	village, during which Israeli forces fired teargas and stun grenades towards
	demonstrators as they neared towards the village entrance, and several
	demonstatoes suffocated as a result of tear gas inhilation.
	• Wall Gates:
	(i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and to
	search civilians, including students, using a metal detector.
	(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al-Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows
	residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at
	the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students
	to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
	Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in Kafr Laqef village north of
	Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Imanuel settlement;
	and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma'ale Shomron settlement.

	Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the

### **Checkpoints:** (i) Al-Tur neighbourhood checkpoint (set up on Jerzim Mount) is closed on Fridays and Saturdays as well as during Jewish holidays. On all other days, it is open between 07:00 and, 02:00 At 05:00 Awarta commercial checkpoint, civilians are only allowed to (ii) cross between 05:00 and 20:00 and between 05:00 and 15:00 on Fridays. All vehicles can access the city of Nablus, but only commercial vehicles and ambulances can leave the city through the checkpoint. At 11:40, the Israeli army intensified its restrictions at "Shavi Shamron" (iii) settlement junction, impeded the free flow of traffic and seized a vehicle owned by Moayad Samar a resident of Qalqilya Flying checkpoints: At 10:30, the Israeli forces setup a checkpoint at Sarah village, searching (i) people and cars. (ii) At 11:15, the Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at tekl village junction, dteianed 2 residents Mohammad Ramadan and Jihad Ramadan, and released them after military coordination. At 11:35, the Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Dierv Sharaf junction. (iii) At 15:00, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Biet Furiq village (iv) (v) At 15:20 and again at 21:45, the Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Salim village junction Raids: (i) At 21:30, the Israeli forces raided Salim village and searched 3 homes. (ii) At 00:45, the Israeli forces raided Talouza village, searched a home and served Ibrahim Dawarsha a summon to report to Israeli intelligence agency. (iii) At 02:00, the Israeli forces raided Tel village **Closure of Main Roads:** The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two (i) detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) Since 14 November 2010, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian buses only. The entrance had been closed for seven years, and at 11:00. Israeli forces closed the entrance and impeded the free flow of traffic. Checkpoints: the Israeli army continues to increase restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. **SALFIT** Settler Violence: At 09:40, a group of Israeli settlers raided Iskaka village until **Demonstrations**: At 12:00, Palestinian and International protestors marched in Kafr Al Dik village against land confiscation and settlement constructions, during which they clashed with Israeli forces leaving several demonstrators suffocated as a result of tear gas inhalation Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement. Closure of Main Road: The Israeli army continues to close Road # 90 between Jericho city and Al-Oja village with cement blocks. **JERICHO Checkpoints:** Israeli forces continue to restrict access through Al-Hamra checkpoint set up (i)

	Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them

### **GAZA STRIP**

# At 02:00 on 18 January 2009, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. The ceasefire has been further renewed on 30 October 2011 at 22:00. On 14.12.2011, Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against pass beyond the mark. Israeli forces broke the ceasefire by opening fire and firing artillery shells from positions at the Green Line towards Gaza.
