Ahmad Nassir Maqboul Salah Al-Din and Salah Majid Ma'rouf near the entrance of Hizma. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 08:30, a group of Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli Military and Police forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshippers. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

On October 3rd 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road located near "Bet El" settlement and leading to Al-Jalazoun camp with cement blocks. (iii) Since November 24th 2015, Israeli forces closed the main entrance of Sinjil and the east entrance of Al-Mughier village with cement blocks. (iv) At 18:50 on December 4th 2015, Israeli forces closed the main entrance of Abboud with cement blocks. (v) On December 15th 2015, Israeli forces closed the West entrance of Al-Labban Al-Gharbi village with cement blocks. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Yabroud village, temporarily detained Malik Subhi Hamad (A resident of Silwad) then released him later and withdrew at 15:15. (ii) At 21:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Nabi Saleh village and prevented residents from entering or exiting the area after closing the steel gate entrance and then reopened it later. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:45, Israeli forces raided Deir Jrier village and clashed with several residents. (ii) At 19:40, Israeli forces raided Beitin village.

(iv) At 01:50, Israeli forces raided Khirbithat Al-Misbah village, detained two residents then withdrew at 03:00. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Yazen Qayed Sa'ed Nimr Muslih and Hufaytha Issa Attiya in Khirbithat Al-Misbah village. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:05, Israeli forces positioned near the vicinity of "Pesagout" settlement located in the east area of Al-Bireh city fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 08:50, Israeli forces positioned in Beituniya fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iii) At 09:00, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Al-Mughier village fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 3 children: Ameer Nazal Al-Na'san (17 years old), Oasam Ghazi Al-Na'san (17 years old) and Hamza Ma'rouf Abu Aliya (15 years old). (iv) At 10:10, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Silwad fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (v) At 11:30, Israeli forces positioned near Ni'lin fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (vi) At 12:15, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Nabi Saleh village fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (vii) At 15:55, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Beit Liqya fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Assault on Education Sector:</u> At 10:10, Israeli forces stormed Budrous village and fired stun and tear gas grenades towards a local school then withdrew later.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. • <u>Detention:</u> At 00:50 on December 23rd 2015, Israeli forces detained Majd Ahmad Amarneh during their raid into Ya'bad as mentioned in the previous report. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 11:00, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Al-Arqa village temporarily detained Mahmoud Nahed Abdel-Ghani Arqawi then released him at 00:40. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Israeli forces continue to close the wall gate and only allow those holding special permits to enter through it.
TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Detention:</u> At 13:00, Israeli forces detained three residents (including a child): Abdel-Wahab Mohammad Ali Bani Odeh (15 years old), Jafar Mohammad Bani Odeh and Lutfi Mohammad Fahed Bani Odeh. • <u>Physical Assault:</u> At 22:00, Israeli forces positioned in Tayassir village assaulted Uazen Zahi Ahmad Abu Ali (A resident of Tayasir village) and left him hospitalised with contusions during which Israeli forces temporarily detained 3 residents including a child: Yazen Ahmad Abu Ali (17 years old), Mujahid Abdel-Raziq Dabaq and Mahmoud Fayez Dabaq then released them at a later time.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> At 13:50 on December 14th 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Shufa and Izbit Shufa villages located near "Avni Havits" settlement with a steel gate and barbed wire fence. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at "Eniv"

	<p>checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 08:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Ramin village then searched residents and vehicles until 10:20. • <u>Raid:</u> At 01:15, Israeli forces raided Tulkarem. • <u>Attack:</u> At 10:50, Israeli forces positioned near Wall Gate (664) located in Shukiya neighbourhood fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

(iii) Since 16:55 on December 18th 2014, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far'ata village which is located near "Gillad" settlement with dirt mounds (iv) Since 10:40 on September 1st 2015, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far'ata village which is located near "Gillad" settlement with a steel Gate • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:20, Israeli force set up a checkpoint along the road leading to Jayyus then searched residents and vehicles until 15:20. (ii) At 16:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Qalqiliya then searched residents and vehicles. (iii) At 21:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun and beneath Azzun Bridge located along the main road connecting Qalqiliya and Tulkarem then searched residents and vehicles. (iv) At 22:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrances of Azzun and Izbit Al-Tabib village then prevented residents from entering or exiting the area. • <u>Raid:</u> At 03:40, Israeli forces raided Qalqiliya, stormed two homes and detained a resident. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Oday Mohammad Abu Assab in Qalqiliya. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 16:10, Israeli forces positioned in the area between Azzun and Izbit Al-Tabib temporarily detained four residents including a child: Subhi Rashid Bashir (15 years old) {assaulted by Israeli forces}, Murad Saleem, Assad Hussien Shabtiya and Maymoun Mohammad Aniyat. • <u>Attack:</u> At 12:50, Israeli forces positioned near Ras Attiya village and Izbit Jaloud fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya, the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
