JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to increase its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city entrance and the entrance to the Old City. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beitlksa villages. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the gate along the Wall section separating the area of Dahiyat Al-Bareed from Al-Ram town. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beitlksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • Checkpoints: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) The Israeli military set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Shu’fat refugee camp in Jerusalem replacing the old checkpoint placed at the entrance of the camp which will close off and separate Shu’fat, Ras Khamis, RasShihadeh, Al Salam neighbourhood, Anata and Shu’fat camp from Jerusalem • Attack on Property: On December 27th 2011, Israeli forces ordered the closure of Al Ein mosque, a local pre-school “Muslim children pre-school” and local merchant shops in Silwan because of damage caused by Israeli authorities illegal

(ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Sawahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • Wall Construction: Wall construction was resumed in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma'aleAdumim.

(ii) Since December 15th 2011, the Israeli army continues to close the road leading to DeirIbzi with earth mounds. • Flying Checkpoint: At 10:30, the Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Al Nabi Saleh village. • Detention: As mentioned in the previous report at 22:10 on December 26th 2011, the Israeli forces detained Ibrahim Harfush a police officer, his mother-in-law and Wisam Al Habil during their raid into Kharbatha Al Misbah. • Provocation of Palestinian Forces: At 09:50, the Israeli forces positioned at Al Mahkama checkpoint in El Berih city detained several Jordanian diplomats for alleged not having entry permits and released them after obtaining the vehicle license plate number .. • Demonstrations: At 11:00, family members of Palestinian detainees demonstrated in front of the International Red Cross Headquarters in El Berih city in solidarity with detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons. • Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantisvillages.
<p style="text-align: center;">JENIN</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Road: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. • Flying Checkpoint: At 11:25, the Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Zubaba village until 13:30. • Raids: At 14:40, the Israeli forces raided Jalqamus village. • Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.

<p style="text-align: center;">TULKAREM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village and the dirt road between Shufa and Saffarin villages. • Checkpoints: At 11:10The Israeli army intensified its restrictions on Palestinian access at ‘Einav checkpoint on the Tulkarem-Nablus main road and impeded the free flow of traffic until 11:50. • Raids: At 01:10, the Israeli forces raided Tulkarem and Tulkarem refugee camp, set up a flying checkpoint and served Farid Tabal a summon to report to Israeli military intelligence. • Wall Gates: Passage through the wall gates was restricted to civilians granted special permits, undercutting access to education and health services for civilians living behind the wall. • Wall Construction: Land levelling for adjustment of the Wall route resumed in the area surrounding Jubara villageAccording to an Israeli High Court decision, the new Wall route will be constructed west of thevillage.

(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second <i>Intifada</i>, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • Flying checkpoints: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:00 and again at 18:00, the Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun. (ii) At 16:05, the Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun Atma. (iii) At 18:00, the Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Qalqilya city until 19:00. (iv) At 21:35, the Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Kafr Qaddum village. • Raids: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:15, the Israeli forces raided Azzun Atma and set up a flying checkpoint near a school. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al-Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras ‘Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • Wall Construction:Wall construction resumed inKafrLaqef village north of

NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Till-Burin and BeitFurik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of AlonMoreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Tur neighbourhood checkpoint (set up on Jerzim Mount) is closed on Fridays and Saturdays as well as during Jewish holidays. On all other days, it is open between 07:00 and, 02:00 (ii) At 'Awarta commercial checkpoint, civilians are only allowed to cross between 05:00 and 20:00, and between 05:00 and 15:00 on Fridays. All vehicles can access the city of Nablus, but only commercial vehicles and ambulances can leave the city through the checkpoint. (iii) At 10:00, the Israeli army intensified its restrictions at Huwara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 14:00. (iv) At 10:25, the Israeli army closed Awarta checkpoint impeding the free flow of traffic as they detained a resident for allegedly carrying an explosive device and reopened it at 14:00. (v) At 10:25, the Israeli army closed Awarta checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 10:50. (vi) At 19:40, the Israeli army intensified its restrictions at "ShaviShamron" checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:20, the Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of BeitFuriq and impeded the free flow of traffic until 11:45 . (ii) At 18:40, the Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint near Sarah village junction. • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:10, the Israeli forces raided Nablus and stormed a home under construction. (ii) At 10:30, the Israeli forces raided eastern Nablus. The entrance had been closed for seven years, and at 08:30, Israeli forces closed the entrance and impeded the free flow of traffic.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> The Israeli army increased its restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> At 09:40 and again at 13:35, the Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Iskaka until 16:30 • <u>Raids:</u> At 03:10, the Israeli forces raided Harres village, stormed 3 civilian homes and detained a residents. • <u>Detentions:</u> Israeli forces detained Usayed Sultan • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> The Israeli army continues to close Road # 90 between Jericho city and Al-Oja village with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to restrict access through Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus Districts, only allowing access to residents of Jericho District and the Jordan Valley area and at 12:55, Israeli forces closed the checkpoint impeding the free flow of traffic for allegedly conducting a military training exercise in the area and reopened it at 17:00.. (ii) Israeli forces continues to intensify its restrictions at the checkpoint set up on the junction to Al-Ouja village, only allowing access to residents of the Jericho District and others with access permits. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:55, the Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint near Ein Dweik village. (ii) At 10:40, the Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the southern entrance of Jericho city until 16:05. • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:20, the Israeli forces raided Jericho city in order to provide protection for a group of Israeli settlers visiting a synagogue and with drew at 13:10. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunums of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> The Israeli army continues to close the BeitJala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road east of BeitFajjar town; the road connecting Tuqu' town to Khirbet al Baq'a village; and the detour road connecting Wadi Fukin and Al Jab'a villages. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 19:15, the Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Container checkpoint. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:40 and again at 12:05, the Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at

