WEST BANK

JERUSALEM

- **Closure:**
 - (i) On December 27th 2015, the Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound, which forced residents to conduct prayers near checkpoints located outside Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
 - (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages.
- **Closure of Main Roads:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.
- **Checkpoints:**
 - (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and at 21:00 closed the checkpoint after alleged shooting incident towards the checkpoint(as alleged by the Israeli military) then reopened it at 23:15.
 - (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- **Flying Checkpoint:** At 09:55, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Khan Al-Ahmar area junction (located along the main road connecting Jerusalem and Jericho) then searched residents and vehicles.
- **Raid:** At 03:40, Israeli forces raided Qalandiya camp, clashed with several residents as they stormed several homes, detained two residents including a child then withdrew at 06:00.
- **Attack:** At 19:00, Israeli forces positioned in Abu Dis fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- **Detention:**
 - (i) At 11:35, Israeli forces detained Sa’id Farouq Mohammad Qambouz (31 years old) {A resident of Al-Eizariya} after they opened fire towards him and injured him for allegedly attempting to stab an Israeli soldier at the main rail way station in Jerusalem.
 - (ii) At 12:00, Israeli forced detained Thaer Wajeeh Abdel-Majeed Mansour {A resident of Biddu} for allegedly attacking an Israeli Military vehicle.
 - (iii) At 17:30, Israeli forces detained the child Malik Mohammad Ahmad Al-Marbou’ (16 years old) {A resident of Al-Bireh city} for allegedly attempting to stab an Israeli Police officer in Jerusalem.
 - (iv) Israeli forces detained Mu’tasim Badira (17 years old) and Mohammad Subieh in Qalandiya camp.
- **Assault on Places of Worship:** At 09:00, a group of Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli Military and Police forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshipers.
- **Wall Gates:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.

	<p>(ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.</p>

On October 3rd 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road located near “Bet El” settlement and leading to Al-Jalazoun camp with cement blocks. (iii) Since November 24th 2015, Israeli forces closed the main entrance of Sinjil and the east entrance of Al-Mughier village with cement blocks. (iv) On December 15th 2015, Israeli forces closed the West entrance of Al-Labban Al-Gharbi village with cement blocks. (iv) At 16:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Atara Bridge then searched residents and vehicles. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:30, Israeli forces positioned near “Pesagout” settlement located in the east area of Al-Bireh city fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 09:45, Israeli forces positioned near the bypass road in Beituniya fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as result injured the child: Mohammad Al-Tarifi (11 years old). • <u>Detention:</u> At 21:05, Israeli forces detained three residents: Ahmad Mahmoud Ammar Awad, Islam Khalil Hussien Awad and Mohammad Hussein Hamad Awad (All residents of Budrous village). • <u>Settler Violence:</u> On the evening of December 27th 2015, a group of Israeli settlers from “Bet El” settlement located in North Al-Bireh city stoned residents and vehicles passing along the main road leading to Al-Jalazoun camp.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Area:</u> On December 24th 2015, Israeli forces closed off the area {900m wide and 100m long} along the main road connecting Jenin and Tulkarem leading to south Ya’bad and installed a barbed wire fence around the area and declared the area a closed military zone • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • <u>Raid:</u> At 03:35, Israeli forces raided Jenin, detained a resident then withdrew at 04:15. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Nour Al-Din Azziz Sadeq Shalabi in Jenin. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Israeli forces continue too close the wall gate and only allow those holding special permits to enter through it.

(iii) Since 16:55 on December 18th 2014, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far’ata village which is located near “Gillad” settlement with dirt mounds (iv) Since 10:40 on September 1st 2015, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far’ata village which is located near “Gillad” settlement with a steel Gate • Flying Checkpoint: At 16:45 and again at 19:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Qalqiliya then searched residents and vehicles. • Detention: At 11:00, Israeli forces positioned near “Mali Shamron” settlement detained the child Kriman Akram Ishaq Swidan (15 years old) {A resident of Azzun}. • Attack: At 18:30, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Azzun fired live ammunition; rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured two residents including a child: Safwan Mansour Mustafa Saleem (13 years old) and Abedel-Rahman Muhanad Dahbour. • Wall Gates: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya, the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.

(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. (iii) At 06:30 on November 22nd 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Aqraba and Yanoun village with dirt mounds. (iv) At 02:10, Israeli forces raided Assira Al-Shimaliya, stormed 3 homes and summoned Thiyab Sa;ada Al-Shouli to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning. • <u>Killing:</u> At 13:35, 2 residents including a child: Mohammad Rafiq Hussien Saba’neh (17 years old) and Nour Al-Din Mohammad Abdel-Qadder Saba’neh (23 years old) {Both residents of Qabatiya village in Jenin} were killed after Israeli forces opened fire towards them along the main road leading to Huwara for allegedly attempting to stab a Israeli soldier {As alleged by the Israeli Military}.

(iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama’ located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za’tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Raid:</u> At 01:00, Israeli forces raided Deir Istiya, stormed and searched 4 homes then withdrew at 01:50. • <u>Detention:</u> On the evening of December 26th 2015, Israeli forces detained Mohammad Bahjat Kamal Harb (A resident of Iskaka village).

(ii) At 18:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Jericho. • <u>Raid:</u> At 21:40, Israeli forces raided Al-Oja village and stormed the village Council headquarters.

BETHLEHEM

- **Closure:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village.
 - (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunums of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities.
- **Closure of Main Roads:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks.
 - (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.
 - (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires.
 - (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds.
 - (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.
 - (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.
 - (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.
 - (ix) Since 10:45 on September 8th 2015, Israeli forces closed the agricultural road located in Arab Al-Rashaydeh village located near "Malee Amous" settlement with dirt mounds.
 - (x) At 15:30 on November 20th 2015, Israeli forces closed the east entrance of Jinata and the entrance of Marah Rabah village with dirt mounds.
 - (xi) At 13:10 on November 22nd 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Marah Rabah village with dirt mounds.
 - (xii) At 18:00 on November 27th 2015, Israeli forces closed Bararat junction located in Ras area in Beit Jallah with cement blocks.

In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
