JERUSALEM	 Closure: The Israeli army continues to increase its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city entrance and the entrance to the Old City. The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beitlksa villages. Closure of Main Roads:

The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Sawahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

	Closure of Main Road: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan.
JENIN	 Raids: At 10:00, the Israeli forces raided Deir Abu Da'if village, conducted tests on several water wells in the village and withdrew at 10:30. At 14:50, the Israeli forces raided Marka village until 15:00. At 18:30, the Israeli forces raided Faqqu'a and Jalbun villages until 19:00. At 21:30, the Israeli forces raided Kafr Dan village until 24:00.
	Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.

Checkpoints: At 11:10, the Israeli army intensified its restrictions on Palestinian access at 'Einav checkpoint on the Tulkarem-Nablus main road and impeded the free flow of traffic until 11:50. Flving Checkpoints: (i) At 10:00, the Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Bal'a junction. (ii) At 11:00, the Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Baqa Al Sharqiya junction and detained a resident. Raids: (i) At 09:45, the Israeli forces raided Alar and Seida village. (ii) At 09:55 and again at 01:50, the Israeli forces raided Anabta, searched several civilian homes and detained a resident. Detentions: (i) Israeli forces positioned at a flying checkpoint at Baqa AL Sharqiya junction detained an unidentified individual. Wall Gates: Passage through the wall gates was restricted to civilians granted special permits, undercutting access to education and health services for civilians living behind the wall. Wall Construction: Land levelling for adjustment of the Wall route resumedin the area surrounding Jubara villageAccording to an Israeli High Court decision, the new Wall route will be constructed west of thevillage.

	village of Wadi Al-Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras 'Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • Wall Construction: Wall constructionresumed inKafrLaqef village north of KarneiShomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Imanuel settlement; and east of KafrThulth town near Ma'aleShomron settlement and between AzzunAtma and Oriniet settlement.

NABLUS	 (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Till-Burin and BeitFurik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of AlonMoreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • Checkpoints: (i) Al-Tur neighbourhood checkpoint (set up on Jerzim Mount) is closed on Fridays and Saturdays as well as during Jewish holidays. At 15:30 and again at 23:00, the Israeli forces raided Nablus, providing protection to a group of settlers who raided the area while visiting Joseph's Tomb during which confrontations ensued between residents and Israeli forces and withdrew at 04:20. At 22:20, the Israeli forces raided Al Nasriyat. Attack: At 18:00, the Israeli forces fired flash grenades near Itamar settlement.
SALFIT	Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. Since 14 November 2010, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to

	Salfit city to civilian buses only. The entrance had been closed for seven years, and at 08:30, Israeli forces closed the entrance and impeded the free flow of traffic.			
	• <u>Checkpoints</u> : At 18:05, the Israeli army increased its restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 22:40.			
	Raids: (i) At 21:40, the Israeli forces raided Deir Istiya. (ii) At 21:50, the Israeli forces raided Kafil Harres and fired flash grenades

- Raids: On December 26th 2011, the Israeli forces raided Nahhalin, served 3 demolition orders for homes near "Betar Eliyat" settlement owned by Husam Shakarna, Ahmad Abdul Hamid and Hassan Othman.
- <u>Detention:</u> At 13:35, the Israeli forces positioned at Container checkpoint detainedMunirTaher, a preventive security officer, strip searched him and released him after wards
- **Provocation of Palestinian Forces:** At 06:50, th eIsraeli forces positioned at Al container checkpoint seized a presidential guard vehicle carrying 6 security officers and released them at a later time.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed northwest of Beit Jala town.

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Dhahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to the entrance to Al-Simiya village.

• Flying Checkpoints:

- (i) At 08:00, the Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Kahil.
- (ii) At 08:40, the Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Sair.


