• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city for the alleged stabbing of an Israeli settler.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.

• Checkpoints:

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:20 and impeded the free flow of traffic until 04:05.
- (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> At 20:30, Israeli forces set up 2 checkpoints in Khal Al-Ajmar and near Maale Adumin junction on the main road connecting Jerusalem with Jericho and searched vehicles and civilians.

• Detention:

- (i) At 11:30 on 25 December 2014, Israeli forces detained 2 civilians during a raid on Isawiyye village: Ahmad Eweisa and Khaled Jadallah.
- (ii) At 15:40, Israeli forces in Wadi Qaddoum area in Silwan in Jerusalem detained civilian Yaqin Muslem Rajabi.

• Attacks:

- (i) At 15:20, Israeli forces positioned in Wadi Qaddoum in Silgan in Jerusalem fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (ii) At 22:00, Israeli forces in Abu Dis fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

• Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks.
- (iii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.
- (iv) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.

• Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) At 15:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the western entrance of Tegoa until 16:20.
- (ii) At 20:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the eastern entrance of Marah Rabah village until 20:40.
- Raids: At dawn on 27 December 2014, Israeli forces raided the village of Husan and summoned civilian Mohammad Ma'moun to the military intelligence.
- <u>Attacks:</u> At 21:35, Israeli forces in Shurfa area near the entrance of Husan and fired rubber coated bullets stun grenades and tear gas canisters at civilians for alleged stoning.
- **<u>Demonstrations</u>**: At 10:40, a demonstration set put with participation of international supporters in protest of Apartheid Wall construction at the entrance of Beit Fajjar (Ziyad Abu Ein village). Israeli forces intervened and confiscated 3 tents.

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.

• Flying Checkpoints:

HEBRON

(i) At 18:30, Israeli forces set up 2 checkpoints at the entrance of Beit Einon village and on Halhul Bridge and searched vehicles and civilians.

(ii) On the evening of 27 December 2014, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Ummar and searched vehicles and civilians.

• Raid:

- (i) At 20:00, Israeli forces raided and patrolled Hebron city.
- (ii) At 02:45, Israeli forces raided Halhul, detained 2 civilians and withdrew at 05:50.
- <u>Detention:</u> The 2 civilians detained in Halhul are: Thaer Jamal Mohammad Zamaara and Salam Iyad Bajes Saada.

• Physical Assault:

- (i) At 19:00 Israeli forces near the Apartheid Wall alongside Surif town physically attacked Mustafa Eid Tawayha from Surif causing him minor injuries.
- (ii) At 19:50, Israeli forces near Beir Einon village junction attacked child Bashar Rami Jaradat. 16. from Sair town.
- <u>Settler Violence:</u> On the evening of 27 December 2014, settlers from Carmel settlement located east of Yatta attacked 5 civilians from Um Al-Hir village and caused them minor injuries.

GAZA STRIP

At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month. Israeli forces broke the cease-fire agreement by opening fire towards Khan Yunis. Israeli Naval vessels broke the cease-fire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of North Gaza.
