<p style="text-align: center;">JERUSALEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On December 24th 2015, the Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound, which forced residents to conduct prayers near checkpoints located outside Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. (iii) On November 16th 2015, Israeli forces closed the south entrance of Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood in Jerusalem, which leads to “Armon Hantsiv” settlement with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. (iii) At 12:00, Israeli forces closed Jaba’ checkpoint located along the main road connecting Jerusalem, Ramallah and Jericho the reopened it later. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:55, Israeli forces raided Qalandiya camp, clashed with several residents as they stormed a home and as a result killed a resident and injured 9 residents including 7 children: Mohammad Annan Ma’ali (16 years old), Abdel-Fattah Khader Badran (16 years old), Firas Yusef Shahin (17 years old), Naji Awad Shihadeh (16 years old), Ameer Hussien Aslan (17 years old), Firas Yusef Manasra (17 years old), Zien Hussien Aslan (17 years old), Mahmoud Ahmad Manasra and Loai Awad Aslan and again at 03:00 Israeli forces clashed with several residents as they stormed and searched the homes of Wissam Abu Ghuoliya , Annan Abu Hiusbah and Issa Assaf {All 3 residents killed by Israeli forces} and as a resident injured 2 residents: Mohammad Abdallah Mutier and Nidal Samir Karama then withdrew at 04:30. (ii) At 13:40, Israeli forces raided Hizma village. (iii) At 14:10, Israeli forces raided Anata. • <u>Killings:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:00, Wissam Nasser Abu Ghouliyah (20 years old){A resident of Qalandiya camp} was killed after Israeli forces opened fire towards him for allegedly attempting to run over a Israeli soldier near Jaba’ village

(ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

(iii) Since November 24th 2015, Israeli forces closed the main entrance of Sinjil and the east entrance of Al-Mughier village with cement blocks. (iv) At 18:50 on December 4th 2015, Israeli forces closed the main entrance of Aboud with cement blocks. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> On the evening of December 24th 2015, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Ya'bad then searched residents and vehicles then detained a child. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces positioned at a checkpoint at the entrance of detained Nasser Bassam Abu Baker (17 years old). • <u>Attack:</u> At 17:25, Israeli forces positioned near Zubaba village junction located near "Saleim" Military base fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents awaiting the release of a Palestinian Detainee and as a result injured Juma'a Mohammad Jum'a Turman and left Ayed Abdallah Mohammad Al-Ali

TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Roads: At 13:50 on December 14th 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Shufa and Izbit Shufa villages located near “Avni Havits” settlement with a steel gate and barbed wire fence. • Checkpoint: Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Detention: At 01:15 on December 24th 2015, Israeli forces detained Ma’en Awad Abdel-Raheem Odeh during their raid into Tulkarem as mentioned in the previous report.