<p style="text-align: center;">HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Dhahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to the entrance to Al-Simiya village. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> At 18:35, the Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Fawar refugee camp junction. • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:05, the Israeli forces raided Hebron city. (ii) At 16:55, the Israeli forces raided BeitAwwa and detained 2 children. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 16:00, the Israeli forces detained Khalid Abu Shukheidim in the old city of Hebron. (ii) The Israeli forces detained MotazMasalmeh, 16, and Abdel Fatah Masalmeh, 16. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahiriya town.

<p style="text-align: center;">ALL DISTRICTS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 02:00 on 18 January 2009, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. The ceasefire has been further renewed on 30 October 2011 at 22:00. • On 14.12.2011, Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against pass beyond the mark. This is in breach of the agreement in this regard with the Israeli side, which specified the limit of territorial waters at 20 nautical; Israel had unilaterally changed this agreement first in October 2006, when it shrunk the area to 6 nautical miles, then in January 2009, when it declared the limit at 3 nautical miles. • Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement by raiding and firing towards Central Gaza and Khan Yunis. Israeli Aircrafts fired 2 missiles in an assassination attempt in Gaza and North Gaza, leaving 13 residents injured including 2 children and 6 Palestinian Gunmen including 2 in critical condition and killing 1 Palestinian gunmen. • Palestinian Gunmen opened fire towards targets behind the Green Line.
<p style="text-align: center;">NORTHERN GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Point:BeitHanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critically ill patients, Journalists, NGO staff, merchants and travellers travelling to Al Karama with previous coordination. • Air Attacks: On the evening of December 27th 2011 an Israeli drone fired a missile towards a motorcycle in an assassination attempt near Beit Lahiya, killing 1 Palestinian gunmen and injuring 4 others (including 1 child) destroying the motorcycle and damaged several homes as a result of the strike. • Assassination: Israeli drones launched a missile assassinating Abdallah Al Talabani. • Palestinian Attacks: At 23:00, Palestinian Gunmen launched projectiles towards the Green Line.
<p style="text-align: center;">GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Points: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iyah (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. • Air Attacks: On the evening of December 27th 2011, Israeli drones fired a missile targeting a Jeep carrying several Palestinian gunmen in northern Gaza city, injuring 8 residents including 5 Gunmen and 3 pedestrian residents including 2 critically injured. • Attacks: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 23:00 on December 26th 2011, the Israeli forces opened fire towards agricultural land and homes near Deir Al Balah. (ii) At 09:00, the Israeli forces opened fire towards agricultural land and homes near Deir Al Balah injuring Mohammad Al Talabani (12 years old)

	towards agricultural land and homes in Al Qarara village.
RAFAH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Points: • Yasser ‘Arafat International Airport remains closed. • Rafah (<i>Al ‘Awdah</i>) Crossing is open for critically ill patients, students and residents with special permits • Sufa Crossing is closed. • Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is partially open for the transportation of food supplies, goods, humanitarian aid cooking gas. In addition to 27 truckloads of Wheat. The exports of 5 shipments of Straw berries, 1 shipment of flowers and construction cargo designated to internationally funded projects.
