WEST BANK

JERUSALEM	 <u>Closure</u>: The old city of Jerusalem remains closed to civilians from other districts. The Israeli authorities continue to intensify restrictions on the city. <u>Separation Wall Construction</u>: Construction of the separation wall in Al Eizariya, Abu Dis and Al Sawahira was resumed. 		
RAMALLAH & EL BIREH	 Flying Checkpoint: At 18:50, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to the town of Beit Rima. Separation Wall Construction: Construction of the western portion of the separation wall in Budrus and Rantis was resumed. Raids: At 12:15, the Israeli army raided the town of Silwad and searched several houses. At 15:30, the Israeli army raided the town of Beit Rima. At 20:10, the Israeli army, including 2 jeeps, raided the center of Ramallah city and fired sound bombs and teargas grenades towards civilians who were shopping for the holidays. At 03:30, the Israeli army, including 14 jeeps, raided the town of Deir Ghassana, searched 5 houses, destroyed most of the furniture and personal property in the houses and arrested 2 brothers. Arrests: Muhammad Abdul Hafith Nofal; and Faraj Abdul Hafith Gheith. 		
JENIN	 Separation Wall Gates: Passage through the separation wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. The closure continues to negatively impact education, economic and livelihood activities and impede access to health facilities. Separation Wall Construction: Construction in the northern valleys (Bardala, and 'Ein al Beida) and east of Tubas (Al Mutilla, Al Mughayyir, the outskirts of Raba, and Al Buqei' plateau) was resumed. 		
JERICHO	• Raid/House Demolition: At 06:00, the Israeli army raided the city, surrounded 1 house, opened fire towards the house and then demolished it. The Israeli army continued to open fire as of 08:00 this morning.		

BETHLEHEM (Closure: The town of Al Walaja remains isolated due to the closure of the Beit Jala/Al Walaja road by dirt and rock mounds. All entrances continue to remain closed to civilians. Raids: At 20:05, the Israeli army, including 2 jeeps, raided 'Ayda refugee camp. At 01:30, the Israeli army, including 3 jeeps, raided the city from the north.
TULKAREM	The Israeli army opened the gates of Al Kafriyat and Enav to pedestrians only, after subjecting civilians to thorough searches. The Israeli army physically assaulted large groups of civilians gathered at Al Kafriyat gate due to the slow search procedures. An Israeli jeep intentionally ran over 3 civilians, including 1 child, from the town of Jayyus. The injured civilians were transferred to hospital. Flving Checkpoints: At 12:45, the Israeli army, including 3 jeeps, set up a flying checkpoint on the road between the town of Jayyus and the village of Kaf Jamal and obstructed movement of traffic. At 13:20, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint near the village of Kafr al Labad, searched vehicles, obstructed movement of traffic and detained 1 civilian. At 17:10, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the junction of Bal'a, searched vehicles and obstructed movement of traffic. At 19:55, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the junction of the village of Al Jarushiya, searched vehicles and obstructed movement of traffic for several hours. Separation Wall Gates: Passage through the separation wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. The closure continues to negatively impact education, economic and livelihood activities and impede access to health facilities. Attacks: At 17:15, the Israeli army opened fire from the DCO towards civilian houses near the city. At 17:30, the Israeli army, including 3 jeeps, opened indiscriminate fire near the entrance of Nur Shams refugee camp. Raids: At 11:00, the Israeli army, including several tanks and jeeps, raided

	the city of Tulkarem and took position in the northern and eastern
	neighborhoods.
	(ii) At 11:10, Israeli Special Forces in civilian vehicles raided the southern
	part of the city and searched 1 house.
	(iii) At 11:30, the Israeli army, including 3 military personnel carriers,
	raided Dahiyat Dhinnaba and took position.
	(iv) At 18:15, Israeli Special Forces raided Dahiyat Shuweika and
	confiscated a civilian vehicle after threatening the passengers with the
	use of force if they did not leave the vehicle.
	(v) At 20:00, the Israeli army raided the city of Tulkarem, opened
	indiscriminate fire and fired sound bombs.
	(vi) At 22:10, the Israel army, including 4 jeeps, took position and opened
	indiscriminate fire, injuring 1 civilian in his right leg.
	(vii) At 00:20, the Israeli army, including 3 jeeps, raided Dahiyat Irtah and
	took position.
	(viii) At 01:50, the Israeli army, including military personnel carriers and
	jeeps, raided Nur Shams refugee camp, searched dozens of houses and
	arrested 1 civilian before withdrawing 03:00.
	• Air Patrols:
	(i) At 10:00, Israeli reconnaissance aircraft patrolled the skies over the
	city and refugee camp at low altitude.
	(ii) At 14:30, Israeli helicopters patrolled the skies over the southern part
	of the district.
	• <u>Injuries</u> : The Israeli army inured 3 civilians, including 1 child:
	(i) Isam Nofal;
	(ii) Sara Nofal; and
	(iii) Anan Abdul Fattah.
	• Arrest: The Israeli army arrested 40-year-old Walid Zandiq in Nur Shams
	refugee camp.
