• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city for the alleged stabbing of an Israeli settler.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.

• Checkpoints:

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:20 and impeded the free flow of traffic until 04:05.
- (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> On 25 December 2014, Israeli forces set up several checkpoints on Mt. Of Olives abnd searched vehicles and civilians.

Raids:

- (i) At 11:30, Israeli forces raided Isawiyye village and detained 2 civilians after storming their homes.
- (ii) At 20:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Ram, detained 2 civilians and withdrew at 21:45.

• Detention:

- (i) At 05:00 on 25 December 2014, Israeli forces detained two residents: Jihad Aweidah and his son Ahmad, 16, from Al-Thuri.
- (ii) On 25 December 2014, Israeli forces detained 2 civilians on the Old Coty of Jerusalem: Mohammad Mashal and Abdallah Shuberi.
- (iii) The 2 civilians detained in Isawiyye are Hassan Jamjoum and Ali Ahmad Darwish.
- (iv) The 2 civilians detained in Al-Ram are Mohammad Rabbah Mohammad and Mahmoud Anwar Nabhan from Qalandia.
- Assault on Places of Worship: At 09:30, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli Police and Military stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound and provoked worshipers.

• Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic

RAMALLAH & AL BIREH	 Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages. Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. At 22:30 on November 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Beit Illu village with cement blocks. Attacks: At 14:50, Israeli forces guarding the Apartheid Wall near Al-Bireh fired rubber coated bullets and tear gas canisters at civilians for alleged stoning. At 15:20, Israeli forces near the entrance of Nabi Saleh village fired rubber coated bullets and tear gas canisters at civilians for alleged stoning. At 18:10, Israeli forces near Beit ur Al-Tahta_fired rubber coated bullets and tear gas canisters at civilians for alleged stoning and impeded flow of traffic. Israeli forces also stormed a gas station and detained civilians in it but released them at a later time.

Flying Checkpoints: At 08:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint on the eastern entrance to Ya'bad until 09:00. Wall Gates: Israeli forces continued to block wall gates with cement blocks and denying civilian access.

Detention: At 07:30 on 25 December 2014, Israeli forces detained at Tayasir checkpoint Mohammad Mousa Sawafta from Tayasir village. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya, the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.

	• Attacks: On the evening of December 25 th , Israeli forces shot fire towards civilians near (Karma Azure) on the pretext of stone throwing.
	Settler Violence: At 12:00, Israeli settlers from Kiryat Arba settlement in the old city of Hebron stoned a civilian home owned by Kayed Daana and caused his son minor injuries.

At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month. Israeli forces broke the cease-fire agreement by opening fire towards Khan Yunis. Israeli Naval vessels broke the cease-fire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of North Gaza.
