WEST BANK

Closure:

- (i) On December 26th 2015, the Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Agsa mosque compound, which forced residents to conduct prayers near checkpoints located outside Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
- The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in (ii) the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a (iii) hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

Closure of Main Roads:

- The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the (i) entrance to Jaba' village.
- The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to (ii) Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Oalandiya checkpoint.
- On November 16th 2015, Israeli forces closed the south entrance of Jabal Al-(iii) Mukabir neighbourhood in Jerusalem, which leads to "Armon Hantsiv" settlement with cement blocks.

Checkpoints:

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and at 21:00 closed the checkpoint after alleged shooting incident towards the checkpoint(as alleged by the Israeli military) then reopened it at 23:15.
- (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- Raid: At 20:55, Israeli forces raided Qalandiya and inspected the area between "Al-Kasarat" area and the camp Cemetery.
- Killing: At 10:30, Mus'ab Mahmoud Mohammad Al-Ghazali (26 years old) {a resident of Silwan} was killed after Israeli forces opened fire towards him for allegedly attempting to stab an Israeli soldier near Bab Al-Hadid area in Jerusalem.
- Attack: At 13:45, Israeli forces positioned in Bab Al-Amoud area fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents who participated in a demonstration demanding the release of the corpse of a Palestinian killed earlier.
- Settler Violence: At 24:00, a group of Israeli settlers attempted to abduct Enas Al-Suri (23 years old) as she was inside her vehicle during which they assaulted her as they attempted to take her before she was able to run away and then was hospitalised with contusions.

Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.
- The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on (ii) Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-

Detention: At 02:50 on December 26th 2015, Israeli forces detained Nasrallah Abdel-Raziq during their raid into Tulkarem as mentioned in the previous report. (ii) Israeli forces detained Mohammad Al-Fakhouri in Tulkarem. Confiscation of Property: At 02:50 on December 26th 2015, Israeli forces confiscated surveillance camera footage after storming and searching a butcher shop owned by Ali Al-Da'mah during their raid into Tulkarem. **Settler Violence:** At 19:15, a group of Israeli settlers stormed the area between Shufa amd Izbit Shufa village then withdrew at 22:30. **Closure of Roads:** (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) Since 16:55 on December 18th 2014, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far'ata village which is located near "Gillad" settlement with dirt mounds (iv) Since 10:40 on September 1st 2015, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far'ata village which is located near "Gillad" settlement with a steel Gate **Flying Checkpoint:** (i) At 16:00 and again at 18:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Qalqiliya until 19:45. (ii) At 18:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Jit village junction until 19:55. Raid: At dawn on December 27th 2015, Israeli forces raided Azzun and clashed with several residents. **QALQILIYA Demonstration:** At 15:00, a demonstration took place in Kafr Qaddum against the closure of the east entrance during which they clashed with Israeli forces tried to disrupt the demonstration by firing live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards demonstrators who attempted to reach they demonstration site. **Wall Gates:** (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya, the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. Closure: Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. **Closure of Main Roads:** (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Agraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the (ii) southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. **NABLUS Checkpoints:** At 15:35, Israeli forces closed Huwara checkpoint then reopened it later.

- (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.
- (ix) Since 10:45 on September 8th 2015, Israeli forces closed the agricultural road located in Arab Al-Rashaydeh village located near "Malee Amous" settlement with dirt mounds.
- (x) At 15:30 on November 20th 2015, Israeli forces closed the east entrance of Jinata and the entrance of Marah Rabah village with dirt mounds.
- (xi) At 13:10 on November 22nd 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Marah Rabah village with dirt mounds.
- (xii) At 18:00 on November 27th 2015, Israeli forces closed Bararat junction located in Ras area in Beit Jallah with cement blocks.
- (xiii) At 14:50 on November 28th 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Um Al-Raqaba area located in Al-Khader with cement blocks.

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) At 05:50 on November 5th 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance leading Farsh Al-Hawa area in Hebron with Cement blocks.
- (vi) At 10:30 on November 8th 2015, Israeli forces closed the junction located near "Hagi" settlement located in south Hebron with cement blocks.

- (vii)At 21:00 on November 11th 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Beit Awwa and Al-Majd village with cement block and dirt mounds.
- (viii) At 15:45 on November 15th 2015, Israeli forces closed Al-Samiya village junction located at the west entrance of Al-Samou' with cement blocks.
- (ix) On November 15th 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrances of Khliat Al-Miya and Al Dirat and the two bypass roads leading east Yatta with cement blocks.
- (x) On November 23rd 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Al-Qom village located in North Beit Awwa with Cement blocks.
- (xi) On December 1st 2015, Israeli forces closed a checkpoint located along Al-Shuhada road located in the old city of Hebron and prevented residents from passing through the checkpoint and redirected traffic through a road near the entrance of Jabal Al-Rahma.
- (xii)On December 9th 2015, Israeli forces closed a road near Jabal Jallis area located in the old city of Hebron and closed the bypass road.
- **Flying Checkpoint:** At 17:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Fuwar junction and detained a resident.

Raid:

- (i) At 00:30, Israeli forces raided Hebron, detained a resident, and summoned two residents: Hamza Al-Qawasmi and Islam Al-Natsheh to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 05:00.
- (ii) At 00:45, Israeli forces raided Ithna village.
- (iii) At 03:10, Israeli forces raided Halhoul, detained 2 residents then withdrew at 05:00.
- (iv) At dawn on December 27th 2015, Israeli forces raided Beit Ummar and detained a resident.
