**WEST BANK****JERUSALEM**

- **Closure:**
  - (i) On December 28<sup>th</sup> 2015, the Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound which forced residents to conduct prayers near checkpoints located outside Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
  - (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
  - (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikka villages.
- **Closure of Main Roads:**
  - (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village.
  - (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikka village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.
- **Checkpoints:**
  - (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and at 21:00 closed the checkpoint after alleged shooting incident towards the checkpoint(as alleged by the Israeli military) then reopened it at 23:15.
  - (ii) On September 19<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- **Flying Checkpoint:**
  - (i) At 09:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in Ras Al-Amoud neighbourhood then searched residents and vehicles.
  - (ii) At 11:30, Israeli force set up a checkpoint near “Malee Adumin” settlement junction then searched residents and vehicles.
- **Raid:**
  - (i) At 19:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Eisawiya village, clashed with several residents, temporarily detained the child: Mohammad Ali Daoud Darbas (10 years old) then released him at a later time.
  - (ii) At 02:35, Israeli forces raided Qalandiya camp and Kafr Aqab village, clashed with several residents as they stormed several homes, detained 2 residents, temporarily detained the child: Imad Zaghir (12 years old) then released him at a later time and destroyed several merchant shop entrances using explosives in Kafr Aqab village then withdrew at 05:40.
- **Detention:**
  - (i) At 14:20, Israeli forces positioned at Jaba’ checkpoint detained Enas Ali Mahmoud Murad {A resident of Hebron} for allegedly finding a knife in her possession.
  - (ii) At 19:00, Israeli forces detained Farhat Rafiq Waleed Salameh (A resident of Wadi Al-Joz neighbourhood).
  - (iii) Israeli forces detained Osama Hassan Hamad and Ma’moun Abdel-Kareem Makhoulf in Qalandiya camp.
- **Home Demolition:** At 19:00, Israeli forces stormed Sur Bahar neighbourhood and served a Military order for the demolition of a home owned by Mohammad Amerih for allegedly being built without a licence.
