JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshippers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and at 06:00, Israeli forces closed the checkpoint impeding the free flow of traffic. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 09:30, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshiper during which Israeli forces temporarily detained 3 children: Ahmad Al-Turkwai (12 years old), Hamza Abu Nab (11 years old) and Abdel Rahman Al-Hashlamoun (11 years old) as they attempted to prevent the settler attack then released them at a later time. • <u>Detention:</u> On the morning of December 30th 2013, Israeli forces detained About Nuqad after storming his home in the old city of Jerusalem. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-

	<p>Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim.
<p>RAMALLAH & AL BIREH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages. (ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. • Flying Checkpoint: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 19:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Turmu'aya until 21:00. (ii) At 03:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Surda village junction until 04:15. • Raid: At 15:50, Israeli forces raided Turmus'aya and clashed with its residents. • Detention: On December 28th 2013, Israeli forces positioned along the main road near Al-Mughier village detained Jaser Al-Na'san (17 years old) for alleged stoning. • Attack: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 16:30, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Mazra'a Al-Gharbiya village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 02:30, Israeli forces positioned at Betuniya check[point fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents who were awaiting the release of the 3rd phase of Palestinian detainees imprisoned before the Oslo Accords and as a result left 4 residents suffocated from tear gas inhalation. • Injury: At 18:00, Israeli forces driving a Military jeep injured 2 residents: Yusef Tabal and Iz Salah after ramming their motorcycle near Abboud. • Temporary Detention: At 16:45, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Mughier village temporarily detained 2 children: Moayad Abu Aliya (16 years old) and Qutaybeh Al-Na'ssan (16 years old) then released them at a later time. • Settler Violence: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 03:25, Israeli settlers stormed Dahiyat Al-Zara'iyah area in north Al-Bireh near "Bet El" settlement and torched 3 vehicles owned by Daod Al-Nashashibi, Adel Al-Nadi and Samer Taleband spray painted racist graffiti on outer walls of a home. (ii) At 04:45, Israeli settlers stormed north of A-Bireh city and assaulted Thabet Eid Hassan , a resident of Dur Al-Qare' and as a result left him hospitalised with contusions. • Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages.
<p>JENIN</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Road: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. • Flying Checkpoint: At 14:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Silat Al-Harhiya and Ti'inik village junctions. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Silat Al-Harhiya and stormed a home. (ii) At 11:30, Israeli forces raided Jaba'. (iii) On the evening of December 30th 2013, Israeli forces raided Burqin, stormed a home and a Coffee shop then detained 2 residents.

	<p>(iv) At 00:20, Israeli forces raided Silat Al-Thaher, stormed and searched 4 homes, temporarily detained 3 residents: Saleh Hantouli, Ziyad Al-Kilani and Imad Al-Hananouli then released them after questioning by Israeli intelligence and summoned Mohammad Hafith to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 01:00.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Tamer Qahish and Hamza Istita in Burqin. • <u>Land Levelling:</u> At 23:00, Israeli forces levelled and a plot of land approximately 800m² in Arraba then withdrew at 01:00. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Raid:</u> At 00:25, Israeli forces raided Shufa village and stormed a home. • <u>Detention:</u> * Name correction for residents detained in Tulkarem are Moayad Ghalib Qassim (16 years old) {instead of Moa’yad Hamdan Qassim} and Muhanad Ghalib Qassim {instead of Muhanad Hamdan Qassim} as mentioned in the previous report. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • <u>Raid:</u> At 01:20, Israeli forces raided Kafr Qaddum village and detained a UNRWA school teacher then withdrew at 02:45. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Awad Obied (a UNRWA school teacher) in Kafr Qaddum village. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 01:45, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Qalqiliya fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents in Al-Razaza area. (ii) At 12:20, Israeli forces positioned near “Matan” settlement located in south Habalat fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate closed the steel gate at 11:40 intensified its restrictions and impeded the free flow of traffic. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma ’ale Shomron settlement.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area.

(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 09:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Qussin village junction until 11:00. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 00:30 on December 30th 2013, Israeli forces raided Beita and detained a child. (ii) At 12:10, Israeli forces raided Beit Wazan village. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Abdallah Najib Nasser (17 years old) in Beita.

(ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za'tara Al-checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 09:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Deir Ballut. • <u>Raid:</u> At 17:10, Israeli forces raided Kafr Al-Dik, set up a checkpoint at its entrance then withdrew at 18:35. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement.

(ii) At 15:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Ein Dweik village located in North Jericho. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 16:20, Israeli forces raided Jericho until 16:55. (ii) At 0:35, Israeli forces raided Aqbat Al-Jabr camp in Jericho, detained 2 residents then withdrew at 02:40. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained 2 residents: Mohammad Teibeh and Sadam Teibeh in Aqbat Al-Jabr camp in Jericho.

(ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man; a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in

(ii) At 02:35, Israeli forces raided Beit Fajjar, stormed and searched a home then detained a resident. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained Hamdi Shihadeh in Bethlehem. (ii) Israeli forces detained Ahmad Thawabteh in Beit Fajjar. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:55, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Khadr fired tear gas grenades towards a school for alleged stoning and temporarily detained the school principle then released him at 13:05. (ii) At 17:00, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ayda camp fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning and as a result shattered the front and rear windows of a National Security force vehicle. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Wall construction resumed in North West of Beit Jala town. (ii) On May 1st 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village. (iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.
<p style="text-align: center;">HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada’ Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron’s Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. . • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa’ towns, Al-‘Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron’s Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.

At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. • On November 14th 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24th 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21st 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles. • Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire from their positions behind the Green Line towards Gaza and Central Gaza. • Palestinian Gunmen broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire and launching projectiles towards the Green Line.
NORTHERN GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businessmen and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination. • <u>Palestinian Attack:</u> On the evening of December 30th 2013, Palestinian gunmen launched projectiles towards the Green Line.
GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Points:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. • <u>Attack:</u> On the evening of December 30th 2013, Israeli forces positioned
